Connecting by Korban

After completing the Mishkan last week, why does G-d specifically call out to Moshe endearingly before speaking about how anyone can bring an offering, a korban?

According to Vayikra Rabbah (1:9) Moshe Rabbeinu had a special and deep connection with G-d, which is why the first person G-d specifically calls out to is Moshe.

But then why is the content about the average Jew bringing an offering?

Rashbam points out that these offerings aren't brought to atone for a sin, rather because the person wishes to contribute the offering to G-d. Perhaps this juxtaposition is to emphasize the purpose of the Mishkan and bringing offerings is to bring people closer to G-d. True, Moshe had a special rapport with G-d. But when the rest of the Jewish people take the initiative to bring offerings to G-d, they too can form their own unique connection with G-d.

BAYT COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

The BAYT COVID-19 Committee asks all members to adhere to the following health and safety protocols.

Signing Up for a Minyan at BAYT

All members who wish to attend a minyan at BAYT, must sign up in advance via SignUp Genius. Minyanim are open to members only. Please only sign up people from your household. You may be denied entrance to BAYT if you have not signed up for a minyan via SignUp Genius.

When you sign up to attend a minyan at BAYT, you expressly agree to strictly follow BAYT's COVID-19 protocols. Other shuls' protocols are not relevant to your decision to attend a minyan at BAYT. If you no longer satisfy BAYT's COVID-19 protocols after signing up for a minyan, please cancel your sign up and do not attend minyan.

While Attending a Minyan at BAYT

- Do not congregate with others during or after davening. Yes, we all want to catch up with others but the public health situation is still fluid. Come to BAYT to daven and, no offence, please leave quietly. Kiddush Clubs are not allowed.
- Do not crowd when leaving BAYT. Please leave the building single file and socially distanced 2 metres apart. Once outside BAYT, please walk away from the doors so others can leave quickly and safely.
- Avoid touching doors and door handles. Interior doors through which you need to pass are open. Please do not touch the doors, as you may cause them to close. If a door is closed, please let the facilities staff know.
- Sit in designated, distanced seating. In the main shul, sit only in seats marked with green tape. Do not move chairs around in other minyanim.

When Not To Sign Up for or Attend a Minyan at BAYT

1. You or a "close contact" are awaiting a COVID test result;
2. you have been in "close contact" with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 or who has any symptoms of COVID-19;
3. you have been in "close contact" with anyone who is in self-isolation. This includes anyone (even if asymptomatic) who lives in your household including children who have to self-isolate because of a COVID-19 case in school or a carpool;
4. you have been outside of Canada within the past 14 days;
5. you have been around others (e.g., workplace, other minyan or gathering) and did not practice proper social distancing and/or masking, even once, within the past 14 days; or
6. you are feeling unwell or have any acute illness, even if you or your doctor do not believe you have COVID-19.

"Close Contacts" Include

1. Someone with whom you have been within 2 metres for more than 10 minutes;
2. Someone who lives in your household or provides care to you;
3. Someone with whom you have had close physical contact including a handshake, or
4. Someone who accidentally coughed, sneezed or spit on you while talking with you.

If you or a "close contact" have any common symptoms of COVID-19 (see below), please get a COVID test, STAY HOME, self-isolate and advise "close contacts" with whom you were in close physical contact with in the prior 48 hours to monitor their health and to self isolate. Do not sign up for a minyan.

Common Symptoms of COVID-19 Per the Ontario Ministry of Health

- fever (feeling hot to the touch, a temperature of 37.8 degrees Celsius or higher) or chills
- cough that's new or worsening (continuous, more than usual)
- barking cough, making a whistling noise when breathing (croup)
- shortness of breath (out of breath, unable to breathe deeply)

ANNOUNCEMENTS

- sore throat, difficulty swallowing
- runny, stuffy or congested nose (not related to seasonal allergies or other known causes or conditions)
- lost sense of taste or smell
- pink eye (conjunctivitis)
- headache that's unusual or long lasting
- digestive issues (nausea/vomiting, diarrhea, stomach pain)
- muscle aches
- extreme tiredness that is unusual (fatigue, lack of energy)
- falling down often
- for young children and infants: sluggishness or lack of appetite.

If you really have to think about it, you should stay home.

Report Illness and Positive COVID Test Results to BAYT Immediately

If you attended a minyan at BAYT, please let us know immediately if you receive a positive COVID-19 test result or if you have symptoms of COVID-19 and are awaiting a test result. Let us know if, after receiving a positive COVID-19 test result, you subsequently receive a positive result for a variant of concern (VOC).

Realistic Expectations

COVID-19 is in our community. Whenever you leave your home, you increase your exposure to COVID-19 and VOCs. That BAYT may advise our members of new COVID cases at BAYT should not come as a surprise.

BAYT will notify York Public Health of all positive COVID cases brought to our attention. In the event of two or more positive COVID test results among attendees of one minyan at BAYT, York Public Health could declare a legal "outbreak." In such event, York Public Health may mandate ALL persons in attendance self-isolate for 14 days, even those who practiced proper social distancing and masking.

How should we manage seudah shlishit on Erev Pesach?

We need to satisfy the mitzvah of eating three Shabbat meals, while halting all chametz consumption at the appropriate time and preserving our appetite for the Seder's role as a Yom Tov meal. Here are two possibilities for navigating the various considerations:

Approach 1: Eat the morning meal, recite birkat hamazon, take a break (Rabbi Korobkin recommends 15-20 minutes), and then complete seudah shlishit before chametz becomes prohibited at 10:44 AM. This enables us to satisfy the ideal form of seudah shlishit, which is a bread meal; we may use chametz or egg matzah. We dispose of all chametz and recite "kol chamira" by 11:56 AM, as discussed in previous columns.

Approach 2: Eat seudah shlishit later in the day, using foods including boiled or fried matzah meal products, fish, eggs, meat and/or vegetables. We eat before 4:32 PM to enable us to be hungry for the Seder. After this we may still snack until sunset (7:38 PM), so long as we avoid foods which would ruin our Seder appetite.

We prefer to eat seudah shlishit after davening minchah, or at least after midday. Therefore, even those who take Approach 1 should eat an additional meal, ideally including boiled or fried matzah meal products to make the meal substantive, later in the day.

BAYT COVID-19 Committee

Dear Members:

Some of you have made clear, and we understand, your displeasure with our protocol for households with children and/or family members returning to or entering Canada from abroad. Today, we spent a lot of time voicing your concerns to our contacts at York Public Health and Toronto's Kol HaCovid committee. This is a synopsis of what they told us.

Federal law is clear. Every traveller returning to Canada must quarantine for 14 days whether arriving by air or road, whether they have been vaccinated, had a COVID infection or a negative COVID test result. Canada Border Services Agency (CBSA) advises all travellers upon entry to Canada that they must completely isolate during their 14 day quarantine period from anybody else in their household. If complete isolation is not possible, they are advised that other household members must also quarantine for the entire 14 days.

It may seem absurd that 14 day self isolation applies to travellers returning to Canada from Israel (of all places) or the United States who are fully vaccinated. Yes, a vaccinated individual has a lower risk of contracting COVID. But public health studies are inconclusive that vaccinated individuals cannot transmit COVID. As well, significant uncertainty exists over the effectiveness of approved vaccines against a growing number of variants of concern (VOC). 40% of all positive COVID cases in Ontario today were VOCs. From a public health perspective, risks remain definite and with significant consequences. Indeed, Kol HaCovid told us a number of students in the Jewish community returning to Ontario from the United States carried a VOC that has already spread to others in our community. In summary:

- No approved vaccine is 100% effective at this time.
- Ontario and Canada are long ways away from herd immunity.
- Whether approved vaccines actually prevent transmission of COVID or VOCs is not yet confirmed.
- Real uncertainties remain as to the effectiveness of approved vaccines against VOCs.

BAYT would be contravening public health guidelines to adjust our protocol for households with children and/or family members returning to or entering Canada from abroad at this time. Until further notice, it remains as follows:

If you have children or family members returning to or entering Canada from abroad who are or will be in mandatory 14 day self-isolation in your household, please do not sign up for or attend a minyan at BAYT unless those children and/or family members are completely isolated from the rest of your household for the entirety of the 14 days quarantine period. This applies even if he/she has been vaccinated, had a COVID infection or a negative COVID test.

We appreciate your understanding and cooperation.

Pesach Puppets and Healthy Animals for the Seder

We want our children to want to learn and enjoy the Pesach experience. Here's one idea: when you read about the Four Sons, use sock puppets and the children can act out the different voices while holding the sock puppet. They can also share which "Son" they identify with, and why.



We should keep in mind that we recall our experiences as children, and how we FELT at the time. We don't necessarily remember what we wore or what food was served. The atmosphere is the most important thing to be mindful of. The goal should be that the family ends the Seder with a good feeling, and that everyone had the opportunity to participate and were included in the Seder experience.

You can also make these healthy animals that can be your centerpiece for the Seder, representing the Plague of Arov, wild animals.



D'VAR TORAH FOR PARSHAS VAYIKRA

You may have noticed that the word Vayikra has a very small Alef at the end of it. There is only one other place in the Torah where an Alef is a different size.

In Divrei HaYomim there is a large oversized Alef in Adam's name. This teaches us something unique about Adam. Adam felt he was very special because he was created by Hashem. He was very confident and so sure of himself that he wasn't careful and he made a mistake and ate from the Eitz HaDaat.

Moshe was obviously special too. He was the only person who was special enough to talk face to face with Hashem. But, Moshe was humble. So modest that he didn't feel worthy enough to lead Bnei Yisroel. He thought of himself as smaller and less important than other people. This is why the Alef in the word Vayikra is so small.

Rashi teaches us that Hashem's "Vayikra", calling of Moshe, was a sign of love. Hashem loves humble, modest people.

Every person should know how special they are like Adam, but they should not become proud or careless. You should stay humble and modest and serve Hashem just like Moshe did.
