“Chezi’s Chochma” by Rabbi Zionce

Shalom,

This Shabbat we add a second Torah reading to our weekly portion of *Tetzaveh*. The week before Purim is noted as *Shabbat Zachor* – the *Shabbos* on which we are commanded to *Zachor* - remember - what our archenemy Amalek did to us. So important is this that the same paragraph that starts with the commandment for us to “*zachor* - remember” concludes with the words, “*lo tishkach* – don’t forget.”

Zachor ... we have to remember the past. But that is not enough. We are also told: “*Lotishkach* – don’t forget.” What is the difference?

Rabbi Israel Lau, former Chief Rabbi of Israel and the youngest survivor of Buchenwald concentration camp, points out that “not to forget” refers to what takes place in one’s heart, while *zachor* – “remember” – refers to actions that serve to remind people. Says Rabbi Lau, “The actions that I took to fulfill the *zachor* – remembering – was to tell the story.”



My friends, it appears that the current Polish government doesn’t want to tell the story and remember ... but we must! It’s not enough to simply feel it in our hearts.

Let us take this lesson to heart, and then witness the fulfillment of the words of the Psalmist: “*Yitamu chataim min ha-aretz u’rishaiim od einem* – when sinners will be obliterated from the world and the wicked shall be no more.”
