MEN'S MIKVEH

Kel Maleh: This Shabbos YES, Next Shabbos NO

Please note: The Maddie Leventhal Mikvah will once again, unfortunately, be unavailable for men to toivel on erev Rosh Hashanah and erev Yom Kippur. We feel that due to Covid we must still err on the side of caution and keep everyone's safety a paramount consideration. The Rav advises men who would like to toivel to either use a private swimming pool (which is kosher for men only for these purposes), or to rely on the principle of "tes kabin," which states that as long as a certain amount of running water passes over your body, you may consider yourself purified. Certainly taking a 10 minute shower with your head under the showerhead satisfies this requirement.

Thank you for your understanding. We hope to accommodate your toiveling needs in the future. Chag sameach and Shanah tovah.

ROSH HASHANAH & YOM KIPPUR SHTENDERS

For fire and safety reasons, as well as ease of movement, shtenders will not be allowed in any Minyan during Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Security guards will be instructed to deny entry to anyone trying to bring in a shtender before davening. Any shtenders being used in contravention of the Shul's policy will be confiscated and returned after Yom Kippur.

TASHLICH

It is customary to go to a body of water and do Tashlich over Rosh Hashanah. If one was unable to do Tashlich on Rosh Hashanah, one may do so any time until Hashana Rabbah. This year, we are recommending that if you normally go to the Duck Pond on Centre St. or another venue which is densely populated for Tashlich, that you NOT go on Rosh Hashanah so as to avoid the problem of a lack of social distancing. Please remember that we are still amidst a pandemic; our health safety takes halakhic priority over gathering for Tashlich.

PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE-PARSHAS NETZAVIM

At the beginning of my term, we spoke of the need for cultural changes at BAYT. How we run the shul. How BAYT treats our members, our employees, and other stakeholders. How our members, employees, and other stakeholders treat BAYT. Cultural changes are the hardest ones to implement in any organization. They face resistance, take time, test patience, and demand persistence, particularly in an Orthodox shul. By all accounts, BAYT is on the right track.

Collectively, you renewed your memberships in record time this year. Thank you! We know the process can be challenging even when fully automated. Some changes we made this year were and will continue to be challenging for a few. Membership renewal will close earlier this year (but fewer will be affected due to so many timely renewals) so we can free up resources to provide better member service. We know our membership structure is overly complex. We <u>must</u> improve it in time for renewal next year. We have a volunteer outside advisor on deck who has offered to help us develop implementable membership changes. Binyan HaBAYT represents a critical cultural change. It is proving to be a success (even though some may not like the emails). We thank those who have been able to join Binyan HaBAYT.

Success can be a double-edged sword. You already know we were swamped with more requests for outdoor seating than actual seats. Over 500 requests for 300 spaces. Many of you responded favourably when asked if you would take a seat inside. But that still left us 160 outdoor seats short with more than a handful of unhappy members. But of course, cultural change dictated we try to find a way to accommodate more of you outdoors. But how? There are no additional tents available for rent anywhere regardless of cost.

Last Friday, I had the passing thought to call Councilman Alan Shefman's office for help. His always helpful executive assistant, Debi Traub, put our office in touch with the right people. Lo' and behold, for a nominal fee, BAYT secured two canopies from the City of Vaughan with additional capacity for up to 100 more socially distanced seats outside. That was the easy part. Driving stakes into the ground requires us to check for underground utilities. And engineers need to oversee set up. And we needed more chairs. But thanks to Karen Zilberberg and David Vodianoi, we made it happen within three days.

That our amazing office staff has coalesced into a tight team is further evidence of positive cultural changes at BAYT. They get along with one another, appreciate each other's strengths and challenges and cover for one another whenever needed. Team members go the extra mile for one another. And for you. We all owe an incredible amount of gratitude to our office staff and, of course, our hard-working facilities team. May the new year be one of blessing for each of them and their loved ones.

Not all cultural change is good including some brought on by the pandemic. After 18 months, COVID-19 challenges our collective patience, as a kehillah and as Canadians. The stress is palpable and increasing. Yes, BAYT members have been overwhelmingly supportive of our COVID-19 protocols. Some members, notably a few physicians, think we should be doing even more. And a few don't believe any of it.

On average, fully vaccinated persons constitute roughly 20% of daily new COVID-19 cases in Ontario. But fully vaccinated persons get significantly less sick and require far fewer hospitalizations than unvaccinated individuals. As our daily lives start to migrate from the sunshine to indoors, new cases will increase. This week, evolving public health guidance compelled BAYT to adopt additional COVID-19 protocols. These changes are workable and non-exclusionary, if not stop gap and less than ideal. As we have done since March 2020, BAYT will continue to adapt to the ever-changing public health situation in order to keep our members safe.

On Parshat Nitzavim, Rabbi Jonathan Sacks z'l teaches:

Our faith – Moses is telling us – is not like that of the Egyptians, the Greeks, the Romans, or virtually every other civilisation known to history. We do not find G-d in a realm beyond life – in heaven, or after death, in mystic disengagement from the world or in philosophical contemplation. We find G-d in life. We find G-d in (the key words of Devarim) love and joy. To find G-d... you don't have to climb to heaven or cross the sea (Deut. 30:12-13). G-d is here. G-d is now. G-d is life.

We all take pride in the fact that Medinat Yisrael has led the global charge against COVID-19. We choose life. While politics and policy may have caused Israel to let its guard down, our Covenantal intuition caused Israel to quickly respond with an effective third vaccine protocol. Because we choose life.

Rabbi Yitz Greenberg writes this week:

Moses mentions that the Torah lines up blessing and curse, life and death, alongside each other and asks us to choose life. This is a reminder that every human behavior can advance life and be a blessing, but that same action (done or applied improperly) can be a curse that increases evil in the world. This is why living covenantally requires constant monitoring, preparation, and review. The coming High Holiday season reminds us that if we fail or do evil—inevitably we all do some—we can repent. We can admit our sin, make reparation to people we hurt, and change our behavior going forward. This turn to life is the central message of the Torah and the central purpose of the life of covenant.

Unchecked, COVID-19 is death not life. As we gather this Shabbat and Yamim Noraim, choose life. Help keep COVID-19 away from our BAYT. May we witness the end of COVID-19 once and for all in 5782. And may it be a year filled with more positive change for our beloved BAYT.

What if I don't have a new fruit for the second night of Rosh haShanah?

The second day of Rosh haShanah is considered an extension of the first day in certain ways. Since it is not a fully independent holiday, the berachah of Shehechiyanu may not be appropriate when lighting candles or reciting kiddush that night. Therefore, we customarily provide an additional reason for reciting Shehechiyanu, such as by having a new fruit present, or wearing new clothing.

Normally, Shechiyanu should be recited for a fruit only if there are seasonal periods when it is unavailable. However, for the sake of the Shehechiyanu on Rosh haShanah one may use any fruit one hasn't eaten in a year. In truth, one who has neither new clothing nor a new fruit should still recite Shechiyanu.

Yasis Alayich Elokayich

We sing Yasis Alayich Elokayich Kimsos Chatan al Kallah at Jewish weddings. But why do we sing that 'G-d will rejoice over us like a groom does for his bride'? Where does this idea come from?

This song comes from our Haftarah, Yeshayahu 62:5, in a slightly different word order. Our Haftarah is the last of the Haftarot comforting us for the destruction of the Beit Hamikdash.

But why do we sing this verse in particular? Our Haftarah begins with Bnei Yisrael yearning for the time when they will be able to fully rejoice and enjoy G-d's Divine Presence, as G-d dresses them like a groom with priestly glory and like a bride adorned in her finery and jewelry. G-d responds that He will not be silent nor rest for our sakes, instead protect us until He is able to rejoice over us like a groom does for his bride. We sing the song Yasis Alayich Elokayich while we are dressed up for a wedding, in our finest clothes hoping and praying to G-d, showing how excited we are for the moment we are in, looking forward to one day when we will once again be able to fully rejoice with G-d with the rebuilt Beit Hamikdash.





