BAYT SITE DEVELOPMENT FEASIBILITY COMMITTEE – REPORT TO MEMBERSHIP ON SURVEY 2

The BAYT Site Development Feasibility Committee (SDFC), recently presented the results of the BAYT Member survey to the BAYT Board on December 21, 2022. In keeping with our promise of transparency through the process, we would like to provide this update to the BAYT membership.

- ♦ 353 BAYT members responded to the survey
- ♦ 89.46% (313/353) agreed that Thornhill needs more “Reasonably Affordable” Housing (RAH)
- ♦ 78.52% (245/312) believe that BAYT has some level of responsibility for RAH (13.14% – Full, 39.74% - Partial, 25.64% - Minimal)
- ♦ 23.48% of the housing to be built should be “Reasonably Affordable” (287/353 responded to the question)

The housing should be built with the following groups in mind (on a scale of 7) (294/353 responding)

- ♦ Young Families – 5.57
- ♦ Newly Married Couples – 5.39
- ♦ Seniors – 4.44
- ♦ Persons with Disabilities – 3.90
- ♦ Singles / Students – 3.45
- ♦ New Immigrants – 2.79
- ♦ Other – 2.46

67.62% (213/315) feel that RAH means that 30% of income should go towards Rent or Monthly Mortgage Payment.

24.33% (64/263) of question respondents spend over 30% of their income on Rent or Monthly Mortgage Payment

81.57% (230/282) felt that at least 1 of the 2 parking lots should be developed, with 63.74% (183/282) in favour of the development of the East parking lot.

57.85% (162/280) were against severing and selling the land.

42.45% (118/278) were in favour of building over some part of the current building, 39.93% (111/278) in favor of building over the Banquet Hall section of the building.

When asked to rank the development options (on a scale of 5) the BAYT Members (267/353) provided the following guidance

- ♦ Build on Existing parking lot – 4.12
- ♦ Sever and Sell – 3.15
- ♦ Redevelop over part of the existing building – 2.78
- ♦ Redevelop over existing facility – 2.61

Significant write-in issues, from 97 written comments

- ♦ Parking lot concerns (14)
- ♦ Affordability (13)
- ♦ Development should be for new or current shul members only (5)

Next Steps

BAYT SDFC will continue Public Consultation, to determine which development scenarios should be worked on to develop financial models to be brought to the board.

Survey 3 will poll both BAYT and non-BAYT Members about the specifics of any type of development with the objective of developing a better understanding and eventually addressing stated needs as well as concerns, and taking them into account as we refine the plan, and bring it forward for review.

Survey 3 will be released in January 2023.

All BAYT Members, for which the office has current e-mail addresses, will receive an e-mail with the Survey URL. You are asked to complete the survey to the best of your abilities.

The BAYT SDFC will be using other distribution channels to get the survey out to the wider Thornhill community, including but not limited to, flyer distribution within 500 meters of the synagogue, and having politicians and ratepayer groups in the area distribute to their constituencies.

May I check my email during Chazarat haShatz (the chazan's repetition of the amidah)?

Chazarat haShatz serves two functions:

It enables those who are unfamiliar with the amidah to fulfill their obligation by listening to the chazan;
It creates a communal opportunity to recite Kedushah and Birkat Kohanim.

Listening to each berachah and answering Amen is meritorious. Further, Chazarat haShatz requires a minyan. For both of these reasons, each participant should listen and respond to the chazan, and should not speak of extraneous matters. Indeed, many halachic authorities even prohibit Torah study (including reading "Weekly Halachah" columns) during Chazarat haShatz. Based on this, it appears that reading email is prohibited.

One who must check for an urgent email during Chazarat haShatz should consider stepping out of shul, to avoid marit ayin.

D'VAR TORAH

Why did the entirety of Egypt mourn Yaakov's passing for 70 days? How did he merit to receive the royal treatment of being embalmed by the Egyptian physicians? What was Yaakov's relationship to them?

Rabbi Dovid Kimche (12th century Provance) explains that they weren't mourning for Yaakov, rather out of respect for Yosef and his feelings.

Rabbi Ovadya Sforno (16th century Italy) offers that it wasn't out of respect or because Yosef commanded them to, rather Yaakov independently deserved to rule and receive respect due royalty.

Rashi says that the Egyptians wept for so long because they knew that it was in Yaakov's merit that the famine ended after only two years, because the Nile rose to greet Yaakov when he arrived in Egypt.

Rabbi Eliyah Mizrachi (15th-16th century Constantinople) buttresses Rashi with the fact that the Egyptians were too disgusted to break bread with the Hebrews (Bresihit 43, 32). Sealing the deal with the fact that crying isn't something that can simply be done at will because of honour.

Yaakov's life may not have been a smooth one, but despite everything Yaakov still managed to leave behind a lasting legacy not only for his children, Bnei Yisrael, but one so great that the entirety of Egypt mourned and respected him.

Survey Background

Since its inception 40 years ago, the Beth Avraham Yoseph of Toronto (BAYT) Synagogue has fulfilled many roles in contributing to the well-being of the surrounding Thornhill community. The Synagogue looks forward to continuing to be a key pillar of the community for many years to come.

The Synagogue is currently examining approaches to achieving financial stability while continuing to contribute to the well-being of members of the congregation, their families and the vitality of the surrounding community.

One of the most important assets available to the Synagogue is the property on which the BAYT is located.

The BAYT's Site Development Feasibility Committee (SDFC) believes it is important to consult with the wider Thornhill community and have the community prioritize the unmet needs which can be fulfilled by development of the BAYT property and understand the community's prioritized development concerns.

The BAYT SDFC has already surveyed the membership of BAYT in November and December 2022.

This 3rd survey is soliciting additional guidance from BAYT members as well as input from the wider community surrounding BAYT.

The BAYT SDFC will use the guidance received in Survey 3 to help arrive at a preferred development solution.

The City of Vaughan development process requires a consultation around 150 meters of the proposed site. We are expanding this to 500 meters around 613 Clark Avenue West. We are also interested in opinions beyond the 500-meter mark.

The Committee wishes to emphasize that this is a study only and does not mean that redevelopment of the site will take place; it is one option being considered.

The BAYT has retained the services of SHS Consulting to conduct the survey.

We have also provided the survey link to a number of community organizations who maintain their own e-mail lists. At no time have any lists external to BAYT been shared with the BAYT SDFC

You will be asked to provide a postal code as a mandatory question, so we can determine which responses came from within 150 meters, 500 meters, and beyond 500 Meters of the BAYT, 613 Clark Avenue West.

You will be given the opportunity to optionally identify yourself if you want to stay in touch about the evolution of the BAYT initiative.

All answers will be kept strictly confidential.
