

Kitah Dalet (4th Grade) Learning Objectives for 2018-2019

Upon completion of the school year, the students will have mastered the following objectives:

Israel:

To complete the three units in the Israel curriculum and tell two facts related to the following units: Israel in the Torah, Israel in Jewish Prayer and Practices and Israel in Jewish holidays.

Holidays:

To identify components of the major *chagim* (holidays) and tell ways that they are celebrated/connected to Israel.

Parsha:

To state components of the various weekly *parshiyot* in *Shemot* (Book of Exodus)

Community/Lifecycle:

To state a connection between ourselves, and our families and the Jewish people through the stories we tell using the Etgar Yesodi curriculum

Mitzvot:

To name the following mitzvot and tell of ways to fulfill the mitzvah – giving Tzedakah through Operation Isaiah, Mason, and Maos Chitim

Tefillah:

To be able to chant the following prayers:

Mi Chamocha

Baruch She'amar

Birchot Hashechar

Ahavat Olam

V'ahavta

Hebrew:

To tell the meaning and decode with fluency the following prayers: *Ahavat Olam, V'ahavta, Amidah (first page), Mi Chamocha, Birchot Hashacar, Baruch She'amar.*
