May I use any kind of food for mishloach manot?

Megilat Esther (9:21-22) mentions the mitzvah of giving gifts ('portions') on Purim, and we are taught that these should be gifts of food, supporting the recipient's Purim seudah (feast). We give two foods to at least one recipient; ideally, each portion should be large enough to provide for an independent Purim seudah. A beverage is also acceptable as a portion.

There is no basis for the common notion that the two foods must require separate berachot; just the opposite, it is clear in Gemara and Shulchan Aruch that foods of the same berachah may be used. However, some authorities do require that they be two "types of food", and using foods of separate berachot would guarantee fulfillment of this expectation.

While mishloach manot is a beautiful mitzvah, one who must restrict his Purim expenditures should put more toward matanot la'evyonim than to mishloach manot.

Individually United

Why are both the voluntary donations from the beginning of Vayakhel of all sorts of materials (Shemot 35:4-10) and the required half-shekel of silver of each individual that we read for maftir, Parshat Shekalim (Shemot 30:11-16), needed? Wouldn't one or the other have sufficed?

The donations from this week's Parshah allow for individuals to contribute in ways that they personally feel valuable and is triggered by Nediv Libo, whoever's heart is moved to do so. This immense degree of freedom allows each person to achieve their own sincere connection to the Mishkan.

The mandatory half-shekel of silver is the same whether a person is rich or poor. Rabbi Shimshon Raphael Hirsch explains this show how each and every to person can fully contribute to the Mishkan, and service of G-d, regardless of their station.

Both voluntary donations and the required half-shekel combine to show that not only does every individual have the ability to personally connect to the Mishkan and G-d, but they also have the ability to fully contribute and come together as a people, a united people, serving G-d in an ideal way.

Dear Friends,

Some of you have expressed confusion on how to commemorate yahrzeits that fall in Adar when we have a leap year such as ours. Firstly, I apologize for any lack of clarity in our communications to you. You may have received two emails, informing you of the yahrzeit dates in Adar I and in Adar II. To clarify: When a loved one's yahrzeit is in Adar, Ashkenazic tradition is to commemorate the yahrzeit primarily in Adar I. That said, the Ram"i recommends commemorating the yahrzeit in BOTH Adars, which is the reason for the double dates that some of our members have been receiving. Please let me know if you have any further questions. As always, if the office has an incorrect date for the yahrzeit of your loved one, you can always change the information yourself by logging into bayt.ca and updating your personal information. Alternatively, please contact the office. Thank you!
