

*How should one pray if they cannot join a minyan?*

According to *halakha* one who is unable to join with a minyan should still pray alone, preferably at the same time the minyan (in our case Beit Rayim) is praying. One should find a room or a part of a room which is relatively free of distraction and where they are unlikely to be disturbed.

*Which prayers should I skip?*

Certain prayers, known as *dvarim sh'b'kedusha* are said only with a minyan. They are *Barchu*, *all of the Kaddishim* (*Hatzi Kaddish*, *Kaddish Shalem*, *Kaddish d'Rabbanan*, and *Mourner's Kaddish*), *the Kedusha* and *repetition of the Amidah*, and *the Torah Service*,
