

Information for Congregants Attending Shabbat in the Lot Services

ADMISSION:

- **This will be a weather dependent service:** Our service will be outdoors. In the event of inclement weather, we will send out a congregational email to announce postponement.
- **Sign up to attend:** Admission will be by reservation only, with reservations will be capped at 36 households, restricted to members only. Advance sign-up is required, along with the attestation that attendees are not experiencing any Covid-19 related symptoms. The reservation will need to list all attendees who will be part of the family group. In the event the health status of any household member changes prior to the service, please stay home and join online.

ATTENDEES:

- **Bring chairs** to sit in. Consider mosquito repellent and hand sanitizer.
- **THE BUILDING WILL BE CLOSED. NO PUBLIC RESTROOMS.**
- **Masks:** Masks are required at all times when outside your personal vehicle.
- **Paperless Service:** Print the service sheet from our website at home or bring a phone or tablet. This will be a paperless service with no handouts of any kind. This week's service will be sent to you via email prior to the service

ARRIVAL:

- **Park only in the designated spaces.** There will be volunteers providing directions. Please wait in your car until an usher directs you to your seating area.
- **Social Interaction is encouraged, as long as physical distancing is maintained.** After being directed to the marked area in the parking lot, remain in your appointed space until the end of the service.

WORSHIP:

- **Feel free to chant softly.** We know how hard it is not to join in on those familiar melodies and prayers. We invite you to participate by singing softly, while still wearing your mask. The spaciousness of our lot, our separation between groups, and being outside mitigates the risk.

DEPARTURE:

- Once the service has concluded, please make sure to keep your mask on and practice social distancing (six feet) as you walk back to your cars.
