Last week, I thanked the ba'alei kriah for laining and of course, I missed a few. My apologies to the reliable Eddie Jesin and Michael Snowbell.

I have said for quite a while that all bags coming into the shul are subject to search. The reason is simple. The mandate is to search everyone's bag. That way, the rule applies to all. "Am echad, lev echad", One nation, one heart. It avoids embarrassing the volunteer who may not know the member or guest entering the building. As well, the paid security staff have strict protocols to follow and check all bags including tallaisim bags. According to the experts, it is a deterrent. The protocols that the BAYT follows are set out by the security team of Federation and the York Regional Police who have more professional experience than our team does. The Executive and Board have discussed this and are fully on board with the protocols. We are committed to ensuring the BAYT is a very safe environment with the tools we have available. Unfortunately, we have members at the BAYT who have lost family members to attacks, so we are hypersensitive to provide a safe environment for all our members and guests. I respectfully ask for everyone's full cooperation. By the way, on September 9th, Federation will be staying in our community for Shabbat. Joining us will be Adam Minsky, CEO of UIA Federation; Daniel Held Executive Director of the Julia and Henry Koschitzky Centre for Jewish Education and Max Robert and Dan Ages, from Security for Federation. It will be an amazing Shabbat program and members will have the opportunity to ask all the security questions you want at that point, amongst the many pressing issues in the lewish community. I'm sure it will be a wonderful Shabbat. Details to follow.

Dedication In Loving Memory Of Rabbi Leiby & Mindy Newman z"l



Leiby & Mindy Newman z"l were a loving and giving couple who contributed to their communities wherever they lived; Montreal, New York, Los Angeles and Toronto.

Rabbi Leiby Newman administered nursing homes in New York and was very active in Hatzoloh. Mindy was a teacher in Los Angeles and Toronto.

When they moved to Toronto, Mindy became a Grade 1 teacher at Bobov where she taught for 17 years right until she passed away.

Both Leiby and Mindy became Mashgichem for COR supervising at various catering venues. Mindy and Leiby were "the

Mashgicham" at the Park Hyatt Hotel and Mindy often supervised at the BAYT on Shabbat, including her last Shabbat when she was rushed to the hospital.

After Leiby and Mindy moved to Thornhill, they joined the BAYT. Leiby intentionally sat among the young men at the entrance to the main sanctuary on the north side where he became one of the guys and always greeted everyone coming into shul. Leiby passed away suddenly nine years ago.

Mindy loved coming to Shul and participating in the various shiurim and shul programs. Mindy's children were her students and her friends' children. Her students and their parents deeply felt her loss and learned Mishnayos in her memory. Her BAYT friends and their children honoured her memory at her shloshim. Mindy was close to her brother Mike and sister-in-law, Patricia. She was especially close to Leiby's son, Nuti and his wife Fran, who came to Toronto frequently to visit her.

Rabbi Leiby & Mindy z"I were part of our BAYT family. We are honouring their memory by dedicating a Shtender on the Bima in the Main Sanctuary. In addition, the Sisterhood will be inaugurating the annual Mindy Newman z"I Shavuos Shiur for Women.

Is it appropriate to visit a cemetery on Tisha b'Av?

Funerals may take place on Tisha b'Av. Further, the Talmud recorded a practice of visiting cemeteries on public fast days, offering two reasons to do this:

- 1) The visitor appeals to G-d, saying he is "as though he were dead" in his suffering, and
- 2) The visitor asks those who are buried there to pray on his behalf.

Later commentators added a third reason: the visitors are reminded that if they do not repent, they will meet the fate of those who are already in the cemetery.

Based on this ancient practice, many Jews visit cemeteries after concluding kinot on Tisha b'Av. For mystical reasons regarding impurity, some stay at least seven feet from the graves, or even refrain from entering the cemetery altogether.

Halachic authorities advise that people should not visit a cemetery on Tisha b'Av in groups, lest the visit lose the introspective and mournful character appropriate for Tisha b'Av.

Why is there so much detail about the aftermath of the war with Midyan? Isn't all that matters that we went to war as G-d commanded and won?

Waging war at G-d's command isn't just about the battle itself, but also how we behave afterwards. Moshe chastises the people for what they take as spoils, and outlines the process for reentering the camp. Elazar the Cohen Gadol teaches Bnei Yisrael how to purify their utensils. G-d commands us to divide the spoils between the soldiers who went to war and those who remained back in the encampment. Another portion from that will go to the Leviim who were serving and guarding the Mishkan. Contained within each command are mitzvoth, morals, and values that are essential for the nation as a whole. When the tribes of Reuven and Gad immediately afterwards petition for land on the east side of the Jordan River, we see that they missed the message. They were focusing on their physical desires and greed, focusing solely on their cattle while ignoring the needs of the nation. Moshe responds angrily that "your brothers will go to war and you will stay here?!?" because you be the Am Yisrael, the nation of Israel, we need to account for all the values we have, not just monetary ones.


