"We just spent five days in the Shaare Tzedek Hospital" in Yerushalaim. My wife had a serious infection and the doctors determined that must be treated with intravenous antibiotics. Therefore, after triage at the emergency department, my wife was admitted in the hospital to the 6th floor, Geriatrics Department. I stayed with her five nights (including Shabbat). PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

The Roof

The BAYT's 34,000 square foot roof spans the entire synagogue structure. The BAYT roof was at the end of its life cycle, with leaks in many areas. Over the past several years, we made costly band-aid repairs which unfortunately did not prevent expensive interior damage. Last November, Phase I began with repair to the main area including the roof over the Perlis Hall. Phase II was just recently completed with a new roof over the Main Sanctuary and lower lobby.

A lot of hard work was planned, including utilizing a 150 Ton crane to lift roofing material in addition to moving our AC units around the roof, including lowering the AC units to the ground while the roof was properly repaired. The six skylights over the bima were replaced.

Of course, the repair took longer than expected with Covid and supply chain issues but given the time line and the challenges, Howard Glowinsky of Elite Roofing had to overcome, they did a magnificent job. We are very appreciative of their hard work.

The \$575,000 roof repair was spearheaded by our David's... Lithwick and Vodianoi. The time they put in to complete this project was remarkable. Negotiating details. Getting quotes. Fighting for every dollar knowing they are the guardians of the BAYT structure and the sensitivity that they are spending communal funds. The board approving the spending. The project was completed on budget. (I love saying that!). Our Budget and Finance committee arranged some excellent financing once we had all the details to take this mammoth job on.

Our stakeholders have to understand that those of us who are entrusted to manage the shul from top to bottom, take our tasks seriously. We are not only responsible for what everyone can see of our physical structure like the main sanctuary, the Perlis Hall, the Turk Beit Midrash etc, but we are responsible for what you cannot see, like the roof. While we raised \$2.3M almost five years ago for the capital improvements, those funds were not permitted to be used for the roof. The good news is that the Main Shul renovations are being planned as we speak and will be conducted in two phases. This coming December, we hope to complete the steps and landing to the bima in the Main Sanctuary with stone and in December of '23, we will replace the carpeting and either refurbish the pews or order new ones, depending on which makes more financial and practical sense, and access to the bima for the disabled is in plans.

As I have mentioned previously, a major reason I stepped forward to be President is the talent on the Executive and Board. The roof project is an excellent example of the team in place. I am very proud of all the people that made this project happen. A huge Yasher Koach to David Lithwick, David Vodianoi, Jeffrey Brown and Jonathon Hames but really the entire Executive and Board played a massive role in green lighting this critical project and seeing it all the way to completion on time and on budget.

What rules apply to the meals of Shabbat, when it coincides with Tishah b'Av?

We eat normally for most of this Shabbat; all of the Shabbat meals may include meat, wine and delicacies. One may even eat and drink extra, knowing this will mitigate the fast – but one may not declare this intention overtly. Statements of preparation for after Shabbat are prohibited.

Seudah shlishit should only be eaten with people who would normally be present for a Shabbat meal, and the mood of seudah shlishit should be somber. All eating must stop before sunset, even though Shabbat continues until its normal time.

Additional notes:

The traditional seudah hamafseket meal eaten before Tishah b'Av is not eaten this year.

After Shabbat has ended, one says the phrase "Baruch hamavdil bein kodesh l'chol / Blessed is the One who distinguishes between the sacred and the mundane." One then removes leather shoes and Shabbat finery. Some wait to do this until after Borchu at the start of maariy.

One may not bring Tishah b'Av clothing or footwear to shul until after Shabbat has ended and one has recited Baruch hamavdil.



Why is the tribe of Menashe the only tribe split between the west and east sides of the Jordan River?

The tribes of Reuven and Gad chose to be on the eastern side of the Jordan for the sake of their sheep and cattle. Moshe furiously chastised Reuven and Gad for ruining Bnei Yisrael's morale and acting like the spies, only relenting when they agreed to fight on behalf of the rest of the tribes in the front. When the tribe of Menashe saw this they went out and promptly conquered new land on the east side of the Jordan on their own, proving their love of the land of Israel and faithfulness to G-d.

Rabbi Menachem Leibtag explains that the tribe of Menashe was meant to be the bridge between the two sides of the Jordan. They would lead by example with their enthusiasm and love of Israel and its land.

During the month of Av each of us has the ability to bridge the gap with our Jewish brethren, to show them a love that not only counters baseless hatred, but emphasizes our caring for each other and our Land of Israel.





John Moscowitz is a Sr. Rabbinic Fellow at the Shalom Hartman Institute in Jerusalem.

John Moscowitz grew up in St Louis, Missouri. Being an anti-war activist, the left was his political home throughout much of the 1970's. Seeking to combine his Jewish and political commitments, John Moscowitz enrolled in rabbinical school.

In 1987 Rabbi Moscowitz began at Holy Blossom Temple in Toronto as an Associate Rabbi. He became the Sr. Rabbi in 2000, a position he held until becoming the congregation's rabbi emeritus in 2014. Author of "Evolution of An Unorthodox Rabbi" (2015), Rabbi Moscowitz has written for a number of publications. He is now writing a memoir of his leftist days in which Tom Hayden, among others, figures prominently.
