

Kitah Hay (Fifth Grade) Learning Objectives for 2018-2019

Upon completion of the school year, the students will have mastered the following objectives:

Israel:

To complete the three units in the Israel curriculum and tell two facts related to the following units: Israel in the Torah, Israel in Jewish Prayer and Practices and Israel in Jewish holidays. To complete Unit 5 *Yisroel: A Modern Look At Our Ancient Land*, in the Etgar *Yesodi* curriculum.

Holidays:

To identify components of three pilgrimage festivals, *Shalosh Regalim- Sukkot, Pesach* and *Shavuot* and tell where they are located in the *Chumash* and the ways they are connected to Israel.

Parasha:

To name the five books of the *Torah* and locate them and additional chapters and verses in the *Chumash*.
Read and discuss the *Parasha Noach*

Community/Lifecycle:

To discuss and participate in ways that we can be show kindness and be mensches as members of the Jewish community.

Utilizing the Etgar *Yesodi* curriculum we will learn Unit 1: *kehillah Kedoshah*

Unit 3: *Arakhim: Living Our Values Together*

Unit 6: *Ahrayut: Our Responsibility Toward Others*

Mitzvot:

To define ways to be involved in the community through performing mitzvot for the *Shearith* Israel Women's Shelter and Jewish Family and Career Services. (Food activities – Operation Isaiah, Mazon, JF&CS Food of the Month, Shelter)

Through the Etgar curriculum we will learn about mitzvot between people; the Torah commands the Jewish people to be sacred and Unit 6 *Ahrayaot* Our Responsibility Toward Others.

Tefillah:

To participate in discussion about the history of the following prayers and be able to chant them:

V'Shamru

Lecha Dodi

Torah Brachot

Ein Kamocha and *Vayehi Binsoa* from the *Torah* service

Chatzi Kaddish

Kaddish Shalem and *Ashrei* (keep this as optional; only a few students got to this last year)

Hebrew:

To tell the meaning and decode with fluency the following prayers: *V'Shamru, Lecha Dodi, Ein Kamocha and Vayehi Binsoa and Torah Brachot from the Torah service, Chatzi Kaddish and Kaddish Shalem*

To recognize and be familiar with the Hebrew words used in the Etgar *Yesodi* curriculum.
