PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE—NO WATER IN THE PIT

This past Motzei Shabbat the BAYT hosted a speed dating night at the BAYT for eighty-six singles. Filling the beautifully set-up RJTH, the singles rapidly met one another while enjoying fresh donuts and a variety of coffee drinks. It was wonderful to see and I'm told there were many matches made!

This week it was announced that public Chanukah lighting in London UK has been cancelled this year due to security concerns. Really? Why did the authorities not cancel all the antisemitic rallies that have been going on for the past eight weeks? There is something fundamentally wrong in society today and it's shocking that more people don't see it. The world better wake up. And just when you thought this kind of thing happens "over there and not here at home" sure enough Moncton authorities shamefully followed London's example. All the more reason for us to have rallied in Ottawa this past week. We have got to show the government that we will not be silent and complacent and certainly we will not be bullied. I think it is incumbent upon us to attend our public local Chanukah lighting ceremonies. I have not been a person who normally attends such events, but this year I plan to, if it's not cancelled. At least Moncton came to its senses following public outcry, but damage was done. Meanwhile seventeen buses didn't show up to take our people to Ottawa. And to add insult to injury, CTV news reported that we rallied in Ottawa in favour of the war in Gaza instead of reporting that our enemy should return our hostages like all the women and children they are still holding. More examples of blatant antisemitism.

Recently, the BAYT was asked to send a representative to appear before the Ontario Ministry of Finance and make a pitch for our community needs in advance of the 2024 Ontario Budget. The Rav represented us admirably, explaining to the committee that provincial government can help us with security needs. The costs to protect our community have soared and we would like to do even more but the financial burden is so great. I truly appreciate all the hard work that Laura Smith has done for the BAYT and this is another example of her leadership by arranging to make a pitch for financial assistance for the BAYT. Also, a big thank you to Laura as well, who came out to our Latke Night. I think Laura had as good a time as the kids did. She was really into it.

Another important representative of our community, Gila Martow, reached out to me to advise that she is working on securing garbage disposal for Passover. Vaughan is preparing their budget for 2024 and Gila wanted to ensure that our community needs are met for disposing of chametz, not just erev Pesach, but also during chol hamoed. We provided Gila with a letter of request setting out our needs and hopefully all will be arranged accordingly. It seems that there will only be one depot for Pesach which will be in our community as opposed to multiple locations last year in Vaughan.

Another shameful plug for Candles and Comedy at the Royal Theatre on December 12th, with proceeds benefiting Magen David Adom. My son Max is one of the comedians so you can see for yourself if he's funny and if not, you helped Magen David Adom. There are five or six other comedians too.

BAYT membership has officially closed for 5784. If you have not renewed, I suggest you be in touch with Irena immediately. For those who are not full or associate members but continue to use the BAYT's facilities and resources, I think it's time to join. And if you still do not want to join, why not make a generous donation to the BAYT before the end of 2023.

We are told in this week's parasha that "the pit was empty, no water was in it". The statement seems to be ambiguous. Of course if there was no water in the pit, it was empty! Rashi teaches us that adding that there was no water in it hints to us that it was not actually completely empty. Although water was not in it, it contained snakes and scorpions. You could not see them easily, they were in the crevices. This Rashi reminds me of the Shifa hospital and all the other "pits" that are located in Gaza. The world wants us to believe that there is nothing in the pits, not even water, yet we know there are snakes and scorpions. Yosef was protected in the pit and please Gd so too our chayalim and hostages.

THE MINILANCE

For those active volunteers who are unable to drive a motorcycle, United Hatzalah has developed a new kind of rapid response vehicle, especially suited to the urban environment. The Minilance is a nimble, four-seat electric vehicle that is narrow enough to maneuver between rows of cars waiting at traffic lights, speedy enough to arrive at the scene of an emergency within minutes, and agile enough to park in tiny spaces or even on the sidewalk. A storage compartment behind the seats holds a fully stocked medic's bag and portable defibrillator.



Distractions Before Lighting Chanukah Candles

Within half an hour before the time to light Chanukah candles, one should not do things that might distract them and prevent them from properly fulfilling the mitzvah. These include eating a significant meal, drinking intoxicating beverages, working on something time or thought consuming, and even learning Torah. However, there are exceptions in many cases:

Learning

If there is a regular class that coincides with candle lighting time and the class will be canceled if the participants go home to light, the class should be held as usual. The participants should light right away afterwards.

Eating

One is allowed to eat fruits, small amounts of mezonot food, and drink non-intoxicating beverages before lighting. If one is in a situation where they need to eat a significant meal before lighting, they should appoint someone to remind them later to light candles. According to some authorities, an alarm can be used for this as well.

Work

Someone who is in the middle of working and can't stop to go home and light candles is permitted to continue working even after candle lighting time. However, this is on the assumption that their work day ends at a specific time or their task is likely to be finished at a reasonable time. Someone working on a project that will potentially occupy them long after candle lighting time should appoint someone to remind them to stop and light candles.

Taking Responsibility

Why are Yehudah's descendants chosen to lead Bnei Yisrael? Didn't Yehudah propose to sell his brother Yosef, and then cover it up?

After the sale of Yosef, Yehudah is vayered may-et echav, he descends down and away from his brothers. According to Rabbi Dani Yaros, he gets mixed up with a bad crowd, mainly the Adullamite Chirah, who then continue to draw him on the wrong path. He gets married to the daughter of a Canaanite and leaves his daughter-in-law Tamar chained as a perpetual widow, refusing to allow his final son Shelah to marry her. This self-same Chirah helps Yehudah cover up his dalliances when Tamar disguised herself as a harlot. He seems to be the biggest hypocrite as he prepares to burn Tamar at the stake, despite his own erroneous ways.

But what makes Yehudah truly worthy of being the leader of the Jewish people is that when he is handed the security that Tamar sends that would prove his involvement, he doesn't throw it in the fire to cover up as he did by Yosef, instead, he admits his mistakes and works to make amends. He doesn't give in to negative influences, instead, he seizes the opportunity and repents.

We should all ensure we surround ourselves with positive influences and take responsibility just like Yehudah did.


