PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

The Ten Commandments

Thank you to Rabbi AZ Thau, Yoni Gelband and Dr. Maru Gete who spoke eloquently on Tu B'Shvat about their experiences in the IDF during this war. It was a very moving evening and a wonderful turnout. We thank them for their dedicated service and their spouses and children for their support.

Trivia Night was a most excellent motzei Shabbat program, unless you came in second, but let's face it, you had no chance either! Ra'anana rocks. A lot of devoted people organize Trivia Night. Thank you to Richie Stoll, Quizmaster Extraordinaire! It is obvious that he put in an extraordinary amount of time for our enjoyment. You can see that Trivia Night is a labour of love. Thank you to the Planning Committee Andy Gelberger, Elaine Genesove, Howard Kurlandski, and Mark Mietkiewicz. Yishar Koach to Matee Moshkovits for his tech support, and the support team Josh & Elizabeth Katchen, Mindy Halper-Oliver, Morris Maron, Roberta Newman and Shari Vodianoi. And finally, thank you to the Judges, Eitan Steinfeld, Hadassah Ward, Leora Stoll, Shoshana Ward and Solomon Astroff. We could not have had such a wonderful evening without any of you!

We continue to have outstanding programs. This week, the Kollel will join us for Kabbalat Shabbat and Seudat Shlishit, so please join us for davening and ruach. The Rosh Kollel Rabbi Mordechai Scheiner will speak Erev Shabbat and at Seudat Shlishit. In two weeks, February 22-24, we will have an amazing Scholar-in-Residence program with Rabbanit Shani Taragin who will be hosting a women's challah bake (hosted by Shaarei Shomayim), Friday Oneg, Drasha in the Main Shul after davening Shabbat morning and a Shabbat afternoon shiur. Please contact the office if you would like to sponsor kiddush or shalosh seudos for this very special upcoming event. As well, Mizrachi is looking for sponsors for the Eishet Chayal initiative which supports wives of soldiers in Israel.

Michelle Factor has been working tirelessly for Run for Their Lives, an organization that connects local communities throughout the world to meet once a week in a designated location in the neighborhood for a short 1km walk/run. It takes about 18 minutes ("דקות" end to end. People march carrying flags of Canada and Israel, hostage posters and more. The Thornhill neighbourhood meets at 10am on Sundays at the main entrance of the Promenade and marches around the entire Promenade property. The name of the organization is misleading as we walked. No one is running. We walk, demanding the release of our hostages. I learned that over 130 cities around the world are participating and posting on social media. Come out and walk and demand our hostages be returned.

"Jews who say no to genocide" (do any Jews say yes to genocide?) stormed the offices of AWZ Ventures in Toronto which is an Israeli-Canadian Venture Capital firm where Josh Gutenberg works. The repugnant behaviour of these demonstrators disrupting a private office and illegally trespassing makes me wonder - when will the police finally start policing? I commend Josh for staying calm the entire time. When they started to say "Kaddish", he tore the prayer out of one of their hands and told them that he will not allow them to disgrace the memory of those who have actually been murdered. Good for him! He even returned their booklet but first removed the Kaddish. Such good manners too. These misguided people even hung pictures of "people" who have been "killed" by the IDF. They did not hang any pictures of our 136 remaining hostages or of the 1,200 innocent people who were murdered on October 7th. Josh was so unflustered. He challenged them to unveil their covered faces, which of course they did not do. We will not be intimidated.

Last week I was mulling over what to write and then as it came to me, Esther said take a week off. Wife knows best. Take a week off it is. That evening Esther asked what I was going to write about and I told her. Her response was, oh you should have written about that. So, Esther was right. I write my thoughts following Parshat Yitro and the focus on last week's parsha with the ability to look back on it after reading and hearing the entire sedra.

Last week, we read the Ten Commandments. And we can all agree that the Ten Commandments are real because Charlton Heston received the Ten Commandments in Cecil B. DeMille's "The Ten Commandments". The entire world, even before the movie, has agreed that the only way for society to possibly function is through civility which means under no circumstance may one person take the life of another. "Do not murder." Bad. Very Bad. And we know that after "Adultery" one commandment later is "Do not steal". And we know that the Torah is not talking about stealing goods, because according to Rashi, this is a warning against kidnapping, enslavement and selling human beings. All are capital offenses. Rabbi Samson Raphael Hirsch teaches that the second half of the Ten Commandments demonstrate the application of our religious ideals within the practical running of society. This means that your neighbour, his wife, his freedom, his wealth, his honour and all of his property receive divine attention and therefore possess sanctity. But it seems that on October 7, society no longer has such basic moral rules of murder, kidnapping and rape. It is mind boggling that we have to be reminded with the reading of the Aseret Hadibrot to be certain that without these very basic rules of civility, civilization will undoubtedly fall apart. And that is why we at that BAYT stay level headed, firm in our beliefs and follow the leadership in our community like members we are blessed to have like Michelle and Josh who we look up to in times of complete moral and civil discord.

INTRODUCTIONS TO THE LAWS OF PRAYER BY RABBI ADAM FRIEDMANN

Why Do We Pray?

Last week we completed our overview of the Laws of Keriat Shema. This week we begin a new topic, the Laws of Prayer. Before getting into the halachot themselves, we'll start with some introductions.

The Torah never commands us explicitly to pray. Instead, we are commanded in many places to serve G-d. This service includes many things, but Chazal understood that one specific aspect of it is prayer. The point of this commandment is obviously not to give something to G-d, since that is impossible. In that case, why do we pray? Many approaches have been suggested over the course of Jewish history. Here are a few:

The Rambam's fifth principle of faith is that G-d is the only real address to turn to when we are in crisis. This principle of faith is acted out and inculcated through the act of prayer when we turn to G-d for help with our deepest problems.

According to Rav Sa'adya Gaon, prayer is fundamentally an act of praise and thanks to G-d. It emerges from the heart of a person who has properly understood G-d's greatness and kindness.

Rabbi Chaim of Volozhin presents prayer as a mystical practice where our words and thoughts have an enormous impact in the spiritual realms.

Why does the Torah need to state explicitly that the capital punishment for someone who murders intentionally applies even if they are atop the altar of G-d? Why would a murder decide to hide in such a public place?

If we fast forward to the time of Shlomo HaMelech, (Melachim I Chapter 2:28-34) Yoav, the disgraced and treasonous general of King David, tries to escape responsibility by holding onto the corners of the Mizbeach. King Shlomo sent Bnaya to catch Yoav for murdering two generals in cold blood, Avner and Amasa. Bnaya ultimately kills Yoav where he stands, because the altar cannot save Yoav, and as per Shlomo's words, Yoav deserves his punishment.

But why did Yoav run to the altar to begin with?

Yoav held the mistaken assumption that the Mizbeach, the altar, is a magical totem. No matter who makes it there, they will be granted protection no matter their sin.

G-d and His altar are not magical force fields that can be manipulated at will. G-d expects us to follow the Torah and mitzvot in their entirety, understanding His Will. We, Bnei Yisrael, aren't magicians or cultists hiding behind a veil of power. Instead, we are G-d's nation who must live up to the high standards G-d sets for us, no matter where we are.


