TBA Oneg/Kiddush Checklist

This is a list to assist you

3+ months prior

√ Review the Oneg/Kiddush Guidelines

√ Determine if you are catering the Onegs, sharing Oneg responsibility with another family or doing it yourself

V If Catering ensure that it is an approved caterer or contact the TBA office to discuss

6 weeks prior:

v if contacted that there is a special service Friday evening, coordinate Oneg with lead of the committee or class

5 weeks prior:

v Contact Oneg team/House of Worship (oneg@brithachim.org) to schedule a walkthrough of the kitchen

Two weeks before Oneg:

Linens (if desired):

✔ Contact TBA Office to arrange to use TBA linens; or✔ Contact TBA gift shop to order linens

Key:

√ Contact TBA office to schedule a time pick up the key from main office

Misc

√ Verify time for Friday night Shabbat Service – (can be 7pm or 8pm)

Week before Oneg:

Linens:

✔ If you arranged to use TBA linens check availability✔ If you have ordered linens, confirm delivery

Key:

√ Pick up key to TBA from main office

Set Up:

√ If large Oneg (over 50) is expected, work with the office to revise the standard layout

Purchases (Friday and Saturday):

√ Wine, Grape Juice

√ 3 Challot (unsliced). 2 for Friday; 1 for Saturday

√ Desert, fruit, bake goods, etc.

√ Additional drinks, including cream and milk if serving coffee

√ Paper goods, cutlery, and decorations

Before Services Begin:

√ Coffee – Prepare coffee and/or hot water

√ Table set up: Cover serving tables

Set out napkins, plates, cups and necessary cutlery buffet-style

Tray up bake goods, snacks, Cover.

√ Ceremonial table: Arrange small table for Kiddush

Friday Oneg: Two Challot; Saturday Kiddush: 1 Challah

√ Bema: Check that Kiddush cup with juice and Shabbat candlesticks are on the bema. Usually

The bema guest arranges this

As Services Conclude:

√ Have two volunteers ready to serve Kiddush juice and wine

∨ Place any food or drink stored in the refrigerator out on serving tables

√ Have a volunteer open accordion door so that the congregation may walk into the Social Hall

Clean up:

V Leave the kitchen clean and tidy. See *Guidelines* for details.
