

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

Pashas Toldos Entrap and Trick

Mark Frischman has been involved in the Rules, Regulations and By-Laws Committee for years. These announcements give me an opportunity to thank Howard Mammon who is the Executive Director of the Toronto Hebrew Memorial Parks, for all his amazing dedication to the greater Jewish community.

An evening of Tefillah and Inspiration was held last week at the BAYT. I am told that there were about 1,500 women in attendance. There was no parking from Chabad Gate on York Hill, and down all the side streets. Of course, the BAYT parking lot was full. The Jewish people are amazing when we unite. Yishar Koach to the all the organizers for an amazing event. May all our prayers be answered.

Last Shabbat was very meaningful as we recognized our Canadian Armed Services with our very own Rabbi Glogauer who recited the prayer for our brave Canadian soldiers past and present. It was very neat to be at the Chabura minyan where Rabbi Geoffrey Haber was in his full US army uniform as he served as a US Chaplain before coming to Toronto where he now works at Baycrest. I have to say that the US Chaplain uniform is spectacular and I look forward to seeing Rabbi Haber in uniform next year. We have to get a pic of Rabbis Glogauer and Haber in uniform.

I'm sure many of you attended both the rally in Toronto and in Washington this past week. Being in Christie Pits certainly had a historic feeling but I felt like we were preaching to the converted and should have held a more public location like City Hall or parading down Yonge Street letting the world know that we will not sit idle as we demand the return of our hostages. Of course being at the Washington Mall was very special. Singing. Dancing. Prayers. Inspiration. There was no violence. No vandalism. No destruction of property. No climbing White House walls. No burning of flags. Lots of American and Israeli flags. A peaceful gathering.

It was great to be with so many Yidim from all walks of life, all with one message to Free our Hostages, Bring them Home Now! I don't know about the actual numbers, but it was a moment that I will never forget. It reminded me of the rally I attended with my father when I was very young demanding the release of Anatoly Sharansky which eventually occurred many years later. So I really had chills when Natan Sharansky was one of the speakers at the rally in Washington. He asked rhetorically how do we keep going? And I cannot think of a better person to turn to for guidance and he profoundly said, "We do it together as one. One fighting family. One outcome. Our victory". He spoke about being in solitary confinement and what he thought about being so alone. While he could not hear our rallies, he knew that we would not leave him behind, just like we will not leave our hostages behind. They feel us. I certainly hope so.

The Rav and I bumped into an old congregant of the Rav back in LA at the rally by the name of Emil Fish, known as Mr. Bardiov. It was very eerie as I overheard him say he was from Bardiov which made my ears open wide. Esther's father was from Bardiov and this was at the rally, on my father-in-law's fourteenth yahrzeit. Instantly, I felt how if I have not done enough to stop antisemitism. I felt that if I have not done enough to stop antisemitism, I have failed the survivors of the Holocaust, like Shimon Berglas z"I and my father z"I.

Who cannot be so impressed with Rabbi Rafi Lipner who in days arranged two chartered flights to Washington. Unfortunately, they were cancelled as they could not get a landing slot given the number of flights scheduled into DC for the rally. "Air Lipner" as it was being affectionately called arranged to watch the Rally at the Posluns theatre for those who were on the cancelled flights. It sure doesn't always go the way we intend to, but Rabbi Lipner continued to make lemonade. The greatest airline never to have wind under its wings and still got rave reviews. Well done!

It is very appropriate in this week's parsha of Toldot, we are told that Eisav is "Ish Tsayid", a man who knows trapping, a man of the field. Rashi tells us that Eisav was the one who knew how to entrap and trick his father Yitzchak with his mouth. He would ask him questions to deceive him, such as, "Father, how does one tithe salt and straw?" Yes, we sure know that Eisav is a man of trapping. Eisav have trapped the entire world into disbelieving what our very own eyes see. We will continue to conduct ourselves with pride, never fearing, demanding the unconditional release of our hostages, as we continue to stand proudly and daven, give tzedakah and better ourselves. We will continue to be a light onto the nations.



Repeating the Shema After Early Maariv

We mentioned previously that the earliest time to read the evening Shema is nightfall (tzeit hakochavim). However, Maariv itself doesn't have this limitation. According to the position of Rabbi Yehudah in the Mishnah, Maariv can be said up to 1.25 halachic hours before nightfall.

This is something we do in the summertime when nightfall is late, especially on Shabbat. This discrepancy begs the question of whether and how to recite Shema when Maariv is said early.

At first glance, there doesn't seem to be any value in reciting the Shema early. According to almost all authorities, one does not fulfill their obligation by doing this. However, there is an ancient and currently universal practice of reciting the Shema when praying an early Maariv.

The practice is even mentioned in the Talmud Yerushalmi. The Talmud explains that the goal of reciting the Shema in such a case is not to fulfill the mitzvah, but rather to set the context for praying by reciting words of Torah.

If the early Shema doesn't count, how does one fulfill the Shema in such a case? There are many opinions, but the accepted one is to wait until after nightfall and recite the three paragraphs of the Shema again without the blessings. According to some, one should explicitly intend not to fulfill the mitzvah of Shema during the early recitation and intend to fulfill it during the later one.

What led Esav to disgrace his birthright and sell it to Yaakov?

The simplest explanation is that Esav was simply exhausted from the fields and not thinking properly, but that wouldn't mean he deliberately disgraced his birthright.

Rabbi Avraham Ibn Ezra offers that Esav excuses the "deal" by saying that he's going to die anyway. Esav doesn't mean to say that he's dying or sick on his deathbed, he just knows that as a hunter of wild game, his life can be suddenly cut short and therefore doesn't see the value of his birthright.

Ramban on the other hand says that Esav disgraces the birthright because of the cruelty in his heart, not an external force or improper evaluation of its worth.

Rabbi Yaakov Medan, one of the Roshei Yeshiva of Yeshivat Har Etzion in his article "Esav's Merit" presents a more complex picture. Esav's initial potential matched King David. Both David and Esav are described as having 400 men, red hair and ruddy complexion, and prowess as warriors. Yitzchak entrusted Esav, his favored son, with protecting the flocks. But today Esav was too exhausted from constantly having the moral high ground while the Philistine shepherds undercut his father. According to Midrash Breishit Rabbah, he returned home from comitting murder, illiciit relations, and idolsatry before he sold his birthright to Yaakov. While he was initially on the right path, that day Esav fully abandoned his morality. David almost committed the same error in Shmuel II Chapter 23, if not for the helpful advice of Avigayil.

We must maintain the hands of Esav while retaining the moral voice of Yaakov. We must listen to all of the advice and support we need to ensure we remain on the right track.


