BAYT HIGH HOLY DAY YOUTH PROGRAMS SAFETY POLICIES

In order to protect the safety of the children, ensure the success of the youth programs and preserve the decorum in the building, we ask that parents fully co-operate with the following procedures:

1. Children should not be roaming the halls. Children without a seat in an adult minyan should be in the appropriate youth program or with a parent.
2. Parents should accompany their children to the appropriate youth program for check-in.
3. Children in the Nursery and the Kindergarten programs must wear their labels and older children should have their tickets with them.
4. In order to protect the safety of all children, we ask that you do not send snacks with your children. **Some children have very distinct and severe food allergies. A shared snack could result in a serious situation.** Snacks will be provided in all youth programs on Rosh Hashanah morning and sandwiches (no peanut butter) will be provided for lunch on Yom Kippur.
5. Please check on your children at appropriate intervals. Older siblings will not be permitted to stay in the Nursery and Kindergarten programs with their brothers or sisters.
6. Strollers and baby carriages are not permitted in the building as they present a hazard in the event of a required evacuation. They may be stored in the utility room behind the lower floor elevator or outside by the bike rack to the right of the parking door entrance. For fire and safety purposes, this rule will be strictly enforced. Any strollers and carriages found inside the building will be removed to the designated storage space.
7. Please inform the youth leaders of any pertinent medical issues / concerns.



President's Message:

Who has kept us alive and sustained us and brought us to this occasion

I am especially grateful that I will be able to return this year to shul for the High Holidays, without a mask, without spaces in between seats, without restrictions on the length of davening and singing. When I try to figure out where I want to go in the coming year, I always try to reflect on where I have come from in the past.

I know when Covid first hit, my family's safety and the safe and continued operation of my business were all I could think about 24/7, but planted in my brain during the first few months of the pandemic was a commitment to take on more learning and to step up for the community. May I eat before hearing the shofar on Rosh Hashanah?

Ideally, a man should not eat before participating in the mitzvah of shofar. Women may eat, because their participation in shofar is voluntary.

A man who is too weak to daven properly may eat after shacharit, before hearing shofar; he should recite kiddush and eat an olive-sized amount of cake in order to fulfill his kiddush obligation. However, he should not eat a full meal; he should just eat enough to be able to daven.

Some authorities contend this should only be done by individuals and in private, to avoid causing people to take the halachic issue of eating before shofar lightly. Nonetheless, some yeshivot and communities deliberately hold a communal kiddush after shacharit for several halachic reasons, including a desire to avoid fasting past midday.

D'VAR TORAH

What Mitzvah is so difficult to grasp that the Torah needs to spend four whole verses to explain that it is attainable? (Devarim 30:11-14)

Ramban answers that this Mitzvah is the Mitzvah of Teshuva, of returning to G-d through repentance.

When the relationship between G-d and us looks irreparable, that is precisely when we need to know that G-d is right there and waiting. Not only that, but Moshe informs the Jews that not only is G-d waiting for them to return, but this return is actually a mitzvah. Understanding precisely how Bnei Yisrael must be feeling right now, Moshe continues that this mitzvah isn't something wondrous or distant. Teshuvah isn't hiding in the heavens, such that someone would need to go up to the Heavens and bring it down for us and show us how to do it. Nor is it on the far side of the sea, such that someone else would need to be brave in order to deliver and instruct us about it. It is close to you; it is within the grasp of your mouth and heart to do it.

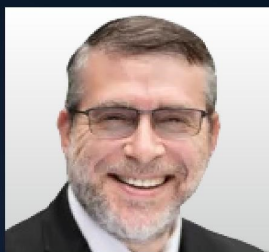

BAYT SECURITY PROTOCOL

When Entering and Exiting BAYT

- ♦ Please cooperate with the instructions and requests of Safety Team volunteers, security guards and police.
- ♦ BAYT is private property. All persons and their belongings are subject to search upon entry to BAYT property. Entry can be denied if consent is not provided. Have your belongings open for search by the time you get to the doors.
- ♦ Have your High Holiday admission ticket displayed for entry. Proceed ONLY to the minyan for which you signed up.
- ♦ Only enter and exit through the designated doors where volunteers or Security personnel are stationed. All emergency exits are alarmed and will signal Vaughan Fire Department.
- ♦ Avoid congregating in and around the shul.
- ♦ Don't distract Safety Team volunteers, BAYT employees, security guards and police from focusing on our collective safety and security.
- ♦ Safely greet unfamiliar guests and offer your assistance.
- ♦ If you see something, say something. Remain aware of your surroundings.
- ♦ Report suspicious persons, bags or parcels to a Safety Team volunteer, facility crew member, security guard or BAYT Executive member. Do not open unattended bags
- ♦ Weapons of any kind, whether licensed or not, are prohibited at all times. Police will be summoned if anyone is found to have a weapon.

In and Around BAYT

- ♦ Report suspicious persons or vehicles to a Safety Team volunteer, facility crew member, security guard or BAYT Executive member. Try to remember license plates, descriptions, location, description of driver, make and model, colour, etc.

In the Event of a Physical Threat or Attack

- ♦ BAYT has procedures in place that have been coordinated with York Regional Police. Alert Safety Team volunteers or guard. Failing which call 911.
- ♦ Follow instructions of Safety Team volunteers & facilities crew, security guards or police
- ♦ If instructed to evacuate BAYT do so immediately – DO NOT look for family members OR take personal belongings.
- ♦ Move as fast as possible to Designated Safe Area along perimeter fence of Parking Lot or where instructed. DO NOT block Fire Lanes around BAYT.
- ♦ Do not pull a fire alarm in the event of a threat or attack.

In the Event of a Fire Alarm

- ♦ Follow posted emergency evacuation procedures.
- ♦ Be aware of the closest fire exits and exit routes.
- ♦ Children in youth programs will be evacuated by youth leaders.
- ♦ Do not congregate near the entry doors or Block fire lanes. Evacuate to Safe Evacuation areas along perimeter fence of the parking lot.
- ♦ Do not re-enter BAYT until given the all clear by BAYT leadership

In the Event of a Medical Emergency

- ♦ Notify a gabbai or Safety Team volunteer. Each minyan has designated physicians and some EMTs and Certified First Aid Responders.
- ♦ Procedures are in place to call and direct first responders and access BAYT medical equipment
- ♦ Stand back. Allow first responders to treat the patient.
- ♦ Keep hallways and access points clear.
