I understand that every teacher has the right to teach and that every student has the right to learn.

I will try my hardest to have fun, be happy and smile at Religious School! I will be respectful and polite to all of my classmates and teachers. I will respect my classmates even if we like different things.

I will make every effort to be in class on time and be prepared with my books and other materials that are required of me.

If I am late, I will enter the classroom quietly.

I understand that I am required to attend the following Shabbat Services during the 2023-2024 school year:

- Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>- (Attendance at Shabbat Chavaya and Friday Night Family Shabbats highly recommended)
- 3<sup>rd</sup> grade-1 Friday Kabbalat Evening Services & 3 Saturday Shabbat Morning Services (which includes Shabbat Chavaya)
- 4<sup>th</sup> grade-2 Friday Kabbalat Evening Services, 4 Saturday Shabbat Morning Services (which includes Shabbat Chavaya)
- 5<sup>th</sup> grade-3 Friday Kabbalat Evening Services, 5 Saturday Shabbat Morning Services (which includes Shabbat Chavaya)
- 6<sup>th</sup>-7<sup>th</sup> grades-5 Friday Kabbalat Evening Services and 10 Saturday Shabbat Morning Services (which includes Shabbat Chavaya)
