In an effort to share updates as they unfold, we write with the latest actions being taken in response to the coronavirus:

KESHER/LTNS CLOSED UNTIL MARCH 30. In light of the announcement by the Mamaroneck School District yesterday to close all school buildings and facilities until March 30 and transition to remote learning during that time, Larchmont Temple has likewise decided to suspend all on-site KESHER and LT Nursery School classes and activities until March 30. KESHER and LTNS families will be contacted with information regarding resources and remote learning activities that will be implemented for this period.

We appreciate the challenge these closures can present to families, especially in nursery school, but this is an important step to helping with the mitigation and “social distancing” efforts being increasingly pursued in our community, our region, and throughout the country.

WOMEN’S SEDER APRIL 1 CANCELLED. Because of the advance planning and commitment required for the Women’s Seder and the significant uncertainty regarding likely conditions on April 1 and soon thereafter, the Women’s Seder has been cancelled.

SPRING GALA APRIL 25 REMAINS ON. We are still a long way from the April 25th Spring Gala to Honor Carol Scharff, and are hopeful that by then we will all feel more comfortable joining together in a beautiful and joyous celebration of our cherished friend and leader.
