Over the course of the last two years we completed studying Neviim and Ketuvim through the OU Women's Initiative, Torat Imecha Nach Yomi program. Nach Yomi, led by Executive Director, Rebbetzin, Dr. Adina Shmidman is the world's largest virtual Navi classroom comprised of over 10,000 women worldwide from 39 countries and 524 cities.

We had the opportunity to learn from women whose breadth and knowledge of bikiut and other areas of learning inspired us along our journey.

The initial motivations for joining Nach Yomi on the most basic levels included an opportunity to learn and review the Navi taught to us many years ago in Junior High and High School and not so commonly learnt Sefarim, learn for the merit of a refua shlama for members of the community and to set a fixed time for Torah study.

We could not possibly have foreseen the impact of our learning on our spiritual and intellectual growth, our davening, connection to Am Yisroel and the chizuk given to us since the events of October 7.

“A prophecy that is necessary for generations is written.”

Neviim and Ketuvim are a living history book. A legacy. They connect us to the past and inform our future.

The importance of knowledge of our history and ties to Eretz Yisroel and the ability to pass this down to the next generation cannot be overstated.

We encourage other women to join the new cycle of Nach Yomi. As of this Shabbat we will be learning Perek 14 in Shoftim. It's an easy place to start. You can catch up at your leisure.

We are looking forward to creating a Toronto Chapter of the OU Women's Initiative, Torat Imecha Nach Yomi to share our love of learning, support each other on our journey and celebrate Siyums as a group.

# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

## Adat B'nai Yisrael

We are very excited as the official opening ceremony for the BAYT Mikvah and Keilim Mikvah will take place on Sunday at 4pm. We urge you to attend this momentous occasion and express your appreciation to all who made this happen. The Mikvahs are stunning! A huge thank you to our sponsors, especially Mikvah USA. We look forward to all of you attending this special event. The Keilim Mikvah will be open on Monday morning for members. Your fobs will open the Keilim Mikvah. Stay tuned for the opening date of the main Mikvah.

As many by now know, the BAYT was chosen as the venue for the Douglas Murray event last week. It was attended by over 1,300 people. Many of you asked why the BAYT did not advertise it. It was not a BAYT event and we had a non-disclosure regarding the event and location of the event which was only revealed to paid and registered attendees less than 24 hours before the event. This was done to keep the antisemites away. Tafsik posted to the public that the event was being held downtown and thankfully the event was quiet. Some questioned whether we made money. The BAYT has a fee schedule and they were charged as any event. Tafsik was responsible for security in conjunction with the BAYT security team and all did an amazing job.

As you are aware, there have been some Israel real estate events in the community, one of them at the BAYT to take place on Thursday (I write my column on Wednesdays.) Last Friday morning, many forwarded the evil posters, tweets and comments regarding the upcoming event at Aish (moved from Dani) and BAYT. By noon, we were in full gear preparing for the event at the BAYT, including a Zoom call with the Executive to ensure that we would be prepared for what was to come. Our Mayor, Steven Del Duca beat me to the punch once again. I was going to call him after my FaceTime to my kids before Shabbat and the Mayor's number popped up while talking to my grandchildren. He ensured me that the police force is going to protect the community, as it always has. I cannot say enough regarding their complete support to uphold the law as the antisemites continue to incite hatred against and intimidation of the Jewish Community.

The Mayor was invited to come to Shul this Shabbat morning but that is uncertain as his father passed away on Tuesday. We send our condolences to the Mayor and may he be filled with wonderful memories of his dad. When I first met the Mayor with the Rav, he spoke so beautifully about his father and what it meant to grow up in Vaughan and how proud he was of him. It was very touching. A moment I was privileged to have with him, just because I was President of the BAYT at the time he was seeking the mayorship. Weeks later, his dream came true and we have had a wonderful relationship since. I will let you know when he will be visiting us for Shabbat next. We are also working on a fireside chat for a Sunday evening as well in the near future. Stay tuned.

Last Saturday night, members of the Italian-Canadian community from across Canada came together in anticipation to greet PM Meloni & PM Trudeau but instead were spat on, physically assaulted, and verbally abused. It was absolutely disgusting and unacceptable. Toronto police are reviewing the protest that prompted the cancellation of the Prime Minister's reception. How convenient to cancel and review protocol after the fact. Member of Parliament Kevin Vuong wrote, "First they came for the Jews, yesterday they came for the Italians. Who will be next? History has shown us that what starts with the Jews never ends with the Jews. We must stand together, #UnitedAgainstHate, to ensure history does not repeat itself." Amen!

We have completed the last fundraising campaign for two amazing causes, The IDF Widows and Orphans and Beit Halochem led by our ambassadors Randy & Esti Cohen, Marc & Michelle Factor, Michael & Ruthie Mammon, Yossi & TK Rosenblum and Esther and myself. While money is trickling in, even though it is closed, we have surpassed \$170,000! Thank you to all. A huge yashar koach. We now move on to taking care of our own community for Purim and Pesach.

And finally, nothing is coincidental. I would bet that every Rabbi will touch on a particular theme on the first pasuk in this week's parsha, but how can one not? Vayakhel. Moshe assembled ALL the community of Israel. That's how the leadership of the BAYT felt as we prepared for the rally. It took the massacre of October 7th for the Jewish community to rally for Israel since the evil of antisemitism around the world has risen but particularly in front of a place of worship, our home, the BAYT. It is no coincidence that Hamas supporters spew their verbal rockets at the Jewish community just like their mentors who launch their rockets from places of worship, schools and hospitals. It's also noteworthy that these protestors behave like murderers and robbers masking their faces.

Moshe assembled the people after the sin of the calf to present the second set of tablets and commanded us to build the Tabernacle, a place of worship. ## INTRODUCTIONS TO THE LAWS OF PRAYER

### Havinenu - The Short Amidah

The Amidah that we say on weekdays has eighteen blessings. However, this is not the only version of the daily prayers. The Talmud discusses a shortened version of the Amidah called Havinenu. In this version, the first three and final three blessings are the same. The middle blessings are condensed into one long blessing that mentions the themes of all the others. Havinenu should only be recited when one is under duress, distracted, or feels they won't be able to recite the full-length Amidah with proper intention. It is intended as a way for people in these situations to still pray properly with intention.

Havinenu cannot be recited for Maariv right after Shabbat or Yom Tov, or in the winter months. This is because these times require special insertions in the Amidah that aren't reflected in the shortened version.

Today the common practice is never to recite Havinenu. The Mishnah Berurah explains that this is because we never have the capacity or peace of mind to pray with proper intention. We have resigned ourselves to this fact. Therefore there is no need to try and mitigate the loss of intention with a shortened prayer.

Nevertheless, Havinenu is still recommended in some cases, such as for soldiers who have very little time to pray, or someone who is very ill and incapable of reciting a full Amidah.

### Individually United

Why are both the voluntary donations from the beginning of Vayakhel of all sorts of materials (Shemot 35:4-10) and the required half-shekel of silver of each individual that we read for Maftir, Parshat Shekalim (Shemot 30:11-16), needed? Wouldn't one or the other have sufficed?

The donations from this week's Parshah allow for individuals to contribute in ways that they personally feel valuable and is triggered by Nativ Libo, whoever's heart is moved to do so. This immense degree of freedom allows each person to achieve their own sincere connection to the Mishkan.

Rabbi Shimshon Raphael Hirsch explains that because the mandatory half-shekel of silver is identical for all, every person can fully contribute to the Mishkan, and service of G-d, regardless of their station.

Both voluntary donations and the required half-shekel combine to show that not only does every individual have the ability to personally connect to the Mishkan and G-d, but they also have the ability to fully contribute and come together as a people, a united people, serving G-d in an ideal way.

All of this comes on the heels of Chet HaEgel. Thereby showing that we must tackle our challenges on both fronts, national and the individual, no matter where our hearts and minds may be.

Motion 1 – Approve Conflict of Interest Policy as required by Ontario Nonprofit Corporation Act (ONCA). (Copy of policy available in the office along with explanation).

Motion 2 - Incorporate Mission Statement into Constitution as Subparagraph 2.05 to Article II:

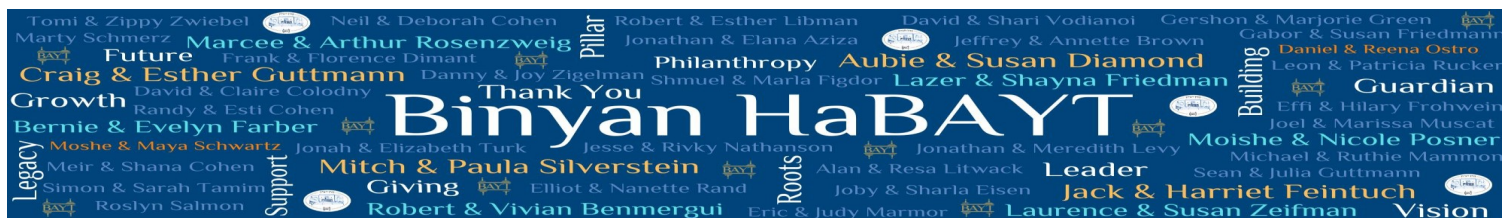
