PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

With our 40th Anniversary celebration behind us, we now turn our focus to examining the possibility of developing the BAYT property to ensure our long-term financial stability.

We face a different environment today than our founder Joseph Tanenbaum z"l did when he bought land from the Spring Family in the late 70's and succeeded in developing an amazing and dynamic community with a Shul at the heart of it.

Our benefactor gave us the land on which the synagogue is now built, surrounded by a 4-acre parking lot. Our financial experience during the pandemic magnified the need to ensure future financial stability while continuing to contribute to the well-being of our members, their families and the surrounding community.

The first iteration of the BAYT Site Development Feasibility Committee (SDFC) helped secure funding from the Canada Mortgage and Housing Corporation (CMHC). This funding is enabling us to explore options for what can be done with this magnificent BAYT property.

The current BAYT SDFC, co-chaired by Board members Jesse Nathanson and Fred Winegust, has been given the mandate to consult with the BAYT community, prioritize our development options, and come back to the BAYT Board and Executive with a number of development options.

Revenues generated by through any development option would go into an income generating account to help cover any annual operating deficits, provide sufficient income for capital improvements, and improve housing affordability in the neighbourhood, particularly for prospective BAYT members. The Committee wishes to emphasize that this is a study only and does not mean that redevelopment of the site will take place. It is one option being considered to meet the goals of the synagogue.

A survey has been sent by email to every full BAYT member. You will have the option to provide your name, e-mail address and mobile phone number if you want the BAYT SDFC to connect with you after the survey is complete. Please take 10 minutes of your time to participate in this survey between now and Tuesday December 20, 2022 at 5PM. Your valuable input will help guide our growth over the next 40 years. On another note, the BAYT's app has not been available on the Apple store for quite some time. After much perseverance by our staff Avital and Shimon and our member Maury Gilman, it has now been restored and is available for download. Thank you to all! It is a powerful app and you can do just about anything with it. I love the ability to look up zmanim for tefillah and finding members emails and phone numbers. You can even print out a membership directory from it (which is not to be shared). As well, there is a link to the Maddie Leventhal Mikvah Centre. Also, in the app, and on our website, we have added a new section for the Sisterhood Chessed Committee with all the various programs they oversee. Click HERE to download the app

During announcements last Shabbat, I mentioned that when you enter or exit the building at all times, it is imperative that you ensure that the door is locked behind you. Last week Friday night, the Yorkhill rear door was left open after davening. In addition, you can now use the Clark doors on Friday night and on Shabbat. However, please be cautious in inclement weather. Snow and ice can build up and may not be cleared immediately. In those instances, the parking lot doors may be a better option.

On Tuesday night, we had a lot going on at the BAYT (Baruch Hashem!). Along with many minyanim and much learning, there was a large NCSY Chanukah event and the Toronto Zionist Council hosted a discussion called, "Protecting Israel's National Lands and Resources." On Tuesday morning we got word that a BDS organization was planning to disrupt the TZC event. Our office staff and leadership quickly engaged our Facilities Staff, our Security Team, UJA Community Security and the York Regional Police. Everyone worked in tandem with the task at hand beautifully. YRP were on site the entire evening and it speaks volumes to our strong relationship with our law enforcement and trust that we have with them and UJA. Our Security Team, who are volunteers constantly protecting the BAYT no matter what time or day, ensured the safety of our members and the greater community.

And if I may add a final personal thought, we will never back down or be intimated by anyone or any group from hosting events at our shul. Rest assured, we will always protect our community.

May I light the menorah and leave my home immediately?

The menorah must remain lit for at least one half-hour after nightfall.

From the perspective of fire safety: Having open flames in one's home, and particularly near windows with shades or curtains, is dangerous (whether or not one is present!). One who will need to leave should take special precautions, perhaps by lighting anchored tea lights. If there is no way to safeguard the menorah, one should remain until the minimum time has elapsed and then extinguish the lights.

From the perspective of the mitzvah: Leaving the menorah while it is lit is not ideal; indeed, we emphasize lighting in rooms where we live and function. We wish to see the light and thereby commemorate the miracles we are publicizing, and to rejoice in the mitzvah. Therefore, one ought to remain in the room with the menorah for at least the minimum time, unless one is called away to perform a mitzvah.

Why didn't Yosef ever send word to his father Yaakov, to tell him that he was still alive throughout his time in Egypt?

Rabbi Yoel bin Nun explains that Yosef believed that his brothers were acting on his fathers behalf when he was sold into slavery. In Yosef's mind Yaakov was fully aware of the feud between Yosef and his brothers. So when his father sends him off alone to check in on his brothers, and he then gets thrown into a pit and sold into slavery, Yosef sees this retrospectively as a mission to his own demise.

Yaakov certainly did not intend for anything bad to happen to Yosef. His giving Yosef a special Ketonet Pasim, a special striped colorful coat, may not have been pure favoritism but a show of love on his behalf to his son. Unfortunately, actions even with the best of intentions, such as sending Yosef to simply say hello to his brothers and hope they can work things out, turned out to have disastrous consequences.

While it is extremely important to act with good intentions, it is also necessary to communicate what we have in mind explicitly to avoid tragic misunderstandings. We need to be intentional when conveying messages to our children and friends so they receive the messages we hope to impart and properly understand how much we care for them.




