# Message from the President

### Nothing so constant as change

For a month with no holidays we've been busy! While I miss the presence of Rabbi Sydni and Rabbi Feivel at services, I am constantly amazed at how this congregation steps up and makes our worship and events happen. This month we started off with a visit from Rabbi Yos of Magen Avraham in Israel, with much gratitude to the Federation for rekindling this relationship with a Masorti congregation after a lull due to COVID. We got to learn new tunes over shabbat and then learn with both Rabbi Yos and Rabbi Jana from BZ for 929. The following week, we got to start trying out our contingency plans for services- Torah and haftarah were both read in English, which congregants told me was meaningful to them. Of course, what we didn't know is that we were welcoming our newest member at the same time, and we were able to celebrate with the Rabbis Rubenstein and their families as Shalom Zimri was brought into the covenant the following Shabbat. We learned as soon as Shabbat was over that streaming was down, and luckily for me, it wasn't back up when I chanted all seven aliyot of the week for the first time the following Shabbat. I'm signed up again later in December- which reminds me, I need to practice. We got through 929s reading of Joshua and into our seventh book of Tanach, We've wondered who attached the Shreveport outdoor temperature to a yo yo and despite folks staying home from the weather (or feeling under the weather) made a minyan almost every time we've had a service scheduled. Thank you all for that. We've welcomed folks back to town who came to visit the cemetery, a new Jewish person at Barksdale who came to our services within a week of getting to town, and had a quick changeover in the office as we welcome Joyce Bailey back to the staff. I have never been so thankful for the rest of a Shabbat as I have been this month.

None of this would have gone as smoothly without our staff and volunteers. It's not unusual for me to say I need to do something for the shul and have someone say they can help or do the thing. Folks know I will take you at your word if you want to try to do something that you aren't sure about- we've had people lead kiddush, parts of service, or birkat hamazon after lunch. If there's something you want to try, even if it's only a page or a paragraph, let me know I'm happy to help you get ready or to be up there with you. There is nothing we do that cannot be done in English if you aren't confident in Hebrew yet. Or read 5 chapters of tanach and moderate the discussion after services (leader spots available December 10 and most of January).

Next month is full of events, but not changes. Look in the bulletin for information about our December guest Rabbi, covered dish dinner, and federation Chanukah party. I can't wait to celebrate with all of you.
