

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PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

My Brother's Baggage

On behalf of the Rabbis, the Executive, the Board and the entire membership, I would like to extend our condolences to Karen Zilberberg on the loss of her beloved sister, Donna Gelman z"l (Hesha Bat Hanoch v'Shulamit). May her neshama have an aliyah. May you be blessed with many wonderful memories.

There was much excitement in the Daf Yomi world after the completion of Yevamot, given how long and difficult it is - A seudah was well earned.

Recently, the Daf Yomi chevra were discussing if there was interest in making a siyum to celebrate the completion of Masechet Nedarim which will be completed on the 2nd of Shevat (January 24th).

This group is a small number of our members learning Daf Yomi and it would be really nice to assemble all of the BAYT members learning Daf for a seudah. There are members committed to learning Daf by means outside of the BAYT with Rabbi Rosner, Rabbi Stefanski, Ner Yisroel and many many more which is just amazing. We would like to build a list of the BAYT Daf Yomi Chevra. I too did not participate in Siyumim for a long time, thinking that only the completion of Shas is worthy of a Seudah, but a Masechet? I was wrong. My perspective has completely changed. We are blessed that no matter what we have going on in our lives and our community, completing a Masechet is quite an accomplishment, and we should celebrate. And if that's not enough to motivate you, then it's codified by the Shulchan Aruch (Yoreh Deah 246:26). Rabbi Moshe Isserles rules that on finishing a tractate, it is correct to rejoice and to make a festive meal, and that is classified as a Seudat Mitzvah – a special meal that is similar to the ones eaten on Festival days. This is why there is a custom to light two candles at the Seudat Mitzvah."

Please sign up with Rabbi Lesher rabbi.lesher@bayt.ca. Let's see if we can get our entire Daf membership out for a Seudah when we complete every Masechet, no matter how short or long, difficult or easy, completing the Masechetot of the Shas is worthy of Seudah.

There is so much negative news out there and I just feel like I have to share this story. As many people experienced, trying to get out for the holiday season was quite challenging to say the least. Lots of difficult situations with harsh weather, dangerous roads were closed, and broken luggage belts. We too were caught in the web of lost luggage. Both our bags never made our flight and so the chase began. Seventy-two hours later, one piece of luggage arrived and the second was still nowhere to be found. Fourteen days later, while learning the Daf (how ironic) on Sunday morning, a picture of our luggage with a ragged tag attached appeared on my phone from some random 705 area code and phone number. A person arriving on Saturday afternoon from their holiday saw so much unclaimed luggage in the baggage hall, they had the brilliant idea to take pictures of luggage and send it to mobile numbers listed on the baggage tag, noting exactly where luggage is patiently waiting for someone to find. Neither the airlines nor the airport authority could think of such chochma. What a beautiful act of kindness. These are the kind of stories I would rather share and hear. How satisfying it is to reconnect with my same old baggage, rather than someone else's? I find that inspiring.



I finished the Friday night shemoneh esreih after the chazan, missing the communal Vayechulu. Should I say it myself?

The practice of reciting Vayechulu (Bereishit 2:1-3) as part of maariv on Friday night dates back to the Talmud. The congregation repeats this paragraph after the silent shemoneh esreih for several reasons, including a desire to testify communally to G-d's creation of the world.

Ideally, one should recite Vayechulu with the congregation as testimony, but one should not rush through shemoneh esreih in order to accomplish this.

Because Vayechulu has an element of testimony, some say that one should recite it with at least one other person. However, since this is not truly an act of testimony, a relative may serve as that other person.

One who davens alone should still recite Vayechulu, even though it will not have the trappings of testimony.

<u>D'VAR TORAH</u> <u>BY RABBI METZGER</u>

How did Bnei Yisrael deserve to be redeemed from slavery? Yechezkel (Chapter 20, 23) describes the way they were steeped in idolatry and adultery, being far from the ideal people. So why did G-d redeem them?

At the end of Shemot Chapter 2 (verses 23-25) we see Bnei Yisrael groan from the immense workload and cry out to G-d. Their pleas rise up to G-d, and G-d hears and accepts their cries. G-d then remembers His covenant with Avraham, Yitzchak, and Yaakov. Then G-d sees Israel and then G-d is aware.

Why does the Torah include that G-d needed to hear, remember, see and then know the plight of Bnei Yisrael? Doesn't G-d know everything already in His omniscience?

First and foremost we see the immense power prayer. Even prayer without words, a primal cry, the desperate pleading of an oppressed people is answered regardless of their personal merits or spiritual states at the time. Yet at the same time G-d is modeling for us the steps that would typically need to be taken for a standard request to be acknowledged, yet we as G-d'a people and descendants of the Patriarchs are granted a unique connection to G-d.





The Beth Avraham Yoseph of Toronto Congregation invites our Thornhill neighbours to provide input for the potential development of our property!



Survey Background

Since its inception 40 years ago, the Beth Avraham Yoseph of Toronto (BAYT) Synagogue at 613 Clark Avenue West has fulfilled many roles in contributing to the well-being of the surrounding Thornhill community. The Synagogue looks forward to continuing to be a key pillar of the community for many years to come.

The BAYT Site Development Feasibility Committee (SDFC) is currently examining approaches to continue to contribute to the well-being of members of the BAYT congregation, their families and the vitality of the surrounding Thornhill community.

The BAYT's SDFC believes it is important to consult with the wider Thornhill community and have the community participate in prioritizing unmet community needs and wants, and better understand community concerns with any potential development.

The City of Vaughan development process requires a consultation around 150 meters of the proposed site. The BAYT SDFC has expanded this consultation zone to 500 meters around 613 Clark Avenue West and would also value opinions and directions from beyond the 500-meter mark.

The Committee wishes to emphasize that this is a study only and does not mean that redevelopment of the site will take place; Survey results will be used to guide a number of feasibility studies which will drive out a preferred solution.

If you decide to participate in the survey please know in advance that you will be asked to provide a postal code as a mandatory question, to help confirm your general distance from the synagogue site.

You will also be given the opportunity to optionally identify yourself if you want to stay in touch about the evolution of the BAYT initiative.

At no time have any lists external to BAYT been shared with the BAYT SDFC

All answers will be kept strictly confidential.

The BAYT SDFC has retained the services of SHS Consulting to conduct the survey and the follow-on feasibility study.

The survey should take 10-15 minutes to answer
