# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

### Ani L'Dodo V'Dodi Li - Young Families

It was two years ago, that I approached four young family members who I heard had grievances with the shul. I asked if they would be interested in sharing their concerns with me. I explained that I had no BAYT authority but I wanted to hear first hand what was on their minds. Very quickly, word spread in the young family community that there was going to be a zoom meeting and the four individuals asked if more people could join. In the end, more than thirty couples joined and it was the beginning of a long and meaningful dialogue that played a large role in my wanting to be super involved in the BAYT.

We were about six months into Covid and home schooling via zoom had completed the year. I had a tremendous amount of respect for these young parents given all the unknowns they were facing. I could not stop thinking of what I would do had our kids had been that age. Esther and I have eight children. I was sure that I would have eaten all of them so my admiration for them was extremely high. In the back of my mind, I was wondering how were they coping financially as well. The stress must have been a massive challenge. I knew I wanted to help, but was unsure exactly how.

For the past two years, I have invested a lot of my energy to the well being of our Young Families. I have met so many wonderful husbands, wives and children in the BAYT and Thornhill community that I otherwise would never have gotten to know. Our three daughters of that age had moved to the States, so while I knew many of the them, I didn't really know them casually. I quickly realized that the loss was mine. And so a lot of my focus has been cultivating the future of these families. The BAYT has Eitz Chaim on one side and Netivot on the other. The future of the BAYT right in our backyard. All we have to do is listen and engage. Last year, we had over six hundred children attend latke night once again. Saturday night learning has had over seventy kids and parents.

The Bat Mitzvah program was a tremendous success. And of course there is the amazingly growing Young Family minyan and Youth Programs. The Stein's have shown tremendous love and leadership for our children and I know they are planning to come out of the blocks running at full speed because they understand the importance of our most precious commodity at the BAYT and that is our children and grandchildren. It is impossible to make up for lost time, but the Stein's are committed to ensuring that not a second is wasted as we invest in the spiritual growth of the youth and that also means making sure that the parents know that the Executive and Board are completely engaged. I remember that some of my greatest memories growing up at Bnai Torah were davening on Shabbat morning, floor hockey and skating on Motzei Shabbat.

The Rav and I have spent a lot of time figuring out the right balance for the Young Family minyan. We are focused on the importance of providing a serious quiet atmosphere where parents and children can daven, learn and grow spiritually. And just as important, but not during davening, create a social home at the BAYT with amazing kiddishes. We will get this right. It may take some time and tweaking. Your feedback is always welcome.

Please pay close attention to all the activities going on around the BAYT. It is like watching the BAYT garden grow. The more beloved we are with our Young Families and Youth, the more beloved they will be with the BAYT.

What happens to money people owe me when the shemitah year ends this Rosh Hashanah?

The Torah states that we should allow loans to expire unclaimed every seven years, with the shemitah year. We are instructed to cancel these debts, and not to pursue their collection. There is some debate regarding the applicability of these laws in a time when the laws of *yovel* do not apply, but the general consensus is that they continue to apply at least rabbinically, and perhaps biblically.

Loans are nullified at Rosh Hashanah at the end of the shemitah year. Note that only loans that were due for collection before that time are cancelled; loans that are due later are not cancelled.

There is an option for preserving loans and collecting payment. The *prozbul* document, formalized by Hillel, enables loans to survive shemitah. Ideally, a prozbul should be drafted before the shemitah year begins, but it may also be prepared during the shemitah year. For prozbul guidance, please see the Rav.

# D'VAR TORAH BY RABBI METZGER

Why can't you plant trees or make a monument near the Beit HaMikdash or the Mizbeach? (Devarim 16:21-22) Isn't it beautiful to have wood everywhere or a solitary stone pillar?

The Sefer HaChinuch (Mitzvah 492) quotes the Rambam that these manners of beautification have no place near these holy places because that was the way of idolatrous people. Often, this would translate into the worship of the items themselves. When we encounter G-d through prayer and worship and feel connected to Him as strongly as we would in the Beit HaMikdash or by placing korbanot on the Mizbeach, we cannot have other beautiful symbols distracting us from experiencing the divine.

This does not mean that we cannot have beautiful shuls or Beit Midrash, but it does mean that when we think about where we daven beauty shouldn't be the only thing in our mind. Instead, we should focus on creating an environment that enables us to become closer to G-d.
