PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE—TUMAH VS TAHARAH

This has been one of the most polar opposite 7 days in the past week that I have ever experienced in my life. We have experienced Tumah (ritual impurity) and Taharah (ritual purity) at our BAYT this week. The question I debated is which one do I address first? I think I will deal with Tumah first. After all, you have to be rid of tumah in order to aspire to become tahor. So let's get the "shmutz" out of the way.

From the moment we got wind of the "Rally" by the antisemites, a lot of people worked extremely hard. It will take me weeks to thank the army of people and organizations who stepped forward to help. The first question we had to deal with was: do we respond and how do we respond? Do we call upon the community to counter-rally? Or do we let the Hamas puppets rally outside the BAYT (shouting for our deaths and the end of Israel) and do nothing? All the while working closely with our executive, community leaders, police and politicians (Mayor Del Duca, Gila Martow, Laura Smith and Melissa Lantsman), trying to prevent the rally and at the very least to ensure that the two communities are separated. Essentially keeping tumah and taharah apart. The Rav and I decided to respond and write a letter to our community and stand proud. The Hamas puppets were not rallying against BAYT because of the real estate event. Never be fooled. That was not their objective. That was a complete smoke screen. You see, on the previous Sunday at Aish, none of the properties were in Yehuda v'Shomron, so really their yelling and screaming clearly showed that displaying land in Israel proper is in itself a violation, which is completely groundless. Furthermore, the BAYT was simply the host of the event, as we have been for many years. We rented our space, as was true in Montreal, Teaneck, Lawrence and Flatbush (the police made the Synagogue cancel). Further infuriating is the Hamas posters. They all displayed Palestine encompassing the entire map of Israel. They are calling for the destruction of Israel and the Jewish people. Do they even know what genocide is?

The safety of our community was the single highest priority. Obviously, they were coming to our territory to intimidate, frighten and harass the neighbourhood with an exclamation point in front of our house of worship. We coordinated with Yalla, Shomrim, Tafsik, Lions of Judah, X730, Federation and the Police. They were all incredible. I can tell you that our community was in great hands and I knew that we had done our best to prepare, and the day of the event is the proof. We have already had a security follow up meeting as we deconstruct what happened on the day of and what we can do to improve. And most importantly to try and ensure that this will NEVER HAPPEN AGAIN at the BAYT.

I would like to thank Howie T for his music. He worked tirelessly. He was amazing. He brought so much power but the Hamas puppets are professional agitators. It is what they do. They disrupt peaceful neighbourhoods and cause chaos. Howie balanced that with his music. And quickly we realized that the puppets had the advantage of bouncing their music off the BAYT building, it made their death chants even louder, even deafening at times. And then the puppets trespassed multiple times and cut our power. Luckily, we fixed it quickly, but we realized that we are not dealing with law abiding citizens. So Howie T brought in even more power and that was a great moment.

I have to thank our office staff. You see, they were planning to work on the Grand Opening of the Mikvaot and preparing for Purim but instead had to pivot for the rally. And that was complete insanity. A huge thank you to Avital, Irena, Karen, Shimon, Michelle and Shonna. You guys are amazing. And then to our internal Thursday Rally Security Team: Allan Jaff, Steve Mortfield, Aaron Rosenberg, Molly Morris, Rabbi Avraham Witty, Josh Katchen, Kevin Greenspan, Michael Conforti, Miriam Snowbell, Jeffrey Brown, Bob Libman, Yaakov Rodriguez, Avital Sandler, David Elmaleh, and Ed Noy. Thank you! You were amazing and you stopped multiple people who tried to trespass. A job well done!

On page 12 in the bulletin you find a link (www.bit.ly/witnessreports-bayt-aish) in the Lion of Judah's ad, and we ask that you report illegal activity that you directly witnessed and upload pictures and video with the report.

We have had a lot people reach out to us to help in any we need. We are taking all the names down and we will be reaching out to you shortly.

A big todah raba to Mark Mietkiewicz, Elaine Genesove, Josh Katchen, Shloimie Romberg for a wonder motzei Shabbat movie night featuring THE UNORTHODOX. An excellent film which was enhanced with comments before and after the film with our Rav and Rabbi David Kadoch of the Sephardic Kehila Centre.

On the Taharah side, the office was focused on the official opening of the BAYT's Maddie Leventhal Mikvah Centre which took place on Sunday. And let me tell you something, if you missed the opening, you missed one of the most beautiful moments in the BAYT's history. Not because the Mikvah is absolutely stunning. No expense or detail was spared. But because how beautifully the Rav and Rabbi Yitzchok Bistritzky spoke. No question there were tears in the room. The Rav spoke about how we were about to renovate the Main Sanctuary and we were approached by the Berman's and the Leventhal's to renovate the Mikvah first. And we agreed because that is the halacha. Mikvahs come before building a shul. Family taharah is the anchor to kedusha (sanctity) in the family unit. And we thank the committee led by Co-Chairs Lisa Berman and David Lithwick, and Rabbi Mordechai Scheiner, Jack Feintuch, Enny Herskowitz and Jessica Rosenberg. A special huge thank you to Sonya Kaplan for all that she does for the Mikvah! And finally thank you to Adina Hofstedter for her design.

There is no doubt that Rabbi Bistritzky, representing Mikvah USA, spoke so eloquently. I would not even try to repeat what he said, but Mikvah USA raises its money from chasidische Kollel yungerleit and they do it for the zechut of those who are trying to have children! This past week we heard of Rabbi Tzvi Kushelevsky, 88, head of the Heichal Torah Yeshiva in Jerusalem, who became a father for the first time to a ben bechor, Baruch Hashem! And so I call on our community, with complete gratitude to Mikvah USA, to daven for the following people in whose names the funds donated by Mikveh USA to our Mikveh were dedicated, so that they merit to have children or a refuah, Be'ezrat Hashem: Shmuel Menachem ben Tela; David Tzvi ben Golda Hasa; Moshe Yuda ben Rivka Leah Sheindel; Rachel bat Malka and Esther bat Rachel.

Rabbi Bistritzky spoke about Mikvah USA expanding its mission into Israel with Mikvah 4 Israel! Right now, our soldiers are fighting the physical battle for Eretz Yisrael and the release of our hostages. We are faced with defending our religion and our nation throughout the world, alone, as Jews. From the countless stories of real-life miracles experienced on the battlefield, we have an invincible power - the power of connection to a higher source, through prayer, mitzvot and through our unity. This transcendental link allows us to fight the spiritual battle that provides a unique protection for our soldiers on the front line, for bringing our hostages home and for Israel.

But the most important message the Rabbi Bistritzky pleaded for our community was the focus of getting as many families as we can in our community, religious and not, to observe the holy mitzvah of Taharat Mishpacha. Each and every person in our community can help to encourage women to go to Mikvah - even once - so that they too can join the ranks of the spiritual army fighting with our soldiers on the front lines, for Israel, the hostages and the Jewish people!

A few halachic and mechanical issues were discovered erev Shabbat (no good deed goes unpunished) with both mikvahs and are being addressed. Stay tuned. We know everyone is anxious to use the mikvahs and we will keep you posted.

A few things to bring to your attention. Please see the bulletin as we have a Membership Meeting to implement very important constitutional changes, including the size of the board, on Thursday, March 28th after the late maariv. We need 100 members in person or on zoom PLUS the proxies can be designated. Please see page 11 in bulletin for precise details or contact Jeffrey Brown.

Obviously the possibility of a prohibition against Shechita (ritual slaughtering) is a massive issue which the Rav and I are meeting with Melissa Lantsman about this week. We will organize the shul as we learn more.

Join us for Kabbalat Shabbat as we have invited the entire Thornhill community to celebrate a unity davening with us, led by our very own home grown Johnny Shlagbaum who is in town for a family simcha. Big mazel tov to our Treasurer Yaakov and Deena Adatto on the Bat Mitzvah of their daughter Sharona.

INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF PRAYER

Praying for Rain

During the winter months we add a prayer for rain (veten tal umatar livrachah) to the Birkat Hashanim blessing in the Amidah. "Winter months" is a relative term, depending on where on the planet a community happens to be. Given this, how do we decide when to add this prayer to our Amidah?

The Mishnah and Talmud indicate that Chazal instituted two different schedules for praying for rain. These schedules suited the two dominant Jewish communities of the time, Israel and Babylon. Jews in Israel start adding the prayer for rain fifteen days after Sukkot. This is enough time for anyone who came to Jerusalem for the holiday to return home. In Babylon, which is less dependent on rain, the prayer is added starting from sixty days into the winter season (tekufat Tishrei). This comes out to either December fourth or fifth depending on the year. In both places, we stop asking for rain at the last minchah before Pesach. The halachah today is that communities in Israel follow the Israeli schedule and communities everywhere else follow the Babylonian schedule.

What about places in the southern hemisphere where the seasons are reversed and the winter months are June-August? Are these communities prevented from praying for rain? They aren't. These communities can add their prayer for rain in the Shema Kolenu blessing. This addition can even be made during Chazarat HaShatz.

How were the Jewish People feeling upon finishing constructing the Mishkan, the Tabernacle?

Surprisingly, the account of the construction in Pekudei contains no reaction or emotion by Beni Yisrael. Later in Parshat Naso, we see the great joy described in detail. Why is the language so matter of fact and technical this week?

Israel sinned terribly at the Golden Calf. Now is not the time for emotions. Sometimes we simply need to prove our capabilities and only afterwards can we process our feelings and emotions.

The Jewish People made a grave error in worshiping the Golden Calf. A great rift was formed between them and G-d. Moshe Rabbeinu had to plead with G-d on their behalf in order for G-d to give them another chance. In the intervening several months, the entire nation has been working to construct a new home for G-d, the Mishkan. They weren't only working on the physical aspects of G-d's new home and mobile Temple, but were also rebuilding their relationship with G-d.

Upon completion of this monumental task, our Sages (Shemot Rabbah 47:1) tell us that this moment was as joyous as a wedding day. In fact, "on the day of his nuptials and on the day of the joy of his heart" in Song of Songs 3:11 refers to the immense feelings of joy and celebration that were felt when G-d dwelled amongst the Jewish People.

Beth Avraham Yoseph of Toronto Congregation (BAYT) was established in 1985 by a small group of coreligionists who wanted to establish a Thornhill community which together would observe the precepts of the Jewish Religion. A full generation has now grown up in this BAYT community and have become active seniors.

A full generation has now grown up in this BAYT community and have become active seniors. In 2023, 60 BAYT members and their extended families participated in Community Gardening activities, funded through the generosity of the New Horizons for Seniors Grant.

This summer, these families developed a connection to the wider community through the growing of food, and making produce available to those in need, both within the BAYT community and beyond.

By working with Reena and York Region Food Network, produce grown at BAYT was bartered, and in return, squash, zucchini and corn, was made available to BAYT.

Every Thursday during the harvest season, a WhatsApp Group was used to communicate a picture of the available produce, both grown at BAYT and received in barter. The message was simple, "If you need it, take it. If you know someone who needs it, tell them. And please, take from the basket, and not the garden!"

The proposed project "BAYT Community Garden - Heterogeneous Community" is meant to expand the impact of the garden, by moving some BAYT members to an outpost at the Bathurst/Clark Vaughan Public Library site and bring non-synagogue member and the local community at large into Clark Farming Collective, made up of Reena, York Region Food Network and BAYT.

"BAYT Community Garden - Heterogeneous Community" would provide the opportunity for BAYT Seniors who participated in 2022 and/or 2023, to mentor a new cohort of Seniors in 2024.

Together, they will expand the "Growing to Give" gardening initiative, and expand connections with the wider community, while continuing to reduce social isolation endured by BAYT and other community seniors during COVID.

Education for the new volunteers would have the option to be offered virtually or in person. The gardening curriculum has been deployed, at no charge to the BAYT community, by York Region Food Network and Reena, an organization which provides housing, support and employment training opportunities for individuals with developmental disabilities. Both operate within one kilometer of the BAYT synagogue.

I support, BAYT's proposed project and kindly ask for the New Horizons for Seniors program to consider funding this project.

- Maintaining a strong connection to and support of the State of Israel
