

Parshas Terumah D'var Torah By Rabbi Stein

In this weeks Parsha, Parshas Terumah, we read about the commandments to construct the Mishkan, the Aron, as well as other fundamental elements in the Beis Hamikdash. What is interesting to note is the expression that the Torah uses when it gives B'nai Yisroel this command. The Torah says "דָּבַר אֶל־בְּנֵי יִשְׂרָאֵל וַיִּקְחוּ־לִי" Hashem commands Moshe to take the contributions from the people that "have a giving heart". It seems a little strange how we can make this distinction that we could fathom that there are members of B'nai Yisroel that wouldn't want to give, and therefore possibly exclude people from giving towards the Beis Hamikdash. We could entertain this thought, but in reality, at this point our mefarshim explain that everyone gave as we see from the commentary of the Ben Ish Chai, who quotes that in essence "ה' יודע שכל לבבות דורש ה'", that in the true essence of man, we are always wanting to serve and seek out ways to serve Hashem. I think that the underlying message here is that we all may have different ways of acting or completing the task at hand, and in the end of the day, as long as we are working on our relationship with Hashem, we are going in the right direction, and thereby fulfilling the other Pasuk "וַעֲשׂוּ לִי מִקְדָּשׁ וְשָׁכַנְתִּי בְּתוֹכָם"
