PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE—PARSHAS VAYEITZEI—HE WEPT

A special welcome back to Drs. Joby Eisen and Sharla Lichtman who returned from Israel where they volunteered with Magen David Adom working in the Ashdod area. After the Chabura minyan last week where a kiddush was held in their honour, they spoke of their incredible experience volunteering. They had a what's app group sharing pictures and videos and stories of their heroic experiences saving our people. I share with you a few words from their chat group. "As our journey in our beautiful and beloved homeland comes to a close, we once again go back to the Kotel to feel Hashem's kiss up close. We began our trip here beseeching G-d's help with Prayers for the safe and successful return for our soldiers and hostages. We prayed for our Jewish brethren worldwide.... The words of the Haggadah resonate with Vehi Sheamda... that in every generation our enemies will come to annihilate us but the Kadosh Baruch Hu will save us from them. After a heartfelt Mincha, we returned to Jaffa Street to see this promise come true. In the heart of Tzion remains a vibrant Jewish world looking forward to its next day with hope and promise to make our world a better place."



We are glad you have returned safe and we look forward to hearing about your experience in the near future with the entire membership.

I have waited all year for this, but finally it's here motzei Shabbat Latke Night! It is going to be a fantastic night. I hope you have tickets. Thank you to the Stein's and the entire Youth Committee for arranging the most amazing night of our youth's lives.

Yashar Koach to all who participated in the Sisterhood's Leket Drive in memory of Judy Grossman z"l. Judy was a co-chair of the Sisterhood's Chesed Committee for many years. Her devotion to helping people was evident by her constant caring for others. May her memory be for a blessing.

I share a couple of comments I read or saw that really drive home how special our IDF soldiers are. Someone once asked Rav Shlomo Zalmen Auerbach z"l if he could leave yeshiva to daven by kivrei tzadikim, our holy gravesites. He answered: When I need a special merit in my davening, I go to Mount Herzl and pray by the gravesite of fallen soldiers, who died al kiddush Hashem.

Rabbi Amar was asked this week how the yeshiva community in Israel should relate to Israeli soldiers and the Sephardi Chief Rabbi replied that they are the holiest. They risk their lives to protect the Jewish people.

Please continue to say Tehillim for our soldiers. Join us mincha every day and on Thursday's we say more Tehillim including Aveinu Malkeinu.

I had the opportunity to hear Jason Greenblatt at Shaarei Shomayim earlier in the week. He was the executive vice president and chief legal officer to Donald Trump and The Trump Organization, an advisor on Israel and one of the architects of the Abraham Accords. I came away with much information but want to share two important thoughts he made clear. "Let's grasp that (Jewish) unity and never let it go." I think that is something we all have to work on. And "we must speak up". Write the news sources when they publish false information. Write the Presidents of universities. Write your governmental representatives at all levels. We have much to do.

The Executive and the Security Committee have worked tirelessly to understand how we can serve the membership in light of growing antisemitism and recent local incidents. Access into the BAYT is provided by your fobs, Security Guards, Safety Team, and Facilities Staff for functions and events. The Staff and volunteers have undergone rudimentary training in security awareness and procedures. Although we have our regulars, there are other hired Security Guards who sometimes do a shift at the BAYT who are not as familiar with our facility and procedures, such as who is admissible. Measures have been taken to tighten this in the future.

Some have asked why we do not employ an armed guard. Firstly, Canadian law does not permit this. Secondly, paying for an off duty police officer is a deterrent but not really that effective. A paid off duty police officer on site only intervenes if directed by a BAYT Executive officer or a Security Committee chair unless an actual crime is being committed. This was recently noted when five plain clothes police officers stood by the door and took no action when a non-registered person was instructed by Security to leave the BAYT at a recent private event held in the Shul. Furthermore, many times the officer signing up for the paid duty is not necessarily a patrol officer - they may work in IT, theft, accident reporting, procedural training etc. Also we have been asked about an officer and a vehicle. That cost is over \$1,000 for a six-hour period. We have been very fortunate with York Region Police special patrols over the past few months where officers park their vehicles in our driveway for a period of time and make frequent patrols through the shul property. This past weekend alone they made more than ten visits that we noted.

The Security Volunteers are doing an excellent job considering the very demanding situation they currently face. They play an important role and Baruch Hashem they have kept us safe. Many shuls in North America have a mandatory voluntary policy. We need more volunteers and quite frankly each and every member should step up. We are working on other ideas and hope to have them implemented in the near future. Please speak to Alan Jaff, Steve Mortfield or Aaron Rosenberg to do your part.

Monday December 4th, there will be a rally in Ottawa to show our unwavering support for the people of Israel, for the safety of Jewish Canadians and of course to bring our hostages home. Pencil it in your calendar. Details to follow.

I urge of you, young and old, to review the Scholar in Residence schedule this Shabbat and Motzei Shabbat so that you can attend several of Rabbi Shlomo Brody's talks. Rabbi Brody is the Executive Director of Ematai and columnist for the Jerusalem Post. He will be speaking about many fascinating and important topics. I met Rabbi Brody at Torah in Motion's Halachic Medical Conference last year in Toronto and I asked Lazer Friedman if he could arrange to bring Rabbi Brody to the BAYT. The Melevo Malka will deal with Halachic Living Wills and it is for all ages. Thank you to our sponsor Wagner Sidlofsky LLP.

The Torah tells us that Yaakov wept, "vayevch". Yaakov wept because he foresaw through Ruach HaKodesh that Rachel would not be buried with him in the Cave of Machpeilah. Rachel was buried in Beit Lechem. Yaakov was pained not be buried with his love. Hashem decreed that Rachel should be buried at the side of the road so that when the Jewish people would pass there on their way into exile, Rachel would cry out and beg Hashem to show them mercy. Yaakov wept for their pain. Today, we all weep in pain, but we are comforted that Hashem will dry our tears speedily.

INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA

The Time for the Morning Shema

The morning Shema is recited when people generally get up for the day (bekumecha). Accordingly, the Talmud defines a range within which to read the Shema. In the Talmudic era, the first people woke up just after dawn (alot hashachar). The majority of people woke up later, around the time one can recognize an acquaintance at a distance of 4 amot. The aristocrats woke up last, around 3 hours into the day. The halachah is that the Shema should be read between the last two times.

There's also another consideration. The Talmud records that the pious would read the Shema just before sunrise so that they could juxtapose the Shema with the earliest time for Shacharit. This is considered the ideal time to read the Shema. So much so, that one who has the practice to pray at this time regularly can do so even if there is no minyan or tefillin available.

If one does not recite the Shema at this ideal time, one should recite it as soon as possible. However, this should not come at the expense of praying with a minyan or reciting the Shema without wearing tefillin.

In extenuating circumstances, such as one who must get up early to travel or go to work, one can recite the Shema early as long as it is after dawn.

Why did G-d show Yaakov a dream with a ladder going up to the heavens with angels going up and down? Wouldn't simply promising Yaakov protection have sufficed?

Yaakov feels despondent and besieged from all sides. He just tricked his father, and stole a divine blessing, and his brother Esav wants him dead. This might be the very first night he manages to fall asleep.

Rabbi Shimshon Raphael Hirsch explains that the ladder represents a means to communicate with G-d, inviting everything earthly to work heavenwards. It is no fairy tale invented by Man, but a most substantial reality established from heaven itself. The angels ascending and descending, Olim viYordim Bo, working both for Yaakov and against him, show that the world's fate is not simply determined by the material world but is controlled by a higher power – G-d. "G-d stood beside him" because G-d protects Yaakov on every plane of existence.

G-d's revelation to Yaakov is formulated perfectly for him, assuaging his fears and doubts even before G-d utters His promise. Every visual element adds to the message. The environment and visual cues play an essential role in providing a message. This can be seen in the ambiance of a restaurant, but the best example would be the Pesach Seder. We specially set the table, dress up, and have all sorts of visual aids from the Seder plate to Haseiba, leaning, to help us better internalize the miraculous and historic moment of leaving Egypt during Yetziat Mitzrayim.

Even Yaakov needed extra visual divine angelic reassurance from G-d before he set off on his mission. Please reach out to someone you know to be their ladder of support. It can be by text, audio, or video because even with just your name appearing on their screen before they read the message they understand that they are not alone.

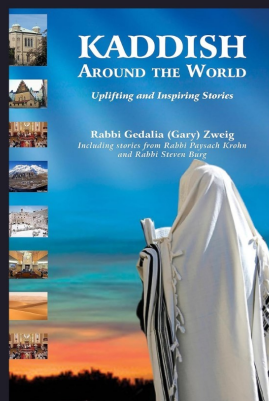

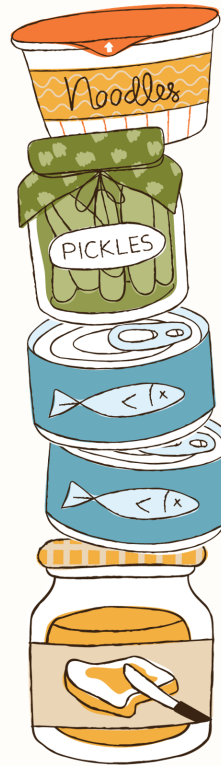

We daven in a small shule of 40 to 50 families, situated in a geriatric facility in Baka in Yerushalayim. The administrator of the facility, Sima Ziny, welcomes us daily with a smile and makes us all feel at home. On Simchat Torah, her grandson Nirel was visiting his long time girlfriend Niv in Kfar Azza where they were making plans to announce their engagement three days after the Chag. Tragically, they were murdered by Hamas terrorists as they attempted to escape through a window. Both were army officers but were off duty on Simchat Torah.

Sima was devastated as expected and was absent from work for several weeks. When she returned, the shule membership approached her with a view to memorializing her grandson and his fiancée. The Aron Kodesh in the shule did not have a Ner Tamid and it was decided to dedicate a Ner Tamid to the memory of the fallen couple.

The ceremony took place this morning with the entire shule membership in attendance along with Nirel's family. The family appeared deeply moved by the gesture. After the ceremony, Sima confided to us that her great regret was that Nirel and Niv, נרצחו כעובדי צה"ל ולא כחיילים מגנים את ישראל.

We have attached some pictures of the Ner Tamid, the dedication plaque and the parents of Nirel z"l.

Our purpose is to connect you and others in Toronto in a more personal way to the fallen heroes of October 7 who died על קידוש השם.

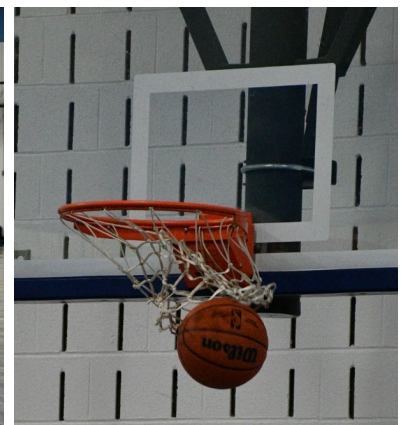
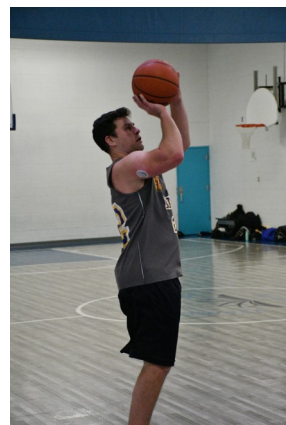
