PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Elul is Here

A few days before we arrived in Israel, Staff Sgt. Nathan Fitoussi, 20 years old of Netanya, was tragically killed by friendly fire. Nathan was apparently misidentified upon returning to guard a post in the Shomron near the city of Tulkarem. It seems that Nathan went off to daven Maariv by himself and when he returned, his friend mistook him for a foe and a precious life was lost. Protecting the Jewish people comes at a very high price.

It was reported that "The family has no anger toward the soldier who shot. Not only are they not angry with him, they even feel sorry for him and I have no doubt that they would want to meet him," said Meir Fitoussi, a relative of the deceased soldier's father.

This story touched me deeply. Particularly to hear the family make a quick statement saying they were not angry with the soldier who had shot Nathan. Nathan was their only son and he is gone, but nonetheless during shiva, the family wanted to comfort the other soldier, who I am sure is suffering extreme mental anguish and regret, wanting to undo one second of his life.

Words are bullets too. While I really strive to be the Yid I want to be, I know I fail at times. I know I can always do better. Sometimes people get caught in the crossfire and that can be very painful. So I want to start Elul off on a positive side, in memory of Nathan, I'm asking all of you for mechila, for forgiveness. We really have no idea what tomorrow will bring and why should I wait till erev Rosh Hashanah to ask for forgiveness. Better to do it now when it is not rushed. As your President, I'm trying to warm our shul up, and hopefully encourage all our members to try harder.

I really appreciate you taking the time to chat or email or call me. While it is impossible to satisfy everyone, every time on every matter, know that I am listening and remember, Jerusalem was not built in a day. In fact, as I write this from Jerusalem I see much construction all around the city. Jerusalem is building and so am I. Trying to build a future for the BAYT, not for me, but for our children and grandchildren.

And speaking of building, let me thank David Lithwick for completing the front plaza of the BAYT. It looks magnificent. On time and on budget. We now know never to put salt down on the landing and the steps as it completely erodes the concrete, aluminum flashing and bricks.

Thank you to all of you who have renewed your membership for 5783, it is extremely helpful to the office for you to renew early. And I humbly ask, if you can join Binyan HaBAYT, please consider it. Your feedback about how to make the process easier is appreciated and we intend to make it a better experience for next year.

Binyan HaBAYT is tied into the 40th Anniversary Gala, so you can take care of two momentous BAYT highlights for 5783. And there will be no more financial soliciting till 5784. I will solicit you for your spiritual growth. That will never stop.

Who eats first: me, my children or my pets?

Our first obligation is to feed minors who cannot feed themselves. After that, our sages teach that one who owns animals must make sure those animals are fed. Of course, if one's animal does not need food now, there is no requirement to feed it; the rule is only to ensure that the animal's needs are met.

The idea of prioritizing animals is seen in the structure of the Divine promise (Devarim 11:15), "And I will put grass in your fields for your animals, and you will eat and be satisfied." It is also a function of the Torah's concern about preventing pain for animals.

Some authorities contend that the rule of putting animals first applies only when eating a meal; regarding snacks, or taking a drink, the owner may go first.

At the end of the Shemitah year there is Shemitat Kesafim, when all loans are annulled.

Rambam (Hilchot Tzedakka Chapter 10) delineates eight levels of Tzedakah.

"The greatest level, above which there is no greater, is to support a fellow Jew by endowing him with a gift or loan, or entering into a partnership with him, or finding employment for him, in order to strengthen his hand so that he will not need to be dependent upon others"

But if giving a loan is the highest form of tzedakah, why annul it?

It takes a great deal of courage to ask for a loan. And taking that money and using it to get financially independent is no small feat. Sometimes even though the loan was taken with the best of intentions and they were as careful as humanly possible, the venture can still fail. What started as a charity, can quickly turn into a burden that is too great to bear.

If not for the annulment by G-d, the poor person would never be able to look his lender in the eyes. But with God behind him, he is able to stand tall and request the loan knowing that he can do it and stand on his feet.
