1987 - THE BIRTH OF THE BAYT BULLETIN

As remembered by Dr. Alan Fink:

It made perfect sense to me why Joel Miskin, who was the Chairman at that time, asked Peter Zeisler, because of his professional background to be my partner to be Bulletin Editors. I must admit that my having a degree as a Physician and Surgeon was of no help to me for this undertaking. In Junior High School, I took a typing course and by the end of the course I was still making the same number of mistakes and could not type any more words per minute than I could at the beginning. The key I used most often is the DEL key. Many years have passed since I took the typing course but regrettably my typing skills have not improved. When I was Bulletin Editor, Word was on multiple floppy discs (how many of you know what a floppy disc was?). A different disc needed to be inserted into the hard drive depending on what functions you needed to use. I was told to use a spreadsheet programme to do the weekly schedule (what is a spreadsheet?). My first attempt at doing the spreadsheet came back from Rabbi Taub with all the times crossed out. It was my responsibility to get the articles and type them up. It was Peter's responsibility to make everything look pretty. I am happy to say that together we managed to produce many Bulletins during our time of being Bulletin Chairmen.

As remembered by Peter Zeisler:

The BAYT community not only provided my family with the Jewish community we desired, but also welcomed me to get involved in helping it grow. The Shul, then in it's old home on Bevshire, was growing fast but still depended on a single page leaflet given out weekly at the Shul, for davening times and

important info. Learning opportunities, special events and youth activities were also announced as one page flyers so I approached the then Chairman Joel Miskin and offered to help produce a more inclusive monthly bulletin. He got the Shul Board to create a Bulletin Committee and asked Dr. Alan Fink and I to co-chair it. We created the BAYT BULLETIN to contain messages from Rabbi Taub, the President, the Chairman, some of the Executive and included Adult & Youth programs along with educational info for the Shul community. The biggest challenge to us was the 4 to 5 week schedule, that took up the 2 page center spread. It was almost always being updated right up to, and sometimes past the publication deadline.

My co-Editor Alan Fink provided me with the hand-typed text set in the new column width and I designed the layout & photocopied pictures then cut & pasted it all up on my old drafting table. After proofreading and final corrections the new art was photocopied, collated & folded by hand, and finally distributed by us and a few volunteers to homes of BAYT members.

A lot has changed over the 20 years I worked on the BAYT BULLETIN. The design and name on the masthead, frequency of publishing, introduction of ads and of course, colour. My computers, scanner and internet has replaced Alan's typewriter and my drafting table. Even the home delivery has been taken over by someone called 'the cloud'. The next time you look a the bulletin, think of its history and enjoy.

What kinds of Torah-related papers may not be discarded in the trash?

The Torah warns us not to treat Hashem in the way we treat foreign gods; this includes acts which desecrate Hashem's written Name, such as erasure or disposal in the trash. The "Name" includes: י-הוה, א-ל, א-לוה, א-לוה, א-לוה, א-לוה, א-לוהים, א-לוהים, א-לוהים, א-דוני, י-ה, ש-די, צבא-ות. יה, ש-די, צבא-ות. suffixes. Rabbinically, one may not erase texts of Tanach, and rabbinic commentary on them, even if they do not contain Hashem's Name.

Addressing some common questions:

Words and acronyms that are invented to represent Hashem's Name, such as a double-yud, may be erased in a case of need. The same is true for the B"H that some people include at the start of a letter.

If a hyphen is inserted into Hashem's Name, erasure is permitted.

Halachic authorities debate the status of Hashem's Name translated into another language.

The word "shalom" may be erased, so long as the context makes clear that it is not a reference to Hashem.

Some halachic authorities are lenient regarding texts which are produced without intent for sanctity, such as a newspaper.

What is the correct way to raise and educate children?

Upon reaching maturity Yaakov and Esav, despite both being children of Rivka and Yitzchak, head in very different directions. One becomes a hunter and man of the fields, the other a simple man who dwells amongst the tents. Were there any portents to their different developments?

Rabbi Shimshon Raphael Hirsch explains that Yitzchak and Rivka raised their sons identically, even though they should have used variegated methods and followed "chanoch linear Al pi darko," "educate each youth according to their path" (Mishlei 22:6).

Rabbi Hirsch points out that we have much to learn from our great ancestors, even from their weaknesses and mistakes. Learning from every aspect serves to uplift and increase the value of Torah and its message for subsequent generations. Yaakov learned from his parents' educational methods and by the end of his life gave varied and tailor-made blessings to each of his sons. He accounts for the individual strength and inclinations of each child because each one has his own unique path.

Finding the correct manner of education and instruction is never easy. Oftentimes we think we have found the best method and are tempted to simply "copy and paste" it. Unfortunately, the trail we must blaze is not so simple. Luckily we can look to previous generations for inspiration and stand upon the shoulders of giants in pursuing the proper avenue.

Report from the Site

Years in design, over a year and a half in construction and home plate just about in sight. People ask where I hang my hat everyday and seem surprised to know that for the last 20 months I've had an office in the white construction trailer in back of the new building. An unusual and educational experience for an architect to witness first hand the birth of his structure on a daily basis.

It was over six years ago that J. T. and I would spend hours together Saturday nights, Sunday mornings creating what was destined to be our spectacular synagogue structure.

So many personalities later, designers, architects, engineers later, so many meetings, drawings and endless papers later and here we finally are, the last push. Final details, coordination and supervision moving at an increasingly quicker pace.

What began 20 months ago with me alone in a huge construction trailer is finishing with an on site coordinating team of 6 in 3 construction trailers.

There have been moments, I must admit, I've walked the half-built halls visualizing ourselves and our children, walking here, davening there, waiting for the elevator, using the Library, davening ... Yet the hourly pressures of doing it, getting it done somehow cloud the inner desire of wanting it finished already.

With such a great myriad of diverse professionals and trades involved and it's wonderous even to me how everything comes together. Each item from the fastening devices to the marble covered ark involves decisions, multiplied by the hundreds and hundreds of separate items gives a small idea of the responsibilities that keep the stress levels running high for all concerned on site.

The satisfaction that makes it all worth while is the reaction of a future Kalah or a member or of anyone from the community who often come and ask to see the facilities. Toronto has come of age and Baruch Hashem we have a facility for the times!


