WEEKLY HALACHAH BY RABBI TORCZYNER TORCZYNER@TORONTOTORAH.COM

I stayed up throughout Shavuot night; do I say Elokai Neshamah in the morning?

The berachah of Elokai Neshamah is recited each morning to thank G-d for restoring our souls to our bodies, after we have slept. Halachic authorities debate whether this is a personal berachah about our own sleep, or a global berachah thanking G-d for enabling sleep for humanity.

If the berachah is global, then we should recite it each morning regardless of whether we have slept. If the berachah is personal, then we should recite it only after we actually sleep. Within the latter view, estimates of how much sleep would trigger this berachah vary; one commonly cited number is 30 minutes.

Therefore: One who did not sleep for 30 minutes straight during the night should satisfy both views by hearing the berachah from someone who has slept. If no such person is available, one may recite the berachah and rely upon the view that the berachah is global rather than personal.

Why does Har Sinai not retain any sanctity after we received the Ten Commandments and Torah there, while Har HaBayit, the Temple Mount, is still holy even almost 2,000 years after the destruction?

Dr. Murray Herbert Danzger Z"L, my Zadie and a sociologist who authored *Returning to Tradition*, about the Baal Teshuva Movement, explained based on the Rambam, that in Judaism we don't make places holy simply because G-d came down to meet us, or a prophet prophesied. Making a place eternally holy can only be done when people go up to G-d to greet Him, not when G-d comes to us. That is why the Temple Mount retains its sanctity while Har Sinai did not.

It is up to each and every one of us to go up this Shavuot to embrace the Torah and bring sanctity into our lives and homes.
