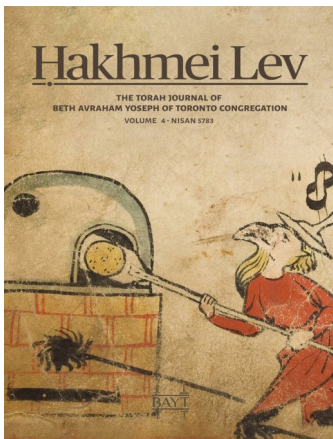

INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA BY

Saying Baruch Shem Kevod Malchuto Le'olam Va'ed

There's a story about Yaakov Avinu on his deathbed that appears multiple times in the midrash. Yaakov is concerned that some of his children will not serve G-d after his death. He challenges their commitment to G-d. In response, his sons declare, "shema Yisrael (listen our father Yisrael) Hashem Elokeinu (just as you are following God, so too Hashem is our God) Hashem echad (Hashem is one)." Upon hearing this, Yaakov responds with, "baruch shem kevod malchuto le'olam va'ed".

This is why we say "baruch shem" after the first verse of the Shema. We say it quietly in deference to Moshe Rabbeinu's formulation of the Shema that doesn't include it.

Some interpret these words as Yaakov praising G-d. Others see them as a fundamental part of declaring G-d's unity, completing the first verse of the Shema.

The significance of reciting "baruch shem" raises a halachic question as well. Can one fulfill reciting the Shema without it? According to some authorities, omitting this phrase or reciting it without proper intention invalidates the fulfillment of the mitzvah. The Mishnah Berurah rules that if the phrase is recited without intention one should repeat it. However, if one has already started the next paragraph one need not repeat the Shema. This is true even if "baruch shem" was omitted entirely.

G-d commands us to install judges and officers in every city to give out judgments of Tzedek. We are also told "Tzedek Tzedek Tirdof", to chase after Tzedek. But what is Tzedek?

While we often think of Tzedek as in Tzaddik, a pious individual, Tzedek in law and judgment means a fair and correct ruling. But who is responsible for ensuring the case's decision is correct?

The initial assumption would be that this responsibility falls upon the shoulders of the judges alone to rule impartially and correctly to the best of their abilities. Rashi quotes the Gemara Sanhedrim 32b Midrash that it is not only upon the judge, but the people seeking to have their case heard should seek out the finest Beit din they can.

Rabbi Yosef Bekhor Shor succinctly explains that each of the "Tzedeks" contains a warning: first to the judges to judge precisely and second to the claimants to choose a proper court of judges.

To properly balance the scales of judgment we need the involvement of both the appointees and those who appoint them. We need a society pursuing justice together, no matter where they sit or stand in a courtroom.

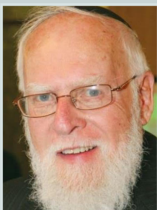

Rabbi Dr. Sholom Gold was a native of Williamsburg, NY, where he attended Yeshiva Torah Vodaath. He continued his learning at Yeshivas Ner Yisroel in Baltimore and at the Ponevezh Yeshiva and Chevron Yeshiva in Israel. He received his rabbinic ordination from Chief Rabbi Isaac Halevy Herzog and from HaRav Yaacov Yitzchak Ruderman, in addition to receiving a doctorate in Talmudic Letters from Ner Yisroel. In 1959 Rabbi Gold founded the Ner Yisroel Yeshiva College and Congregation B'nai Torah in Toronto. In 1971, he accepted the position as spiritual leader of Young Israel of West Hempstead. He built one of the first eruvim in North America, which quickly became a model for communities worldwide. In 1982 the Golds fulfilled their dream of making aliyah, where Rabbi Gold was the founder and Rav of Kehilat Zichron Yosef of Har Nof, Jerusalem, and founder and dean of the Avrom Silver Jerusalem College for Adults. His memoir, Touching History, is a modern classic in the history of 20th century Jewish America.
