On Motzaei Shabbat leading into Yom Tov, what sort of candle do I use for havdalah?

When Shabbat leads into Yom Tov, as it does on the second night of Pesach (outside of Israel) this year, we recite havdalah as part of kiddush.

Most people don't light a special Havdalah candle, for two reasons:

On Yom Tov we may light candles from an existing flame for our personal use, but this candle would only be used for a mitzvah, not for our physical pleasure, and

We may not extinguish fire on Yom Tov, and leaving a standard, long-lasting Havdalah candle burning would be inconvenient.

Instead, most people use the light of the Yom Tov candles. [Note that one must either daven maariv or recite "Baruch HaMavdil bein kodesh l'kodesh" before lighting these candles, and we light them from an existing flame.]

Some people join two of their Yom Tov candles to create a multi-wicked flame for Havdalah, but this may create halachic problems. Therefore, most people leave the candles as they are, and simply recite the berachah beside them and make use of their light that way. One should follow one's family custom.

Why would someone get tzaraat?

Many are familiar with the opinion of Rabbi Yoss Ben Zimra, that tzaraat is a punishment for speaking Lashon Hara, talking about someone negatively behind their backs even though it is true. The Gemara Arachin (15-16a) gives several other options as well. Reish Lakish explains that it is caused by being Motzi Shem Ra – giving someone a bad name based on untrue and unfounded rumors.

Rabbi Yochanan says that there are 7 different reasons:

1) Lashon Hara 2) murder 3) oaths taken in vain 4) forbidden sexual relations 5) arrogance 6) theft 7) stinginess

But why do we get a physical malady for a spiritual sin?

Rabbi David Zvi Hoffman (1843-1921, Germany) explains that Tzaraat generates Tumah, ritual impurity, because the outward appearance of the disease is the symbolic image of the sinner. G-d manifests our sins in a way that we can see precisely how bad our sins, thereby rendering us impure and requiring us to leave the Israelite camp.

Tzaraat and its purity and impurity may be confusing, but knowing where you stand spiritually can help put us on the right path. While tzaraat and Tumah are not part of our daily lives, interpersonal relationships are. May we take the message of Tzaraat and use our personal power for the greater good.

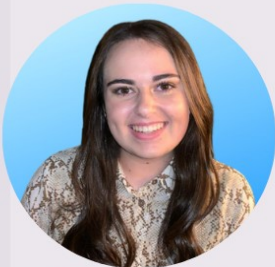
