May a person daven while connected to a catheter?

We communicate with Hashem when we daven, and Devarim 23:14 states that a space in which excrement is found is unfit for the presence of Hashem. However, one who excretes via catheter and has no control over the flow may still daven, so long as the following conditions are fulfilled:

There must be no foul smell in the room;
The catheter should be covered.

There are multiple reasons to be lenient in this circumstance, including 1) the importance of ensuring that every individual will have the opportunity to daven, and 2) the uncertainty as to whether excrement is emerging from the body at any given moment.

One who excretes via catheter should recite the berachah of asher yatzar as part of the morning berachot (subject to the two conditions above), and have in mind that it will serve for the entire day.

Pharaoh finally meets Yaakov, the father of his prized vizier, Yosef, and yet all he has to ask him is how old are you? Why does Yaakov respond by complaining about his hard life to Pharaoh?

The Chizkuni quotes a Midrash that because of this conversation Yaakov's life is shortened by thirty three years, one per word in this section beginning from when Pharaoh asked his question (47:8). But what was so bad about Yaakov lamenting his hard life?

There is a time and place for everything, but the first time you meet the most powerful man in the region is not that time. Yaakov had the opportunity to perform an incredible Kiddush HaShem, to sanctify G-d's Name, and he did not. When Yosef was first presented before Pharaoh, as but a lowly young foreign slave rescued from the depths of prison, he properly interpreted the dreams and saved the lives of the people living in the region around Egypt and its sphere of influence from famine.

Yosef presents Yaakov as his honoured father, a much better starting point, yet Yaakov fails to capitalize on his chance, instead turning it into an insult to G-d. There are times to complain and times to act.


