Weekly Halachah

I missed Borchu in davening; may I recite it at the end, if I have a minyan responding?

In some communities, the chazan customarily recites Borchu at the conclusion of Shacharit and Maariv on weekdays, for the benefit of latecomers. However, this is not standard practice in Ashkenazi minyanim outside of Israel, and a chazan must not deviate from the local custom.

Even if a minyan does not recite Borchu routinely at the end of davening, a latecomer who came late and missed Borchu, and who has not yet davened, may recite Borchu and then daven.

If a latecomer misses Borchu but completes the rest of davening by the time the minyan finishes, some authorities rule that he should not recite Borchu. However, others permit it if he has not heard Borchu at all that day.

SHORT VORT ON PARSHAS KI SISA BY: THE RAV

Why is the commandment to build the Kiyor, the large laver (sink) in the Mishkan, written here, in Parshas Ki Tisa, and not earlier in Parshas Terumah, where all the other Mishkan utensils were itemized? Bas Ayin by Rabbi Avraham Dov Auerbach of Avritch (19th cent.) suggests that originally, the Kiyor was not considered necessary for the Mishkan's construction. The Jewish people were on such a high level of innate purity, that washing hands was not deemed necessary as a means of purification before approaching the Temple service. However, once they sinned with the Golden Calf, Bnei Yisrael were demoted from their lofty innate status and therefore could only approach Divine service through purification beforehand. This is why the commandment to construct the Kiyor was added later, and appears in the same parshas as the Golden Calf, to imply that its construction was only necessary because of that sin.

Many have pointed to the uncanny connection of the commandment to wash our hands in the Kiyor to the directive today of washing our hands to avoid spreading the Covid-19 virus. Let's realize that we need purification, both physically and spiritually. Wash you hands often, and wash your soul often!


