Parshas Yisro Summary

In this week's parsha, Yitro hears of all the miracles that Hashem did for the Jews, and he decides to go visit them. When Yitro meets Moshe in the desert, he can see how much Moshe is with helping the Jewish people. Yitro gives Moshe some advice– he tells him that working this hard will be exhausting and wear him out. He suggests that Moshe appoint judges to help the Jews with their questions. Moshe likes this idea and appoints the judges. The Jews then travel to Sinai where Hashem tells them to accept the Torah. The Jews all go to Har Sinai where they see a big white cloud and hear a long, loud blast of a shofar. Hashem then gives Moshe the ten commandments for the Jewish people.

The ten commandments are:

1. Believe in Hashem
2. Do not worship idols
3. Do not swear in the name of Hashem
4. Keep shabbat
5. Honour your parents
6. Do not kill
7. Do not act immorally
8. Do not steal
9. Do not falsely testify against others
10. Don't be jealous of others
