The Rav and I spoke about the situation and the Rav reached out to the owner of the company. The owner was shocked to hear and read what had been posted on the internet and within a few days, we were advised that this antisemite was let go from the company. One antisemite at a time, we can all make a difference. Everyone in Vaughan has the right to feel safe and that has been reiterated by Mayor Del Duca and the Police Chief of Vaughan.

I look forward to a strong BAYT presence in Ottawa on Monday. Thank you to all who have signed up to travel by bus. Buses are departing from the Promenade. Details will be made available when we have them.

I think what I am about to write everyone knows, but I feel like writing this out is my therapy. I know that when I saw this story about Chana Kazir last Friday, it hurt me to my core. There is no question that there are multiple examples of the psychological warfare that our enemy is implementing, it is so cruel all without firing a shot. And they know that it emotionally disturbs every Jew throughout the entire world. Last Tuesday, our enemy had posted that Chana had died in their custody as a hostage. Low and behold, with the first batch of hostages released, Chana was alive (and well relatively speaking) Baruch Hashem. This is the torture they want us to feel. The thought of losing one hostage takes our breath away and we are overcome with insurmountable grief knowing we have lost one soul. And then we realize the opposite is true. The same is true with them releasing the hostages in batches. We are so happy one moment, filled with relief and joy and then we realize that there are many more children, women and men who are still held in captivity. We keep davening. Do not stop. Our tefillot are working. We must continue to daven, learn and perform chesed for brothers and sisters.

Several friends have asked if I would like to go out to a comedy event they had heard about during Chanukah called Candles and Comedy at the Royal Theatre on December 12th, with proceeds benefiting Magen David Adom. I had booked tickets weeks ago as our son Max Guttmann is one of the comedians.

We are told that "V'yehvater Yaacov", Yaacov was left alone. Rashi fills in why Yaacov was alone. He had forgotten some small jars on the other side of the river and went back for them. Yaacov had already brought all his animals and important possessions across the river, all that remained on the other side were some "small" jars. What was in these seemingly insignificant small jars that Yaacov would put his life in danger to retrieve them? The jars contained oil and they were to be used by Yaacov as "nesachim" (libations) for offerings that Yaacov was going to use to serve Hashem at the Stone Pillar he set up when he left Eretz Yisrael. By rescuing this "packh" (jar) of sacred oil, Hashem performed a miracle many years later for Yaakov's descendants who find a jar of sacred oil, the Chanukah miracle. We the Jewish people understand that every single drop of sacred oil matters, just like every hostage. Just like Yaacov, our brave soldiers will go back "across the river" to rescue even one small jar of oil. May that small drop of oil bring much light to a dark world.

The Significance of the Insignificant

If you have had the distinct pleasure of entering a government office, there are many things that can be uncomfortable. The long lines, the disgruntled government employees, and the endless background music all contribute to the experience. For me, more than the technical inconveniences, there is a deeper level of frustration. I cannot shake the feeling that I am just another name or number to them.

Feeling unique is basic to the human experience. If we are robbed of our sense of individuality, or purpose, we begin to lose sight of what it means to be human.

Rabbi Moshe Chaim Luzatto (1707-1746) writes in the first few lines of his *Mesilat Yesarim*:

*The foundation of piety and the root of perfect service [of G-d] is for a man to clarify and come to realize as truth what is his obligation **in his world**.*

R. Luzzatto does not refer to the generic service of G-d, but rather, to the individual mission that every single person is charged with.

In this week's Parsha, Yaakov prepares for battle with Esav. He makes all the necessary preparations and he splits his family into two camps. Right before this encounter, we are told that Yaakov was alone and wrestled with an angel until daybreak (*Bereishit* 32:25). Why was Yaakov alone on that fateful night? Rashi, citing Chazal, says that Yaakov was alone because he had left the camp to recover some small jugs that he had mistakenly left behind (*Bereishit Rabba* Ibid.).

This is very strange. Yaakov's confrontation with the angel is clearly a turning point for him. After he emerges victorious, Yaakov is renamed Yisrael -- the name that the Jewish people will carry forever, Bnei Yisrael, the children of Israel. Why is the introduction to this pivotal moment Yaakov returning for a few small jugs? This part of the narrative seems completely insignificant.

Perhaps that is exactly the point. A popular Jewish song, paraphrases a Midrash (*Bereishit Rabba* 77:1) which joins two verses together. One from *Yeshayahu* (2:11) and the verse from our Parsha:

ונשגב ה' לבדו ביום ההוא
ויותר יעקב לבדו ויאבק איש עמו עד עלות השחר

*None but Hashem **alone** shall be
Exalted that day
Yaakov was **alone** and a man wrestled with him until the break of dawn.*

The Midrash highlights the term לבדו — alone — in both verses. Just as Yaakov was alone on the night he went back for his jugs, Hashem is “alone” so-to-speak. Perhaps the message of the Midrash is that every single human being is endowed with a divine uniqueness. Just as G-d is completely “alone” and absolutely unique, man, in his own sphere, is also completely “alone.” He can be no one else, and no one else can be him. Maybe this is what Yaakov realized in the moments before his battle with the angel. Yaakov understood that he was unique. Everything he had, all of his talents, all of possessions, even his “pachim ketanim,” the seemingly insignificant things, were important. The inner strengths and qualities he had were unique to him, and him alone. What was valuable to Yaakov was not Esav's huge entourage of wealth or his army. Yaakov valued each and every item he owned not because of their prestige, but because they were his.

Every human being has a basic need to feel unique, valued, and wanted. But sometimes we lose sight of this in the natural ebb and flow of our daily lives. The truth is that we each have our own “pachim ketanim” in our lives. They are the things we may have left behind in the course of life, thinking that for whatever reason, they are trivial or unimportant. It may be a childhood dream or talent. It may be a unique skill that was never valued in the narrow confines of the school system. Yaakov teaches us that everything that happens to us is significant -- even the things that appear to be completely insignificant. All of what Hashem gives us is meant uniquely for us, and for us alone. So go out and look for your forgotten pachim ketanim. You may be surprised by what you will find along the way.

INTRODUCTION TO THE LAWS OF SHEMA

Intention for the First Verse of the Shema

One who says the first verse of the Shema without the proper intention does not fulfill the mitzvah. What is the proper intention?

The first thing to consider is what kind of speech act we are supposed to perform when saying this verse. It cannot be recited as part of reading the Torah or scanning through the text. Rather, it must be spoken as a declaration of beliefs with a full awareness of what one is declaring.

What are we declaring when we say this verse? The different schools of Jewish thought offer a variety of interpretations. This makes it difficult to pinpoint an exact answer. At the most basic level, we must "accept the yoke of heaven" through saying the verse. This means accepting that Hashem, the G-d revealed to us in Tanach and throughout the course of Jewish history, is our master and king. According to some, part of this acceptance requires a recognition that Hashem is the absolute master of everything and that there is no being or force that matches Him. This is denoted by the phrase "Hashem is one".

Beyond this basic intention, one should aim to understand and intend for the actual words of the verse according to a reliable interpretation.

Why did Esav kiss Yaakov when they reunited? Didn't Esav swear to kill Yaakov?

Based on the dots on top of Vayishikayhu מִשְׁכָּח Midrash Breishit Rabbah explains that Esav intended to bite Yaakov's neck linoshcho, not kiss him linoshko, but Yaakov's neck turned to marble and Esav began to cry because of his broken teeth.

Rashi gives two options: 1) either that Esav wasn't genuine in his actions towards Yaakov and didn't kiss him wholeheartedly, or 2) Esav was overcome by emotion when Yaakov and his family bowed before him so Esav wholeheartedly kissed him.

Rabbi Shimshon Raphael Hirsch builds up and buttresses Rashi's second point - "That here purely humane feelings overcame Esav is warranted for by the little word וַיִּשְׁכַּח, they wept. A kiss can be false but not tears that flow at such moments. Tears are drops from one's innermost soul. This kiss, and these tears show us that Esav was also a descendent of Avraham. In Esav, there must have been something more than just the wild hunter. ... and it is just Jacob on whom Esav has the most opportunity to show, that, and how, the principle of humaneness begins to affect him."

May we all merit to be reunited with our brothers and sisters whom we have not met in far too long. Not only that, but we will be able to genuinely express our heartfelt feelings just as R' Hirsch believes even Esav did.
