## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

#### May We All Be Comforted

What a magical Shabbat we experienced last week. Thank you to Esti and Randy Cohen and all the host families: Cheryl and Alvin Einhorn, Sari and Paul Weinberger, Linda and Howard Katz, Alina and Steve Mayer, Judi and Jason Berman, Nancy and Omri Farajun, and Chaya and Josh Cole. Thank you to the Brotherhood, Jesse Nathanson, Rosy and Moishe for their amazing contribution. Yishar Koach to the Rav, Aubie and the choir. You guys sounded great. I won't comment on Tefillat Tzahal, or I will start to cry again.

I have received multiple beautiful emails from our membership and volunteers expressing how impressive Shabbat was and their appreciation to the kehilla for opening our Shul and homes for this amazing event. The Todah Rabah the Rav received from Shlomi Nahumson, CEO of IDFWO was quite beautiful and inspiring, which I share with you:

"I hope this email finds you well. As I write it, a wonderful group of 18 Bar & Bat Mitzvah children, together with their staff, awaits for their flight from the Toronto Pearson Airport that will carry them back to their mothers' open arms here in Israel. They will embark that plane after spending over 3 weeks in North America, seeing Hashem's wonders such as the Niagara Falls and many others. But what is undoubtedly much more important than any Six Flags or summer camp, amazing as it can be, is the message they receive from Jewish families and congregations who live so far away from our Land, but care for them like they were their own. And with this message, our children are leaving Toronto right now, as they begin their journeys to adulthood and become members of Am Yisrael.

Rabbi Korobkin, for over a decade that the BAYT under your spiritual leadership has become a bayit, a real home away from home to hundreds of the children of Israel's Fallen Heroes. The third floor will continue to be used by the BAYT on Shabbat mornings for our youth programming. Many preparations to the building will be coming. A huge thank you to the negotiating team David Lithwick, Jeffrey Brown and Karen Zilberberg. They worked tirelessly to get the deal done. It has been an honour to work with the Bais Yaakov negotiating team of Moshe Goldshmidt, Lieb Irons and Ben Tzion Heitner. Yishar Koach to them. May they enjoy much health and happiness at the BAYT.

There are so many beautiful things to say about this agreement. It is living proof that the BAYT has been the incubator for forty years of Tefillah, Torah, Learning, Youth, Education, Simchas and social programming in Thornhill and no one can deny that. We are very proud of that record. Joe and Faye are shepping nachat. We are honoured to be a part of the continued growth of Bais Yaacov School in Thornhill. It's a great community story.

Obviously, things do not happen without the hand of Hashem and this one is so clear to me. Completing this agreement during the Nine Days, helps in the goal of binding the Jewish people to the growth of Torah in Thornhill and is the derech to Moshiach.

Congratulations to Emunah Canada which held its annual Shabbat afternoon lecture at the BAYT featuring Dr. Esther Libman. I'm told that over 200 ladies attended. It is so beautiful to hear. Yishar Koach to Esty Yeres (city-wide chair), Elaine Genesove, Esti Cohen and all of the volunteers who assisted on Shabbat afternoon to help prepare.

We are still looking for 2 host families for the Shinshiniot for first term. The girls arrive in the last week of August, and would live with your family until the end of January, at which time they move to a new host. They go home to Israel for 2.5 weeks in December. As a host, you provide a family environment to one Shinshinit. It's really not a large time commitment, as they are very busy with their work. In addition to developing a wonderful bond with a new family member and being part of an amazing program, you are also eligible for a tax receipt from UJA of up to \$3000 for expenses incurred. Up until last Friday, the BAYT garden had been blossoming so beautifully. I could not believe how tall the plants were growing. Unfortunately, sometime on Friday people stole some food right off the plants and damaged the growth. We are working on ways to prevent this, including signs and some other ideas. # OF SHEMA BY RABBI ADAM FRIEDMANN

Writer's note: I'm excited to start writing this column! I'll be covering topics in series' starting with the Laws of the Shema. But first, an introduction.

Rambam places the laws of the Shema in the second book of his Mishneh Torah, the Book of Love (of G-d). This book contains the laws of: Shema, Tefillah, Sefer Torah, Tefillin, Mezuzah, Tzitzit, Berachot, and Milah. Rambam explains what all these laws have in common. We perform them constantly and they are aimed at reminding us about G-d and bringing us to love Him.

What does it mean to love G-d? For Rambam, it begins with philosophy. A person must gain a deep understanding of the metaphysical and natural worlds, and of G-d's interaction with them. Once a person understands these things, they are occasionally struck by the magnificence of G-d's creation and wisdom and are filled with the desire to draw close to G-d. The ultimate fulfillment of the mitzvah to love G-d is to transform this fleeting experience into a consistent awareness that informs our experience of the world. This is the purpose of the mitzvot in the Book of Love.

People can come to love G-d without studying metaphysics, but the structure that Rambam introduces is still relevant. There are several mitzvot that are aimed at fostering a pervasive G-d consciousness and the Shema is one of them.

### D'VAR TORAH BY RABBI METZGER

Why do we only hear about Moshe's prayer to G-d to enter the land of Israel now? When exactly did Moshe say it? Why wasn't it included earlier?

Ramban explains that Moshe prayed to enter the land after he led Bnei Yisrael in defeating Sichon and Og, divided up the land in the east side of the Jordan River. It follows Bamidbar 27:12 when G-d tells Moshe that he cannot enter the land of Israel. In Bamidbar 27 the Torah only mentions the prayer that was answered, G-d choosing a leader for Israel — Yehoshua. Moshe's first prayer was for himself to enter the land. When that failed, Moshe beseeched G-d for a proper leader to lead them into the promised land.

Why do we only hear of this now? To show us how much Moshe loves the land of Israel. Moshe expresses his love of the land as part of his advice and rebuke for Bnei Yisrael.

When we tell our stories, we highlight what we did and how we succeeded. But in order to fully communicate our values and ideals, we need to relay our hopes and aspirations even if they aren't fulfilled — just as Moshe did




