Palm Beach County has seen a slight decline in the amount of Covid cases/hospitalizations over the past few weeks but remains at "Medium" Community Risk Level.

Your health and safety are important to us, and we encourage everyone to follow CDC guidelines. We are not mandating masks at this time, but KN95 masks will be provide for anyone who wishes to wear one while indoors at Anshei Emuna. As long as the CDC Community Risk Level remains "Low" or "Medium" masks will not be mandated, regardless of vaccine status.
