

## Parshas Tetzaveh D'var Torah By Rabbi Stein

In this week's Parsha, Parshas Tetzaveh, we read all about the Bigdei Kohanim, as well as the Bigdei Kahuna. What is interesting to note is that the Torah distinctly identifies the uniform of sorts of the Kohanim. Many of us might not have paid much attention to this, but what stands out to me is that by having a uniform dress code, it is much easier to identify who is a Kohen, and Levi etc. Much like it is easy for us to identify a civil servant like a police officer, firefighter or paramedic by the uniform that they wear. If we were to look one step further, we could add that the purpose of the Bigdei Kohanim was also to remind the Kohanim, who it is they are serving, that as a Kohen in the Beit Hamikdash, they had to be on call for the people to be ready to serve, and that they are the bridge between the people and Hashem. Our appearance also plays a major role towards our first impressions with others and how we conduct ourselves in the greater world. May we learn from this that all that we do, should be to give Kavod and Honour to Hashem as well as us (the Individual) Shabbat Shalom!
