

INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA

Timing of the Shema pt 1: Tzeit Hakochavim

The evening Shema is read when we "lie down" to sleep at night. This includes the time when people are going to bed as well as the entire time that people are asleep. Fundamentally, this time span begins at the emergence of three stars (tzeit hakochavim) and continues until dawn the following morning.

According to some views, the Shema, and therefore all of Maariv, should be said as soon as possible after tzeit hakochavim. However, later poskim consider this position to be a stringency or non-normative. Therefore, one should prioritize praying with a minyan, even a late minyan where they think they can better concentrate, over praying alone at tzeit hakochavim. In all cases, one should try to recite the Shema before halachic midnight.

The Sages were concerned about people falling asleep for the night before reciting the Shema and missing out on the mitzvah altogether. Therefore they decreed that a person should not eat a meal or take a nap starting from half an hour before tzeit hakochavim until after they have read the Shema. If one needs to eat during this time, they should ask someone else to remind them later to recite the Shema. If no one is available they can set an alarm as a reminder.

Can we justifiably say there are two Akeidah's in this week's Parshah, Yitzchak's versus Yishmael's?

There are two stories of a child leaving with their parent, and ultimately being saved by divine intervention — but the reason behind them is very different. Avraham and Yitzchak set out on a journey directed by G-d, while Hagar and Yishmael are kicked out because of Yishmael's inappropriate behavior towards his brother Yitzchak. G-d approved their exile, caused by their own sins.

Once the journey begins we also see a sharp contrast in the relationship that the parents have with their children. Hagar and Yishmael have a terrible relationship. Not a word is spoken between Hagar and Yishmael. By Akeidat Yitzchak, we can clearly see the parent-child bond. Avraham tells Yitzchak where they are going, and Yitzchak feels comfortable enough to ask Avraham where is the sheep for offering, and Avraham responds that G-d will show us and "they continue on their journey walking together", וַיֵּלְכּוּ שְׁנֵיהֶם יַחְדָּו

Perhaps the biggest difference though comes at the moment when it appears that their child is about to die. Hagar abandons her son beneath one of the bushes, then goes an arrow shot away because she doesn't want to see him pass away. Avraham, on the other hand, stays with Yitzchak until the end and is ultimately stopped by the angel from having any harm come to Yitzchak. Avraham then is able to see the solution of the ram tied up by its horns in the brush.

There are two parallel stories, but the point is to show how different they are. As opposed to Hagar who says nary a word to her son and abandons him, Avraham converses and sticks with Yitzchak until they are eventually saved. What makes Avraham and Yitzchak uniquely deserving of being chosen by G-d is that both of them passed the test. Avraham and Yitzchak are there for each other, no matter what, through thick and thin.

When someone we know and cherish falls on hard times we don't always have a solution. Israel and the Jewish people are now in the middle of a war for their very existence. Many of us find ourselves far from the front-lines, unable to actively fight. The best option we have is to be there with them throughout the process. It can be a phone call, a text, a whatsapp, or sending a package or donation.

G-d willing we will never have to face challenges as difficult as Avraham and Yitzchak faced, but when we do, we know that we will be able to face them together.


