What is the ideal fuel for the Chanukiah?

Wax and all kinds of oils are fine, as long as they burn well, with a clear and steady flame, for the appropriate period of time. (Shabbat 23a, Shulchan Aruch Orach Chaim 673:1)

Some prefer oil because they claim that a wax candle is an "avukah (torch)" rather than a "ner", and we are supposed to light a "ner". In an oil "ner", the fuel is consumed and the wick remains, but with a candle the entire wick burns. (Maharal, Ner Mitzvah pp. 24-25)

Some prefer olive oil over other oils, for two reasons:

- To echo the miracle, which involved olive oil. (Kol Bo 44, Rama Orach Chaim 673:1, Mishneh Berurah 673:4)
- To mimic the olive oil-burning menorah in the Beit haMikdash, viewing our lighting as an extension of that menorah. (see Ramban Bamidbar 8:2, Mishnat Yaavetz 73:1, Chasdei Avot 17:17)

Why does Lavan make Yaakov marry Leah before Rachel?

Lavan's excuse is that in this place we don't marry the younger sister off before the elder. (Breishit 29:26)

The typical explanation is that Lavan deliberately tricked Yaakov for his own gain at his daughters' expense.

The Or HaChaim explains that Lavan was actually acting in Yaakov and Rachel's best interests in doing so because this was the only way that the people of Charan would allow Yaakov to marry Rachel. Only once Leah is married can Rachel marry Yaakov, and in the end Yaakov did in fact marry Rachel. Lavan claimed Yaakov should have done his research, and therefore Lavan is free of blame.

Lavan's defense is absurd, so the Or HaChaim explains that Lavan lives up to his name as a trickster.

For Lavan's claim to have been tenable, he should have informed Yaakov of the customs and explained the situation prior. If Lavan had clearly communicated his intent over the seven years between Yaakov's proposal and the wedding date as opposed to springing it on him, history may have been very different. Good intentions without communication can be just as deadly a combination as malicious intent.
