PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

October 20, 2023 Noach

There was a lot of nervousness in the community going into Shabbos last week given that there was a call for a "day of rage". I can tell you that our Mayor Steven Del Duca and the York Regional Police Force were incredibly sensitive to our need for security all while projecting complete moral clarity. Our leaders entrusted with protecting the Vaughan Jewish community are to be commended. I am very grateful for their no-nonsense approach. The police have been diligently watching over, not only the BAYT, but all religious institutions in Vaughan including schools. I know that I went into Shabbos feeling protected and I hope you did too. There is no question that the temperature is high and we must remain vigilant at all times but rest assured our police and Mayor have our backs.

Obviously, I am shocked by the explosive public display of anti-Semitism locally and worldwide, but it is critical that we write the involved institutions and utilize all our resources and tools to stop such vile immoral and illegal behavior.

I cannot begin to express my appreciation to the kehillah who came out for Kabbalas Shabbos and rocked the BAYT on Friday night led by Rabbi Lesher. It was extremely heartwarming to connect with Hashem after such a difficult and heavy week. The same was true in the Main Sanctuary on Shabbos morning with a beautiful tefillah, including a special rendition for Tzahal and the Medina. A huge thank you to our Rav, Elie Weltman and the choir led by Cyril Brenman. I just felt that I kept getting stronger as Shabbos went on. It was very much appreciated that our Mayor came to visit us on Shabbos and addressed our community directly from the pulpit. While I did not personally see Laura Smith, our MPP, I heard she was in shul and had to leave but it was great to have her join us as well. And then, for motzei Shabbos we had a beautiful, musical unity havdalah and kumsitz which was attended by close to a hundred members and their kids. From there, Esther and I, and many other BAYT members, went to Shaarei Shomayim for a community wide Siyum Tanach, which was very well attended, extremely moving, filled with learning and divrei chizuk which was delivered by our Rav who was incredibly inspiring quoting an amazing gemara. By the end of Saturday night, I felt recharged and ready to face the difficult challenges ahead. The best possible therapy.

On Monday night at the weekly Sugya Shir, our Rav gave an excellent shiur on The Modern Mitzvah of Pidyon Shevuyim During Wartime. As difficult as a subject could ever be, given the timing, it was uplifting to learn Torah and Halacha at such a critical time as we know that our brethren are trying to free almost 200 captives. I urge you to find the time to watch or listen to the shiur. I felt it was so much more productive than watching the news. The Rav recommended limiting our time on social media because all the news is mentally, physically and emotionally draining. Better to put our energy into helping klal Yisrael than listening to the repetitive news cycles.

We are very blessed to welcome Rabbi Yehuda Mann who is the Rosh Beit Midrash of Beit Midrash Zichron Dov and assistant Rabbi at Clanton Park Synagogue as our scholar in residence for Shabbos. I hope you take the time to hear his divrei Torah which I'm sure you will find to be inspiring and interesting from an Israeli Rabbinic perspective.

There are many important charities to support at this time. Of course, there are the obvious ones which we include in our links to make it easy. However, many of our members are soliciting for personal drives for critical needs and I find it so heart-warming. Big or small, give what you can.

I was supposed to be in Israel this week to visit my children, grandson and brother and his family. The Brown wedding was to take place on Sunday, but that has been postponed too. Hashem had other plans for us. I look forward to dancing at Zack and Dalya's wedding, visiting mishpacha in the near future, but there are very urgent matters to attend to in the meantime. There will be time to sing and dance.

Men and women continue to say tehillim at mincha/maariv and following maariv we say three more tehillim, for those who can remain, including tefillos for our beloved injured, kidnapped and soldiers. Please join us if you are able. Looking forward to seeing all of you in shul Friday night.

Additionally, we understand that there are many families in Toronto who have children or family members in the army.



Blessings of the Shema Part 4: Redemption

The first blessing after the Shema deals with G-d's historical redemption of the Jewish People. In the morning, the blessing begins with emet veyatziv (it is true and certain). The evening version begins with emet ve'emuna (it is true and faithful). Both versions mention the core components of the Exodus from Egypt, the death of the firstborn, the splitting of the sea, and G-d's sovereignty. Rashi explains the distinction between the versions: The morning blessing focuses on G-d's kindness in taking us out of Egypt. The evening blessing broadens to include our faith that G-d constantly saves us from our enemies throughout history. This fits well with the earlier blessings that also emphasized G-d's manifest kindness in the day and our faith in His as-of-yet unrealized kindness at night.

The Talmud states that whoever does not recite these blessings every day does not properly fulfill their obligation. This is taken to mean that one is obligated to say these blessings and also that without them one's fulfillment of reading the Shema is lacking. If one failed to recite this blessing or omitted one of its core components, it must be recited later. If one recites the evening blessing in the morning by accident, or vice-versa, the proper blessing should be recited. This is true unless one has already recited the name of G-d at the end of the blessing.

Is Noach a Tzadik? If he is, why didn't he protest when G-d told him that the world was going to be destroyed like Avraham before the destruction of Sodom? Why did he only build the ark?

The Kedushat HaLevi, Rabbi Levi Yitzchak of Berdichev, offers that there are two types of Tzadikim. One type of Tzaddik, such as Avraham, only seeks to serve G-d as best he can and believes that G-d can do anything that He desires, but ultimately the actions of a righteous person can cancel G-d's decrees (Moed Katan 16b). The second type worships G-d but is very lowly in their own eyes and thinks, 'Who am I to pray for annulment of G-d decree?' so he does not pray for it to be annulled. This is the type of Tzadik that Noach was.

It is perfectly understandable to be righteous like Noach. With the difficult news we have heard, to simply do what G-d has tasked us with and nothing more, thinking ourselves unworthy of more. We can make it through by simply acting.

But there is another level, that of Avraham. Through our actions and prayers, we can cause G-d to change His decree. We must not give up hope or be overly humble. Rather we must act and strive for the best possible result, which can become G-d's Will.



SHUL HAPPENINGS

Since 2022, BAYT has been a neighbourhood partner of the Reena Community Farm. That relationship allows some food grown at Gan BAYT, to be donated and bartered through Reena with the York Region Food Network. (YRFN)
