



ANNOUNCEMENTS

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE:

Last Shabbat, I thanked the Perlis Hall minyan for its patience regarding COVID restrictions. COVID has been one of our more stressful challenges on many fronts. We follow the rules. No more, no less. While many had asked, we declined to voluntarily adopt the vaccine passport program. Until Premier Ford modifies the emergency regulations, we all need to continue to wear masks completely covering our mouth and nose while inside BAYT and otherwise not eating at a kiddush, kibud or simcha. Thank you for your continued patience. And if it's wearing thin, may I suggest you send an email to Premier Ford or MPP Gila Martow.

Moving on to brighter matters, we have taken advantage of the lockdown to replace our original and very leaky roof and to begin Phase One of the Main Sanctuary renovations. Both are nearing completion.

In the Main Sanctuary, we removed 40 year-old wallpaper. Yes, it was peeling, but it was difficult to remove. We re-plastered and painted the walls using bright yet understated colors that match with the downstairs renovation a couple of years ago.

Humidity and water leaks badly damaged the ceiling which is also being refreshed. We also installed a mechanism to ensure humidity does not damage the new ceiling and wood work.

We replaced the old, energy inefficient lighting fixtures in the Main Shul with brighter, high efficiency LED fixtures that can be dimmed for weddings.

We completed an extensive professional review of our heating and air conditioning system to better understand air flow and why the women's section was either too hot or too cold. We installed new duct work to more evenly heat and cool both the men's and women's sections. We are confident everyone will notice a difference.

Phase Two of the Main Sanctuary renovation should begin next January. We plan to re-stain, repair and re-upholstering the pews. We will replace the original carpet and install stone tiles on the stairs and bima.

Thank you for your patience. We look forward to reopening the Main Sanctuary the first week of March. Hope to see you there!

When do we stop adding "ul'chaparat pasha" to the musaf amidah of Rosh Chodesh?

In the musaf amidah of Rosh Chodesh we make a series of requests – for life, peace, etc. In early siddurim, this series of requests included a request "ul'chaparat pasha" ["and for atonement of sin"] on every Rosh Chodesh, possibly because we bring a special sin offering on Rosh Chodesh.

In our communities, "ul'chaparat pasha" is included only during leap years. Some suggest that it was removed from the liturgy of normal years so that the normal Rosh Chodesh amidah would contain twelve requests, parallel to the year's normal twelve months, and in a year with a leap month we would add a thirteenth. Others suggest that this request was kept only for leap years in order to request atonement for the rabbinic court which added a month to the year, in case they erred in their calculations.

Some communities add "ul'chaparat pasha" every Rosh Chodesh of the leap year, Tishrei through Elul, but our practice is to add it only through Rosh Chodesh Adar II (inclusive), perhaps because Nisan really begins the next year. We do not include "ul'chaparat pasha" before Tishrei at the start of the leap year, though, because the rabbinical court does not announce the leap month until after Rosh haShanah.

Why Aharon?

Aharon and his sons are chosen to be the Cohanim, the priests, who will serve G-d in the Mishkan. But why were they selected? Why does Moshe need to bring them closer to him?

Rabbi Avraham Ibn Ezra explains that until this point Moshe has effectively been serving as the Cohen Gadol, taking care of all sacrifices and interceding on Bnei Yisrael's behalf. While the most natural thought would be because of the role that Aharon played in supporting Moshe during the Exodus and having served as Moshe's aide and interpreter, Rabbi Avraham Ibn Ezra rejects this in favor of it being based on Aharon being brother-in-law of Nachshon Ben Aminadav. Due to the familial connection Nachshon will be better able to atone for Bnei Yisrael. Furthermore, Bnei Yisrael has been turning to Moshe for teaching and guidance until now.

According to Rabbi Ibn Ezra, Aharon isn't chosen to be Cohen simply as a reward for his role until now, but rather as an expectation for his and his families capabilities to atone for and educate Bnei Yisrael. What defines Aharon isn't his past but his potential as a peacemaker for all of Israel.




