# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

## Joe and Chessed

One of the most remarkable scenes in all of Torah is in this week's Parsha. Avraham had just completed the mitzvah of brit milah three days earlier and is by the entrance of his dwelling recovering. And none other than HaKadosh Baruch Hu himself visits Avraham Avinu. And while Avraham is conversing with Hashem, Avraham is peering out to see if anyone is out in the distance to perform the mitzvah of hachnasat orchim. And suddenly, Avraham sees what he has been searching for... guests to entertain and teach about the Creator of the World. And what does Avraham do? He interrupts his conversation with G-d! Hold on Hashem, "I see some guests coming. I must tend to them". Avraham actually interrupts his dialogue with Hashem to greet passersby? This is the essence of Judaism. The Chessed subcommittees do need more volunteers to take the pressure off these fantastic women (where are the men?) as they may not always be available to assist when the need arises. If last week was an indication of things to come in the Shul for the next three Shabbatot, we are very fortunate. The Netivot Shabbaton at the BAYT was a jolt of high energy. Thank you to all who organized it.

## LETTER OF INTENT

2022 marks the 80th anniversary of the beginning of Operation Reinhard - the plan to genocide Polish Jews, prepared and carried out by Nazi Germany, as a result of which on October 22, 1942, the Jewish population of Opatów was exterminated.

Bearing in mind the importance of this event for our town, and also driven by the concern to preserve the memory of the murdered and the desire to prepare the best and worthy of commemorating this anniversary - Mayor of the Town and Commune in Opatów, Mr. Grzegorz Gajewski, Association of Geodetic and Cartographic Initiatives Geocentrum and the Society of Friends Opatowska Land would like to inform you that ceremonies commemorating the victims of the criminal operation "Reinhard" will be held in Opatów on **October 23, 2022**. We would be pleased if the Holocaust survivors who were born in Opatów and their descendants would accept our invitation and participate in the ceremony.

An appropriate invitation along with a detailed program will be sent at a later time.

As a meal is being planned, please let us know if you willing to have kosher food.

## The Unexpected Invitation

In the fall of 1941, Nazi Germany implemented a plan to systematically murder Jews in the General Government. This plan was codenamed “Operation Reinhard.” Three killing centers were established as part of this action: Belzec, Sobibor, and Treblinka. Operation Reinhard marked the deadliest phase of Nazi Germany’s intention to commit genocide against the Jewish people.

The overwhelming majority of German camp personnel deployed at the Operation Reinhard camps came from Operation T4 (the Euthanasia Program). Operation T4 was the Nazis’ first secret program of mass murder in which institutionalized persons with disabilities were killed.

On January 20, 1942, 15 high-ranking Nazi Party and German government officials gathered at a villa in the Berlin suburb of Wannsee to discuss and coordinate the implementation of what they called the “Final Solution of the Jewish Question”.

The overwhelming majority of victims in the Operation Reinhard killing centers were Jews deported from ghettos in German-occupied Poland. Once the killing centers were operational, German SS and police forces liquidated the ghettos. Jews were deported by rail to those killing centers.

SS General Globocnik submitted his final Operation Reinhard report to Reichsführer SS Heinrich Himmler in January 1944. He listed the goals of Operation Reinhard as follows:

- ♦ To “resettle” the Jews of the General Government View This Term in the Glossary (by “resettle” Globocnik actually meant to murder them)
- ♦ To exploit the skilled or manual labor of some Polish Jews before killing them
- ♦ To secure the personal property of the Jews (clothing, currency, jewelry, and other possessions)
- ♦ To identify and secure alleged hidden and immovable assets such as factories, apartments, and land.

My father and grandmother both came from the town of Opatow, Poland. On October 22, 1942 the entire Jewish population was assembled on the ground where the farmers used to bring their livestock to be sold, carrying with them rucksacks and bags containing the bare necessities of life, men, women, young and old, children and infants in their mother’s arms, were marched off brutally to a railway station Jasice, on their way to be murdered in Treblinka.

By an act of fate, my father and a group of about 25 – 30 were pulled aside, by a German in charge. The group consisted of members of the Judenrat, The Ghetto police and a number of strong young people. Our task for the next couple of weeks was to collect all of the possessions left behind in houses and business at one central depot, the Opatow shul and Beit Midrash and eventually all was shipped to Germany.

From Opatow, the group was sent to Sandomierz around the middle of December 1942.

80 years later, a representative of the Opatow Town Council sent a letter to the Apter (Opatow) Society in Canada, to invite the survivors of Opatow and their descendants to return to Opatow.

On Friday October 21, 2022, a group of Israelis, Americans and Canadians, including 1 survivor, assembled in Krakow in answer to the invitation and began a journey to commemorate the 80th anniversary of the liquidation of the town of Opatow.

**Must I hold the challah when reciting HaMotzi?**

Ideally, one who is reciting any berachah on food should hold it at that time, to minimize any delay before eating. We hold it in our stronger hand, to demonstrate respect for the berachah. However, these are not absolute requirements so long as the food is present or immediately accessible during the berachah.

Regarding HaMotzi, specifically, there are additional reasons to hold the bread during the berachah, related to the symbolism of the ten fingers holding the bread. On Shabbat there is yet another reason to hold the bread: to show love for the two loaves which parallel the miraculous manna.

**What exactly does Yishmael do wrong to warrant being kicked out of Avraham's household? Is the act of Yishmael being metzachek, playing, (Breishit 21:9) really so bad?**

From the simple sense of the text it seems like Yishmael was simply acting as a young lad is wont to do, as Rabbi Avraham Ibn Ezra points out. But if that's the case, Sarah, our matriarch, appears to be overreacting or jealous for no reason. How can G-d agree with Sarah's decision to kick out Yishmael and Hagar (21:12) with just that as a basis?

Rashi explains that we have the wrong meaning for metzachek. He quotes three options from the Midrash in Breishit Rabbah (53:11) that either 1) the playing here is idolatrous like by the Sin of the Golden Calf (Shemot 32:6), 2) it's adulterous akin to Potifar's wife's false accusation against Yosef (Breishit 39:17) or 3) it's murder as was the ultimate end of the "playful" duel in battle between the young men of Avner and Yoav (Shmuel II 2:13).

Ramban suggests that metzachek means mocking derisively, which also explains why Yishmael is called a "son of a maidservant."

When raising children and deciding what influences we want, we often need to make tough decisions about the environment we wish to create for ourselves and our future. Ramban and Rashi enlighten us to Sarah's matriarchal wisdom, showing who we should be listening to, even if others may doubt our conclusions.




