How early may we daven maariv on the first night of Shavuot?

Generally, we may begin Shabbat and most Yamim Tovim early, and this is considered meritorious. However, in recent centuries halachic authorities have contended that we should not recite kiddush on the first night of Shavuot until the stars emerge. Many even contend that one may not daven maariv until the stars emerge. The standard practice in our communities is indeed to wait to start maariv.

The most popular explanation for waiting until nightfall is that the Torah says to count seven complete weeks, leading up to Shavuot. Starting Shavuot early would abbreviate those seven weeks. Some even contend that this applies for every night of the Omer – that counting early inappropriately abbreviates the previous day.

Another rationale for starting Shavuot late is that Vayikra 23:21 says to declare Shavuot “in the etzem of this day,” which may mean on the day itself, not earlier.

The BAYT position is to start maariv on the first night of Shavuot this year no earlier than 9:30 PM.

On the other hand, there is good reason to start Shabbat early on the second night of Shavuot. One of the justifications for the eruv tavshilin that permits cooking on Friday of Yom Tov for Shabbat is the fact that one could also use the food on Friday itself, if need be. Therefore, we avoid cooking close to sunset, as it would be unlikely that one would use the food on Friday. By accepting Shabbat early, we ensure that we will not cook close to sunset.

Why is Shavuot the only holiday without a set calendar date in the Torah? Why is it fifty days after Pesach, upon the conclusion of the Omer? Especially since we received the Torah on Shavuot, isn't that a date worthy of celebrating yearly?

Rabbi Eliezer Melamed in Peninei Halakha explains that Shavuot and receiving the Torah depend on the messages that we received on Pesach when we left Egypt. “These interconnected principles are the Jewish people’s uniqueness, and simple faith (emuna peshuta). ... However, for this faith to reach its full expression and allow us to help the world progress toward redemption, we need the Torah as well, for it contains the values, commandments, and guidance necessary to perfect the world. ... Without the natural and basic Jewish faith revealed on Pesa, it would be impossible to arrive at the deep and complex faith represented by Shavu’ot. Conversely, our natural faith and our uniqueness could not survive without the Torah given on Shavu’ot.

G-d gave us the festivals of Pesa and Shavu’ot so that we may relive the miraculous events of the Exodus, and to once again remind us of the uniqueness of the Jews and simple faith. These realizations allow us to use the time period of Sefirat Ha-omer to gradually ascend to the sacred day on which the Torah was given, when our faith becomes whole and complete. Each year we are able to rise higher and higher.”

As we learn Torah together on Shavuot it is the crescendo that began with Pesach. One that we continue to grow from each year.




