Young & Old Torah

It takes seventeen parshiot to finally arrive at Har Sinai and Hashem blesses k'lal Yisrael with the ultimate prize, the Torah!

I love writing about Daf Yomi for so many reasons, but not long ago I became aware of a great BAYT story that I would like to share. One thing I have learned over the years is that you can start the Daf at any point. Never too early or too late to start. Might as well start today. If you happen to miss a few days (Purim and Pesach are coming) and you find yourself unable to catch up, many people just never get back on the Daf wagon. My advice is - don't worry about falling behind, just get back into it and you will make up what you missed in your free time. Hopefully, if that advice doesn't inspire you, maybe this will.

Rabbi Lesher was telling me that he has a fifteen year old young man who has been attending the 6am Daf Yomi every day (and always on time!) since Nedarim (smart man for starting after Yevamot). This is so impressive. This sensational dedication by Josh Gruenfeld hopefully will inspire other members of our shul, young and old, to join the Daf or any other shiurim. I wish I had started learning Daf at fifteen. I think about what I was doing at fifteen and the Daf was definitely not on the list. Kol hakavod Josh. I'm sure Josh wasn't thinking about being a role model, but he is. He's my role model. And of course, this does not come by accident and there have got to be special parents behind the scenes. Max is the Gabbai for our Bais Medrash Minyan on Shabbat and I'm told that Rachelle is always so friendly to everyone. The BAYT is truly blessed to have this mishpacha as members OR The BAYT is truly blessed by this mishpacha.

And this leads me to my second role model, Larry Tover z"l, Leib Reuven ben Shmuel Shabsai, father of Robin Berglas who passed away last week in Israel. Pa, as he was affectionately known, lost his wife of 57 years, Sheila z"l seven years ago. Pa was a Californian through and through, born in San Fran but eventually moved to Los Angeles following Rabbi Wasserman. After Sheila passed and with no children remaining in the area, Pa decided he would make aliyah at the ripe age of 82. Pa checked himself into Kollel and learned Torah each and every day. He had a full schedule, nap included. He made it a point to learn with single young bochrim in the afternoon and would give advice on dating. Pa worked his entire life in the insurance business but chesed and community service was always at the forefront. He was President of the Emek Jewish day school and one of the founders of the Valley Torah High School (VTC), helping countless yeshivas and charities thrive, yet Pa made the time to sit and learn. It's never too late to start, that's what learned from Pa.

This Shabbat we will read about Matan Torah. 600,000 men, women and children prepared for this momentous occasion to bear witness. And now in 5783, Jews continue to learn the written and oral Torah 3,300 years later. Many nations have come and gone and anyone can grow their knowledge of Torah to unprecedented levels. Josh and Pa are proof. Two inspirations at different ends of the age spectrum with one common goal.



I received fine china from a relative who did not keep kosher. Is kashering possible?

The consensus of Ashkenazi halachic authorities is that porcelain (which includes the material colloquially termed "china") is what the Talmud calls cheres, a clay-based material. Halachically, cheres is said to absorb food which is cooked in it, and kashering does not adequately purge the absorbed food.

In a case of great loss, especially when the dishes involved are rarely used on a flame, some authorities permit the following method: Leave the utensils un-used for 12 months, and then perform hagalah three times, in three different pots of boiling water.

G-d's first communication to Bnei Yisrael after receiving the Ten Commandments is to not make idols. Instead, we are commanded to serve G-d on rough altars of dirt or unhewn stone and not have stairs leading up. (Shemot 20:19-23)

Bnei Yisrael was shaken and fearful after the awe-inspiring experience that was the Revelation at Har Sinai. So overpowering was their fear that they kept backing away from the mountain and they asked Moshe to convey to them G-d's prophecies, not to receive directly from G-d for fear of death. (Shemot 15-18)

G-d lays out the framework of an easy and gradual manner for Bnei Yisrael to serve Him after the overwhelmingly powerful encounter with the divine they had at Har Sinai. Bnei Yisrael isn't expected to construct fancy artwork or massive structures like those they had seen in Egypt, built with violent iron and used for idolatry. Instead, G-d tells Bnei Yisrael to make simple altars that don't even have steps ascending. G-d commands us to serve Him gradually, sloping our way up in a gradual fashion, making this relationship accessible to every individual who witnessed G-d at Har Sinai.







Adam S. Ferziger is professor in the Israel and Golda Koschitzky Department of Jewish History and Contemporary Jewry at Bar-Ilan University and holds the Rabbi S.R. Hirsch Chair for Research on the Torah and Derekh Erez Movement. He is a senior associate at the Oxford Centre for Hebrew and Jewish Studies, University of Oxford and co-convener of the annual Oxford Summer Institute on Modern and Contemporary Judaism. His research focuses on the history of religious responses to modern and contemporary life in Western Europe, North American, and Israel.

He is the author or editor of seven books, including Exclusion and Hierarchy (University of Pennsylvania Press, 2005), Jewish Denominations (Melton Institute – The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, 2012), and his monograph, Beyond Sectarianism (Wayne State University Press, 2015), was the winner of the National Jewish Book Award.

In parallel to his academic career, Adam Ferziger was a congregational rabbi in Kfar-Sava, and has dedicated over thirty years to performing weddings and providing religious services to a wide spectrum of Israeli Jews in a meaningful and nonjudgmental manner.


