Do a husband and wife fulfill mishloach manot by giving a joint gift?

Men and women are separately obligated in all of the mitzvot of Purim. Therefore, husbands and wives are obligated to send their own gifts of mishloach manot, and not to rely on each other's gifts. However, one may ask a spouse to deliver mishloach manot as one's agent.

Children who are above bat and bar mitzvah are also obligated to send their own mishloach manot.

Why do we spend two whole Parshah's describing the instructions of the Mishkan and two more about the construction and implementation?

The value of an experience is often proportional to the effort put into the preparations leading up to it. This is true for weddings, Bar and Bat Mitzvahs, and becomes even more evident when we reach the national scale. Managing to complete a complex construction project in only six months, having everything work out precisely as planned is no small feat. Especially so considering the goal of Mishkan to be a home for G-d's Shechinah, the divine presence, after Bnei Yisrael sinning at the Golden Calf. When everything goes perfectly and G-d's Shechinah descends in a cloud onto the Mishkan at the end of our Parshah and the Book of Shemot, Bnei Yisrael know that all of their efforts were worth it.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

We are all sick of masks. The provincial indoor masking requirement should lift by mid-March. Until then, we cannot choose to disregard the rules. We urge all of you to continue to respect each other's sensitivities and wear masks while inside BAYT. At the same time, if you are uncomfortable with how another member is wearing their mask, please move away rather than risk confrontation.

Just as public speakers we see on TV remove their masks when at the podium, we have been allowing the same for our ba'al tefillah and ba'al korei. We believe this leniency is permissible under the law. But it is not a license for everyone else to do the same. If you have an Aliyah but are concerned about close contact, please make arrangements with the Gabboim.

Keep in mind, approximately 15% of Ontarians are immuno-compromised. This suggests there are more than 100 immuno-compromised BAYT members. For those members who cannot or may not want to go maskless, we anticipate keeping our 830 Shabbat minyan masked and vaxxed minyan once masking protocols are lifted. We are also having early discussions about the need for outdoor minyanim as the weather warms. If anything, we may need the space as more and more people attend BAYT on Shabbat. Your BAYT is buzzing!

We return to the main shul this Shabbat. You will find a brighter and more climate-controlled environment. A big 'shkoach to our renovation committee. Phase Two of the Main Sanctuary renovation, the "waist down" portion, should begin next January when we re-stain, repair and re-upholstering the pews, replace the carpet and install stone tiles on the stairs and bima.

Mizrachi Canada kicked off their Monday night Beit Medrash program this week in the newly freshened Milevsky Beit Medrash followed by a women's program Tuesday evening. Milevsky was packed both nights!

This week the Board approved Vine and Company as our new auditors. This Hamilton firm has deep not-for-profit experience that includes Jewish institutions. I worked with Vine when I served as treasurer of Hamilton Jewish Federation back in 2013. The Board also approved our 2022 budget and a new financing package with RBC. We rolled in our existing leaseback loan, financed the new roof at better terms than originally expected and correspondingly eased our historic cash flow pressures. A big 'shkoach to our treasurer Jonathan Hames and Terry Rubinstein in our office.

This week the sister of one of our friends at Congregation Ayin L'Tzion went missing for nearly 26 hours. Toronto Police put out an alert. This was one of those drop everything moments. After 24 hours, our friends started to line up volunteers for a search. I reached out to UJA Security for assistance coordinating with police. Then word came of a lead. Shortly after, she had been found safe. Police have protocols before they call Ontario Volunteer Emergency Response Team (OVERT) to lead a search and rescue. You may remember OVERT from a few years ago when dozens of you stepped up in a successful search for a missing elderly man from Thornhill. Until police call OVERT, we only have each other at a horrifically hopeless time. B'H, it worked out.

This will be our first Shabbat in Thornhill after spending the past two in our true home, Israel. Our older son Zachary made Aliyah last week. Our younger son, Benjamin, plans to continue his studies at Yeshivat Hesder Lev HaTorah next fall. Ernest and Aviva Segal hosted our mishpacha for both Shabbats. We also caught up with Rabbi and Malka Taub, Warren and Sharon Bean and Lisa and Joel Jakobovits. As Rabbi Korobkin reminds us, last one here, turn out the lights. Hope to beat you home!



Some of you have expressed confusion on how to commemorate yahrzeits that fall in Adar when we have a leap year such as ours. Firstly, I apologize for any lack of clarity in our communications to you. You may have received two emails, informing you of the yahrzeit dates in Adar I and in Adar II. To clarify: When a loved one's yahrzeit is in Adar, Ashkenazic tradition is to commemorate the yahrzeit primarily in Adar I. That said, the Ram"a recommends commemorating the yahrzeit in BOTH Adars, which is the reason for the double dates that some of our members have been receiving. Please let me know if you have any further questions. As always, if the office has an incorrect date for the yahrzeit of your loved one, you can always change the information yourself by logging into bayt.ca and updating your personal information. Alternatively, please contact the office. Thank you!




