Why are Aharon and his sons chosen to be Cohanim, the Priests of Hashem? And how does this connect to Purim?

Rabbi Shimon ben Gamliel (Shemot Rabbah 38:4) offers that Aharon and Mordechai both rose to greatness because of the consistency in their prayers to G-d. Mordechai was constantly by the gateway of the king, not just King Achashveirosh, but G-d the King of Kings. By being there he was able to hear Bigtan and Teresh's plot to kill the king which was necessary in leading to the Jewish People's salvation. Even after he was paraded around on the king's horse in Esther 6:11, Mordechai returns to pray by the gate in Esther 6:12. Similarly, even though Aharon and the Jewish people sinned with the Golden Calf, because of Moshe's prayers the people were ultimately saved. Aharon continues to pray on their behalf every day.

We should model ourselves after Mordechai and Aharon, continuing to pray not just so our prayers will be answered, but so we will remain worthy of being G-d's chosen people.

KAREN'S KORNER – PARSHAS TETZAVEH – TIME OUT

The bells on the bottom of the Kohen Gadol's Me'il-Robe had pomegranates and bells at the hem. The bells would ring wherever the Kohen Gadol walked and this would notify everyone that he was coming. We learn a lesson in Derech Eretz that before one enters a room, one should give warning by knocking or making a noise to announce that one is entering. Even children should be accorded this respect of their privacy. Sometimes it will be that a child has his or her own room, and it's important for a parent to knock before entering. When a private room isn't available, a child should still be given a private shelf or drawer which they can call their own.

Craft: Make a Doorknob Hanger for children, which they can hang on the door to their room letting people know that they are busy.

When Erev Pesach is Shabbat, when and how do we destroy our chametz?

Searching: Since we cannot search for chametz on Friday night, we search on Thursday night, when the stars emerge. As in other years, we recite the berachah of *al biur chametz* before searching, and afterward we recite the first *kol chamira* paragraph renouncing ownership of chametz of which we are unaware.

Destroying: We cannot burn chametz on Shabbat, so instead we dispose of chametz and its utensils on Shabbat morning, before the sixth daylight hour, in one of these ways:

- Allow someone who is not Jewish to remove it for his own use;
- Dispose of flushable quantities in the toilet;
- Leave chametz in a trash can or bag, declaring the can or bag “ownerless” and placing it outside our property.

We then recite the second *kol chamira* paragraph, renouncing ownership of any chametz. From this point onward, chametz is muktzeh.

Many Jews also preserve the practice of burning chametz, doing so before the start of the sixth daylight hour on Friday. No berachah or *kol chamira* is recited.

(Shulchan Aruch Orach Chaim 444:1-2; Rabbi Shimon Eider, *Halachos of Pesach* Ch. 33, 36)

Assistant Rabbi Search Committee: Status Report #2

The Assistant Rabbi Search Committee (ARSC) is pleased to provide the Kehila an update on the search process. We have had a very significant interest from a broad spectrum of candidates for this position.

- ⇒ We have reviewed 18 resumes to date.
- ⇒ We have completed 1st interviews with 6 candidates.
- ⇒ We have completed 2nd interviews with 4 of these candidates.
- ⇒ We will bring 3 finalists to the Shul for "Probahs" – see below

Timeline:

- March – Probah – 3 candidates
- April- June – selection of the finalist
- High Holidays 2021 - The successful candidate will begin his tenure

Probah:

What's a Probah?

- ⇒ A Yiddish term for "tryout", often used in searches for Rabbis. Traditionally, the candidates are invited to the Shul and spend a Shabbat as Scholar in Residence while getting to meet members of the Kehila. Due to the Covid -19 pandemic, we will be hosting the 3 finalists in 'virtual Probahs'.

When will we have these Probahs?

- ⇒ The Probahs will take place on March 8, 9,10

What will a virtual Probah look like?

- ⇒ The candidate Rabbi will spend various parts of the day and evening giving shiurim, lectures, and a Drasha. There will also be a "meet the Rabbi & family" session.
- ⇒ A full schedule will be provided as we get closer to the Probahs. For now, **please reserve the evenings of March 8, 9, 10 for these important events.**
