- Next week, we bid farewell to our facilities manager Noel Fernandes. After nearly a decade, Noel has stepped down for a much-needed break. Noel and I worked quite a bit together over the years, as have David Lithwick and David Vodianoi most recently. We all concur, Noel has served our community caringly and faithfully. Because that is who he is. Please join all of us in wishing Noel well. He will be missed.
- In case you did not hear my remarks last Shabbat, we thanked the efforts of our main shul renovation committee, David Lithwick, David Vodianoi and Jack Feintuch. Funding for the renovation came from our capital campaign a few years ago, ½ of which came from The Jewish Legacy Charitable Foundation and ½ from members and other donors. Please join me in thanking the committee, Yaakov Kaplan and the Jewish Legacy Charitable Foundation for a job well done.
- It may not surprise you that a just released Angus Reid Institute/CBC survey of 2,550 Canadians reports 79% believe the pandemic brought out the worst in people and 81% believe "people around me have become more irritated as the pandemic goes on." No doubt, we all feel some of that angst in our BAYT. But hang in there, masks come off March 21! Until then, please don't add to the angst. Please continue to wear your masks until March 21.

Drop off Locations include the Schwartz Reisman JCC (9600 Bathurst Street, Meeting Room B), the Lipa Green Building, Sherman Campus (4600 Bathurst Street, Board Room) and the garage at 194 Montclair Avenue in Toronto.
- Please make sure you know your children's whereabouts on Purim, who they are with and how they are getting around. For everyone else, police will deploy sobriety checkpoints in Jewish communities once again.

FUNDRAISING MESSAGE

A MESSAGE FROM OUR FUNDRAISING CHAIR:

When I walked into the main sanctuary last Shabbat, I was overwhelmed with utmost pride of our BAYT community. When I think about where we were in March of 2020, right after Purim, and where we are now. What an accomplishment.

The unknown had crept into every person's life. Simchas in the shul had come to a complete halt. The biggest source of income the shul relies on, next to membership, literally evaporated. We still had to operate and maintain our shul and service our debt. We made painful decisions. There was a tough road ahead. We had to come up with a plan.

From the fundraising perspective, we were not going to touch the Capital Campaign money. That money remaining was set aside to refresh the main sanctuary. Donors had given to the shul for the cause of renovating the shul. Had we used those funds in an emergency, we would have lost all donor credibility. We decided to approach the BAYT community and explain the dire situation. Many were surprised and rightly wanted explanations. Under the leadership of Jeffrey Brown, a very challenging plan was developed. Calculated decisions were made to assure our donors that we would do everything possible to use their generous dollars prudently. The Crisis Campaign was launched and was very successful. This year, Binyan HaBAYT was inaugurated and the response was overwhelming. Binyan HaBAYT will become the backbone of our Shul. The Silverman Sefer Torah Campaign, in memory of our beloved first Chairman of the Board, Albert Silverman z"l, was just completed and it, too, was very successful. Thank you to all our Donors. Our community is very special. Never ever forget that.

The House Committee, led by David Lithwick and David Vodianoi, completed the first phase of renovating the main sanctuary on time and on budget. The roof was redone, with a little more to go in the spring. And so on Shabbat, I walked into the main sanctuary and realized that we as a community have overhauled and rebuilt so many things in the BAYT over the past two years. It would be impossible to credit everyone. The list of volunteers is mind boggling. Our committee chairs and members have dedicated their amazing talents to help the BAYT succeed and restore our shul to being one of the most distinguished shuls in the world. During the pandemic, our Rav worked tirelessly to ensure shiurim and lectures continued. Our community is extremely engaged in their spiritual growth of Torah, Chesed and Israel. It's a beautiful thing to see.

I looked up and saw the most beautiful gem of stained glass over the Aron Kodesh and could not remember the last time the lights shined on it. It was luminous. I can only imagine how stunning a wedding picture would look. The peeling ceiling is finally repaired. The Magen David restored to its elegance. And the air conditioning. The air conditioning. I've heard it my whole life. I cannot wait to hear the thank yous. Please direct them to the House Committee.

People have asked why we did not finish the main sanctuary. We are short in dollars, but not by much. Also, another impediment is the supply chain of materials. It is very difficult to predict when the complete renovation could be completed. Everyone is anxious to get back into the building and we have Simchas coming back into the building.

The minyanim are filling. We are coming alive again. It is exciting. Thank you to all the volunteers! You are amazing. Please take the time to thank them. It is well deserved. Budget and Finance, Youth Department, Technology, Catering, Obligations, Cemetery, Sister and Brotherhood, Health, Religious, Security, Singles and Young Families Committees and more... Yashar Koach. Well done!

Finally, thanks to my special friends on the Fundraising Committee, Rosy Rosenzweig, Chuck English, Moishe Posner and Mitch Silverstein. If anyone would like to join our committee or any other one, we could always use assistance. There is a lot to roll our sleeves up to.

Todah to the Professional Staff and of course our Rabbinical leadership of Rabbi Korobkin, Rabbi Lesher, Rabbi AZ Thau and Rabbi Metzger.

Our hard work and dedication are coming to fruition.



Must I give tzedakah to all who request it on Purim?

Giving tzedakah to one party could reduce the amount available for others. Therefore, we are usually required to investigate a tzedakah recipient or fund before giving a gift that would reduce our tzedakah for others. [There is an exception where the need expressed is dire and immediate, as in a request for a meal.]

However, on Purim we are instructed to increase people's joy and to give gifts of money and portions of food. Therefore, most halachic authorities rule that one should give to anyone who asks. A minority view contends that this rule applies only to distributors of communal tzedakah funds.

What is the purpose of Korbanot, sacrifices? Bnai Yisrael built the Mishkan but why do they offer Korbanot?

Various forms of the word Korban occur 25 times in Vayikra. While often translated as 'sacrifice' or 'offering' the Hebrew root of Korban is k.r.v. which means close. The root k.r.v appears 29 times in our Parshah, when not part of 'Korban'. But why is "close" so many times in Vayikra?

As hard as it is to connect and form a relationship with G-d, we are being encouraged to draw ever closer to G-d through Korbanot. They aren't simply offered as payment, they are a means to create a relationship with G-d and close that gap between man and G-d.

But how can we connect to G-d? Aren't we but mere physical flesh?

Rabbi Ezra Bick of Yeshivat Har Etzion explains we can connect to G-d the same way we connect to other people. By sharing experiences. By being physically and emotionally connected through shared actions. To connect via precise philosophical terms and definitions is unnecessary. We need to put in the time and energy and then we will be able to form that bond with G-d, however we can.
