How early in the morning may I put on tefillin?

We do not put on tefillin unless there is sufficient daylight to recognize a casual acquaintance from several feet away; this time is called "misheyakir". Some explain that we wait until misheyakir because visibility is a core requirement for tefillin; others say we wait until misheyakir lest someone don tefillin earlier and fall asleep while wearing them. The BAYT calculates misheyakir as one hour before sunrise.

One whose work requires him to <u>begin davening</u> before *misheyakir*, and who is unlikely to fall asleep, may don tefillin without a berachah as early as necessary. After *misheyakir* he should recite the berachah and touch the tefillin.

One who will need to <u>complete the entire davening</u> before *misheyakir* should don tefillin for davening without a berachah, and find a later time to don tefillin with a berachah, repeating Shema, even late in the day. If putting on tefillin later would be impossible, significant authorities permit reciting a berachah even before *misheyakir*.

The source to be extremely happy on Sukkot and the holidays appears to be from the song ViSamachta biChagecha ViHayitah Ach Sameach, "and you shall be happy on your holidays, truly very happy" (Devarim 16:14-15)

This song is from the Torah but it is actually the beginning of one verse and the end of the subsequent verse. In between ViSamachta biChagecha and ViHayitah Ach Sameach includes @you, your sons and daughters, servants and Leviim, converts, orphans, and widows," the less fortunate in your cities. Not only that, the 7 days of celebration of Sukkot and doing so in Jerusalem are included as well. Only once you've fulfilled all that is in between, making sure to care for those in need and are subsequently blessed by G-d, will you truly be Ach Sameach extremely happy.

True, it is certainly enjoyable to celebrate and serve G-d wherever you are in the world but when you celebrate together with everyone else in the place G-d chooses, particularly in Yerushalayim, in His House, the Beit Hamikdash. That is when and where and with whom you will experience a whole new level of joy and happiness.

The BAYT West Side Garden – We are Thankful for a Community Experience in Charity and Achdus

In Late March 2022, the BAYT Board was faced with a critical decision. The Board never gave specific direction / permission for someone to go after the New Horizons for Seniors grant. So now, the Board was faced with a dilemma, return the \$24,000 dollars that the Canadian Government entrusted BAYT with, on behalf of the Canadian Taxpayers, or accept a plan to create the BAYT West Side Garden.

Although not unanimous, the vote to accept the money was passed. A follow-on motion requested permission to establish the BAYT West Side Garden in the 32×80 foot fenced in area on the York Hill Boulevard side. Permission was granted.

Izzy Kutnowski & Fred Winegust joined forces as the co-chairs of the BAYT-WSG Committee in April 2022. To keep project costs down, BAYT leveraged work already done by Reena in 2021 and became the first organization to implement the Reena Community Farm, Neighbourhood Model.

By establishing this relationship with Reena, BAYT was able to leverage Reena's existing volume procurement agreement for above ground containers, soil and non-manure smelling fertilizer mix, and their standardized seven vegetable plant set.

As a Reena partner, BAYT was able to take advantage of on-line education and supporting You Tube video, developed by Reena and Centennial College with subject matter help from the York Region Food Network and Niagara Region's Small Scale Farms

100 above ground containers were procured. Each container had a 10 liter reservoir which was easy to fill using the protruding pipe and a visual indicator to indicate when the resevoir was full.

An ad was then placed in the BAYT Passover bulletin looking for 25 families to participate in the program. Each family would be given 4 containers to manage. It took until early May for all families to sign up.

Each family was given the opportunity to "Eat What they Grow", "Give What they Grow" or a hybrid of the two.

In May

- 200 bags of soil arrived, along with 100 powder fertilizer packets.
- Rebbetzin Laura Stein organized 15 volunteers from NCSY Torah High, who helped load and place the 100 containers.
- Pre-ordered Vegetables arrived and were planted by the participating BAYT families
- Starter plants were Cucumbers, Peppers, Tomatoes, Green Onions and Eggplants
- Radishes and Yellow Beans were started by seed.

In June, Tova Guttenberg's Israeli grandchildren planted the 250 plant Pollinator Garden on the York Hill side of the fence. These plants were donated by the Toronto and Region Conservation Authority and the City of Vaughan, as part of the Thornhill Sustainable Neighbourhood Action Plan.

We hired a summer student, Yochi Deutsch, to be responsible for keeping the water reservoirs full and the pollinator garden watered.

And yet, the question was raised, "Was the government right to provide BAYT with \$24,000 in order to grow \$2,000 worth of food".

Here is a representative group of the BAYT West Side Garden farmers who answer that question;

"This was a great experience for all of us to learn how to seed a garden from start to finish. It encompassed many generations and brought a group together to create a wonderful community experience and allowed us to give back to others" - Lithwick Family

"This year's activity will last us all for many years to come. One cannot put a value on the forming of friendships and family ties facilitated by this garden." - Kutnowski Family

"Clearly we have achieved all of New Horizons for Seniors Program objectives as stated in their website: promoting volunteerism among seniors and other generations, engaging seniors in the community, supporting inclusion of seniors, etc." - Crandell Family

"This experience was truly medicine for my soul. Nice to see the other gardeners and chat time especially since locked up for 2 years with the Covid crisis. Really great summer." Kurlandski Family.

In September we established a table outside the fenced area, where our BAYT farmers were able to put the produce they grew into wicker baskets. Whenever this was done, the BAYT Chesed WhatsApp group was notified. "If you need it – Take, If you know someone who needs – Tell Them, Take from the Basket, Not the Garden".

On occasion, after distributing vegetables to Reena Residences, Apartments, Selling its produce, and bartering with York Region Food Network, Reena would also contribute some of its leftover produce to the BAYT "Grow to Give" basket.

Rambam has identified eight levels of charity, each level greater than the next. The second highest level of charity is to give to the poor without knowing to whom one gives, and without the recipient knowing from who s/he received. This is performing a mitzvah solely for the sake of heaven. This was the essence of the "Grow to Give" experience at the BAYT West Side Garden

As we approach Sukkot, we have celebrated a wonderful first harvest, and the BAYT West Side Garden is in the midst of being dismantled.

You cannot put a price on Achdus and high levels of Charity, but we believe the 2022 BAYT West Side Garden experience has brought a new level of community thinking to BAYT. Not everything can be expressed in dollars and cents.

And we hope to repeat the experience in 2023 for more members of the BAYT Community



When Entering and Exiting BAYT

- Please cooperate with the instructions and requests of Safety Team volunteers, security guards and police.
- BAYT is private property. All persons and their belongings are subject to search upon entry to BAYT property. Entry can be denied if consent is not provided. Have your belongings open for search by the time you get to the doors.
- Have your High Holiday admission ticket displayed for entry. Proceed ONLY to the minyan for which you signed up.
- Only enter and exit through the designated doors where volunteers or Security personnel are stationed. All emergency exits are alarmed and will signal Vaughan Fire Department.
- Avoid congregating in and around the shul.
- Don't distract Safety Team volunteers, BAYT employees, security guards and police from focusing on our collective safety and security.
- Safely greet unfamiliar guests and offer your assistance.
- If you see something, say something. Remain aware of your surroundings.
- Report suspicious persons, bags or parcels to a Safety Team volunteer, facility crew member, security guard or BAYT Executive member. Do not open unattended bags.
- Weapons of any kind, whether licensed or not, are prohibited at all times. Police will be summoned if anyone is found to have a weapon.

In and Around BAYT

• Report suspicious persons or vehicles to a Safety Team volunteer, facility crew member, security guard or BAYT Executive member. Try to remember license plates, descriptions, location, description of driver, make and model, colour, etc.

In the Event of a Physical Threat or Attack

- BAYT has procedures in place that have been coordinated with York Regional Police. Alert Safety Team volunteers or guard. Failing which call 911.
- Follow instructions of Safety Team volunteers & facilities crew, security guards or police.
- If instructed to evacuate BAYT do so immediately DO NOT look for family members OR take personal belongings.
- Move as fast as possible to Designated Safe Area along perimeter fence of Parking Lot or where instructed. DO NOT block Fire Lanes around BAYT.
- Do not pull a fire alarm in the event of a threat or attack.

In the Event of a Fire Alarm

- Follow posted emergency evacuation procedures.
- Be aware of the closest fire exits and exit routes.
- Children in youth programs will be evacuated by youth leaders.
- Do not congregate near the entry doors or Block fire lanes. Evacuate to Safe Evacuation areas along perimeter fence of the parking lot.
- Do not re-enter BAYT until given the all clear by BAYT leadership.

In the Event of a Medical Emergency

- Notify a gabbai or Safety Team volunteer. Each minyan has designated physicians and some EMTs and Certified First Aid Responders.
- Procedures are in place to call and direct first responders and access BAYT medical equipment.
- Stand back. Allow first responders to treat the patient.
- Keep hallways and access points clear.
