Does a mourner send or receive Mishloach Manot?

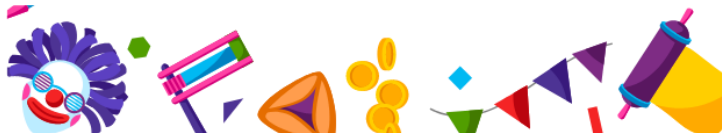
Sending: Even though the mitzvah of sending mishloach manot is joyous, a mourner is still obligated to send them, and even during shivah. However, the mourner should not send items like wine and special delicacies, which involve extra joy.

Receiving: One should not send to someone who is within the periods of required mourning for a parent or other relative r"l. However, a mourner who receives mishloach manot is not required to refuse them. One may send to a mourner's immediate family members, where the sender has a relationship with them.

One may send to a needy mourner as a form of tzedakah. Also, one may send to a mourner who holds a professional position in which it is expected that people will send mishloach manot as a means of financial support.

May we know happy occasions.

Why do we read about King Shaul's failed war on Amalek and his being stripped of the kingship in our Haftorah? Granted, it goes along with the reading of Parshat Zachor, remembering what Amalek did when they ambushed us in the desert and why we must destroy them as per G-d's command, but why read specifically about Shaul's folly?

We are commanded to remember what Amalek did to us, and are enjoined to wipe them out because G-d told us to. The ethics of doing so if not for the direct instruction of G-d would be difficult to explain. When Shaul doesn't fully listen to G-d's command to not take any spoils or spare the lives of Amalek, choosing instead to spare the Amalekite King Agag and utilize the sheep as sacrifices as per the people's request, he completely misses the point. We need to listen to G-d's explicit directives especially when our actions are extremely emotionally charged. Justice can easily turn into vengeance if not acted upon correctly. Shaul doubled down on his mistake when he refused to admit wrongdoing, choosing to blame the people instead of admitting his own weakness. We need to remember this Shabbat Zachor not only what atrocities Amalek committed but remember that our actions need to align with what G-d expects of us.
